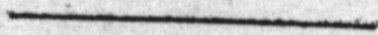

BISHOP'S ADDRESS.

The Most Rev. the Metropolitan delivered the following address at the opening of the Synod of the Diocese of Montreal, on the 20th June, 1871 ;

MY BRETHREN OF THE CLERGY AND LAITY :

I meet you to-day, no longer with the feeling of a stranger, with which I addressed you on the last occasion ; for nearly two years have now elapsed since I first entered upon my office as the Presiding Pastor of this important Diocese. I have learnt much during that time, as to the difficulties of my position, as to the wants of the diocese, and as to the peculiar characteristics both of the field of labour and of those whom God has called to work in it. I trust that you have also learnt to give me credit, amidst all my short-comings, for a single desire to serve my Heavenly Master, and you for His sake. And I doubt not that you have found out that, in accordance with the principle which I laid down at starting, my desire is to act not as the Bishop of a section, but of the whole Church ; and that wherever I see real earnestness and devotedness of heart, I am disposed to overlook little differences, in order that I may help forward the great work of Christ. I was quite prepared to expect that this policy of moderation would not be entirely acceptable to those who are inclined to extreme views on either side, and consequently would render my course somewhat difficult ; but being convinced that such a course is the right one, I hope by God's help, never to swerve from it. The recent appeal case in England, of *Hebbert vs. Purchas*, has, I conceive, settled some points before uncertain ; and unless that judgment be overruled, which is not likely, the law of the Church, as to the questions at issue, is decided. There are a few points of minor importance, ruled by that judgment, which have long caused much discussion and bitterness of feeling, on which we might, I think, with great advantage come together—such points on the one hand as the position of Celebrant in the Holy Communion, and on the other hand the vesture of the clergy in the pulpit. Here, then, is a basis for some approach to uniformity. Let those who belong to one school of thought consent to give up the practice of turning from the congregation in the administration of the Holy Communion ; and let those who belong to the other fall in with the practice which now prevails in almost every church of wearing the surplice in preaching. I shall be extremely thankful if, in such matters, more of a spirit of mutual conciliation might be shown, and that our clergy might be disposed so to modify their practice as to be more in harmony one with the other. May I not hope that, as we realize more and more the great and blessed work to be done by us in this rough field of Canada, we at

least shall see the unwisdom of stopping to dispute about matters which are, in themselves, the veriest trifles, when compared with the eternal salvation of souls? Let us rather at once buckle on our armour, and go forth to our warfare, feeling that no time must be wasted, but that "the King's business requireth haste." Above all, may we not hope that this present Synod may be specially marked by an entire absence of anything that savours of party strife; that all combinations to strengthen the interest of this or that section will be studiously avoided; and that we shall vie with one another to forward the real welfare of the Church, rather than to win a party triumph.

During the last year it has pleased God to remove from among us two of our Fathers in the Ministry—one, the Rev. Canon Townshend, who fifty years ago patiently bore the burden and heat of the day, when there was little to cheer the heart, and much to endure for Christ's sake—the other, the Rev. J. Braithwaite, an accomplished scholar, as well as a faithful minister, to whom more than one in this assembly owes the blessing of his early Christian training.

The number of Clergy now labouring in the diocese amounts to seventy-six. There are also eleven candidates for holy orders; and as the number of the latter has greatly increased in the last three months, I am thankful that my anxiety on the score of a supply for the sacred ministry is, to a certain extent, abated. We have an additional band of nine Lay Readers, employed, under Episcopal license in our missions: two of these are in sole charge and the remainder are working under the superintendence of the clergy and aiding them in their ministrations. Their valuable services are in most cases given gratuitously. The training of candidates for holy orders is still a matter which weighs heavily and anxiously on my mind. You are aware that, in conjunction with some leading clergymen and laymen of the diocese, I initiated a movement in this direction a few months ago. I did so, not from any indifference to the interests and welfare of the existing college at Lennoxville, for that college has had, and always will have, my cordial support; nor on account of the teaching in that institution, for I believe it to have been as good as under existing circumstances could have been given; but simply and solely because I felt that it would be for the welfare of this Diocese if we had an institution of our own, and if the training of our young clergy were nearer to the centre of their future work. Finding, however, that a decided majority of the clergy, and many also of our laity, viewed the matter in a different light from myself and those who acted with me, and at the reasonable suggestion of the Corporation of Lennoxville, we consented to stay our hands and leave the matter for a while in abeyance. However strong my own convictions may be, I would never desire to carry them out, if known to be at variance with the feelings of my clergy, whose interests in such a matter are deeply concerned. At the same time I wish it clearly to be understood that no act of mine for the improvement of Bishop's College, either in the past Synod or in the present, is of a nature to fetter me as to my future freedom of action in this respect. Whilst on this subject, I would remind you that a measure for

bringing Bishop's College into closer connection with the two Synods of Montreal and Quebec was passed at our last session. Certain resolutions were then agreed to, but we were somewhat premature in proceeding forthwith to the election of those trustees and members of Council who were to represent our Synod in the newly constituted body, since the Act empowering us to do so had not yet passed the Legislature. It has since become law; and I have named to-morrow as the most convenient day for us to make that election. A deputation consisting of the Chancellors of the University, and three other members of the Corporation, have kindly offered to wait upon us during our present session, in order to give any information which we may require. I need scarcely ask you to receive them with all respect; and to admit them to the body of this house.

