





CASUALTY ON THE B. & O.

A PASSENGER TRAIN STOPS AT SWITCH AT ANKNEYTON. And Runs Into a Freight, the Engine of which is Destroyed.

On the 26th of the month of August, the B. & O. passenger train, No. 14, was derailed at Ankneyton, near Hamilton, Ontario. The engine and two passenger cars were wrecked.

The engine, a 2-4-0, was wrecked at the crossing at Ankneyton. It was derailed by a freight train which had crossed the tracks.

The passenger cars were derailed and overturned. One car was crushed under the engine. The other cars were damaged.

The cause of the accident is believed to be a switch which was not properly set. The freight train was running on the wrong track.

The wreckage was removed and the tracks were repaired. The passenger train resumed its journey on the following day.

The accident caused a loss of life and property. The engine and several passenger cars were destroyed.

The B. & O. Railway Company is conducting an investigation into the cause of the accident. It is expected that the results will be published soon.

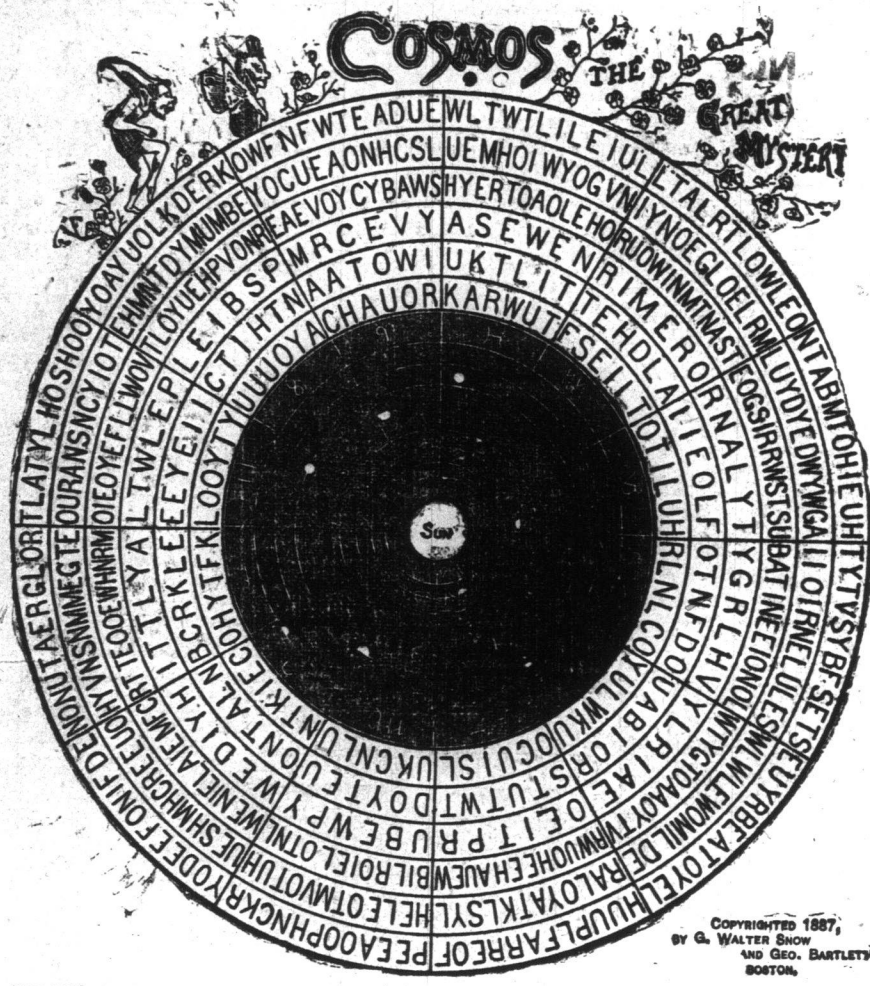

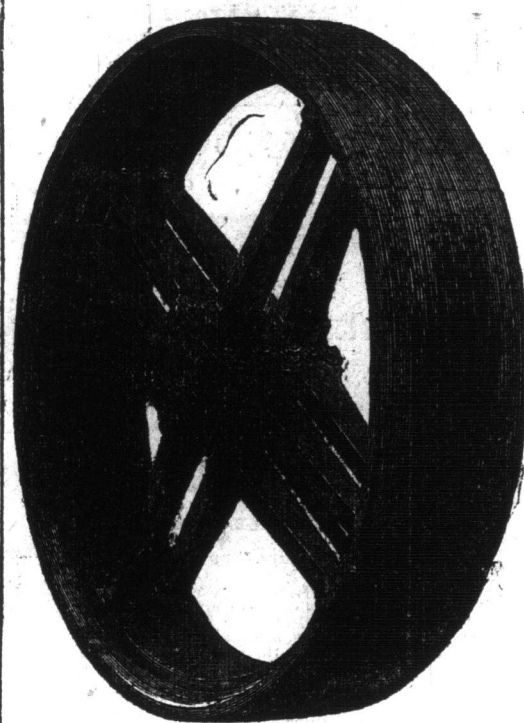
