HARDWOOD LUMBERMEN'S ASSOCIATION. In the March number of the Cainabs Lumbirman blank forms were enclosedrequesting an opinion from hardwood lumber manufacturers and dealers regarding the formation of a Ilardwood Lumbermen's Association for the province of Ontario. We would respectfulty request that all persons intetested relurn these forms, duly filled in, to this office, at the same time giving a free expression of opinion on the subject.

CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.
ontario.
The logging situation in Ontario has been somewhat relieved by the weather of the past two weeks. There is now abundance of snow in the woods, in fact, almost too much for expeditious bauling of $\log s$, but reports from the northern districts state that operators are making fair progress and putting forth every effort to get logs to the streams. While there is no doubt that some logs wall be left in the woods, the present outlook is that a sufficient stock of logs will be secured to keep the mills in operation for the greater part of the season. This, of the greater part of the season. This, of
course, is provided that all the logs that course, is provided that all the logs that
are banked reach the mills, none being are banked reach the mills, none being
hung up as a result of low water. From hung up as a result of low water. From
information gathered, it seems that the cut of handwood logs in western Ontario this winter has been quite heavy, and that the lumber production will be up to the averase, if it does not exceed the cut of last season.
Although there is not a heavy movement of lumber, the market is decidedly firm, Some of the manufacturers have advanced their quotations on pine uppers, dressing, wide common, and mill run stock, but asfar as can be ascertained this step is confined to mills that have adopted a high standard of grading, and consequently no changes have been made in our price list. United States dealers are looking to Ontario for stock, and a brisk spring trade is expected as soon as the building season shall open. The mills, in anticipation of this, and in view of the shortage in lumber stocks, will start operations earlier than usual.
ourbrc and new brunswick.
The local movement of lumber has been restricted by the cold weather, which has prevented operations in the building line. Architects in Montreal ana Quehec report a considerable amount of work in hand, and when the buildiny season opens there will likely be a lively demand to lumber. It is experted that the prices for local stock will be affected to some extent by the ligher prices ruling in the export irade. While no changes have been made in our Quebec price list, it is understood that the market for both deals and timber is strengthening. There have been numerous enquiries from 13riush importers for birch timber, and the prospects are that operators in this wood will realize enhanced values before the year closes. The deal market at St. John is firm, shippers continuing io buy for export, but so far few vessels have been chartered owing to high rates.
united states.
Enquires have been made by the American Lumberman to ascertain the prospective input of logs this winter. The replies received seem to indicate that. in comparison with last winter, there will be a decrease of from to to 15 per cent. in the production of pine logs, and an increase of about 10 per cent. in the cut of hardwoods. If this estmate should prove nearly correct, it is not probable that the season of 1900 will witness any material deprer ation in lumber prices. The narket is now very stron. Sales are reported at Wisconsin mills of mill culls at $\$ 12$, No. 3 boards at $\$ 13$, No. 2 at $\$ 15$ and No. 1 at $\$ 17$, and it is predicted that mill culls will reach $\$ 13$ before many weeks. It is stated that the cut of mill culls in some districts for the first half of the season has Ilready been sold. At Bay City and Saginaw some changes in prices of pine have been made withn uppers and selecis have been advanced by uppers and selecls have been advanced by about $\$ 2$ per thousand. No. hater, as is barn boards are abou $\$ 1$ hegher, as is
also shipping culls of narrow widus. also shipping culls of narrow widulhs.
Shaky clear stock has advanced $\$ 2$, selling from $\$ 28$ to $\$ 30$. Shingles are unchanged, but No. 1 white pine lath is slightly easier, sulling in the Ray City market at $\$ 3.50$, arainst $\$ 3.75$ a few weeks aro. Attention is also directed to the changes in the Buffalo and Ton
Fumness stull characterizes the hardwood market. Basswood has been sold at $\$ 2.50$ for firsts and seconds delivered in Chicago. Brown ash is held at high figures, Wisconsin manufacturers asking $\$ 21$ forlog run at the mills.
Shingle prices remain stationary. Dealers in the Eastern States are holding stock firmly, believing that the production this season will not be large.

Stock in the hands of brokers in Great Britaln is gradually becoming diminished. Buyers now seem to realize that the high prices asked for spot goods are warranted by the enhanced values at which contracts for new stock are being placed. At London, Liverpool and Glasgow the volume of trade is considerable, spruce and pine selling freely. Puces realizedat recent public sales have been exceptionally good.