As to the mission work of the diocese, I may truly say that God has not withheld His blessing. Notwithstanding certain difficulties, of which I shall presently speak, the work *has* prospered, *is* prospering, and I believe *will* prosper. Two new churches have been built within the city limits, and there is room for more, especially in the lower parts of the town. A regular service is now held at Côte des Neiges, after a suspension of two years. Six churches in other parts of the diocese have been opened, four of which have been consecrated. Others also are now in progress. I have ordained five Priests and two Deacons. But we still need more labourers, and increased funds for their support. In addition to the signs of life which I have mentioned, I would add that I have held during the past year forty-four confirmations, and admitted eight hundred and fifty-seven persons to the privilege of that holy Rite. And truly I may say, with regard to these confirmations, that no part of my episcopal duties gives me truer satisfaction than this, or calls forth more abundantly the zeal, energy and devotedness of the clergy. Never since my entrance upon my work here have I observed a single instance of lightness on the part of any candidate who has been presented to me. And the warm interest evidently taken by the various congregations shews me that this ordinance is increasingly appreciated by the Church at large.

I have, on more than one occasion, been requested by clergymen who have several congregations to whom they minister on the same Sunday, to authorize some curtailment of the morning service. I feel that the length of that service in such cases is a little burdensome to an overtaxed Missionary, and I propose to bring the subject before my Right Reverend Brethren at the next meeting of the Provincial Synod, with a view to some united action in regard to it. Meanwhile any clergyman, who ministers to more than two congregations in the day, has my authority to use a portion only of the morning service at each, so that it be an *integral* and *complete* portion. That is to say, of the three services now used in their blended form, he is at liberty to omit one office on the Sunday morning.

And now I come to a matter which must needs be one of considerable anxiety both to myself and to you all—the financial condition of our Mission Fund. This has been for years past anything but satisfactory. There

has ordinarily been a small deficit at the close of each year; and this difficulty has been tided over as best it could, either by borrowing money to meet the existing debt, and repaying it when the exchequer has been replenished, or by making a special collection at once to pay it off. This year, however, it was felt by the Executive Committee that the time had come when, although the balance could easily have been dealt with as heretofore, it was desirable to look the difficulty fairly in the face, and provide against its recurrence. At recent meetings of the Committee, two decided steps were adopted: 1st, The Treasurer was directed to pay on the next quarter day, July 1st, one-half of the salaries then due, being such an instalment only as could be met by the funds in hand, leaving the remainder to be paid when fresh funds shall have been received. This was a measure calculated to produce serious inconvenience; but it was considered necessary under the existing circumstances. 2nd, It was agreed by the Committee to withdraw the Church's grant from certain older missions which were considered capable of self-support, and to date such withdrawal from July 1st. Whilst I concur in the principle of its being desirable that as many as possible of our long established missions should depend upon their own resources, I strongly objected, and do still object, to the mode of carrying that principle out. My objection lay against the arbitrary selection of certain missions, from which it was decided to remove the grant, without sufficient information as to their ability to depend upon their own internal strength. And I further objected to the short—the needlessly short—notice which was given to these missions to adapt themselves to their altered condition. I therefore felt it right to record my objection by entering a formal protest on the minutes against the particular resolution which was passed. My decided counsel is that the details of so important a measure should be carefully reconsidered, especially as regards the parishes from which the grant is to be removed, and the extension of the time from which such removal shall date. But however much I may have objected to the details of the measure, this I feel bound to say, that those who were forward in recommending it were impelled by the necessity of the case, and will yield, I am very sure, to none in their sincere desire to advance the interests of the Church. I hope that, if this subject is discussed during our present session, it will be considered with the gravity and forbearance which it demands; and that the result will be the putting our Mission Fund on a better and more vigorous footing. Let our clergy exercise a little faith and patience; and let our laity cheerfully accept whatever increased responsibility forces itself upon them. Of this I am sure, that we may confidently rely upon the true-hearted liberality of our Church members to meet with an open hand any reasonable demands which are made upon them, and not suffer the work of God to flag for lack of support. I believe there are not only abundant means at our disposal, but also a willingness to furnish those means. There are two points which must claim our immediate attention in any future arrangement. The first is the paramount necessity of augmenting the stipends of the clergy. We owe it to

them as a matter of justice; we owe it still more to *ourselves* as a matter of self-respect. The other point is the commencing without delay to lay the foundation of a sustentation or endowment fund for the future exigencies of the Church. Our diocese stands alone, of the five which form this ecclesiastical province, in never having made a real effort in this direction. We have improvidently trusted to the annual generosity of the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel, well knowing, however, that their liberal grant will shortly be altogether withdrawn. Indeed, in a letter which I received from the Society on Wednesday last, it is announced that the amount of assistance voted to us for the year 1872 is £1800, being a reduction of £200 upon the present grant. I would also state that, in a letter which I received from the Secretary some months since, he complains of the fact that a considerable portion of the Society's aid has been given to missions of more than ten years' standing. To this he calls my attention, and intimates that the Society expects its money to be in future expended, not on established and fairly rooted missions, but upon those which have been more recently opened, and therefore require their aid. In conformity with this latter intimation, I shall, at the next meeting of the Executive Committee, recommend the transfer of the Society's grant to the more decided missionary work of the diocese, and the placing of the older missions, which still require extraneous support, upon the list of grants from the General Church Fund. As to the urgent necessity of raising a Sustentation Fund, I hope that our leading churchmen will feel that they cannot do better than consecrate their wealth to so blessed a purpose, thus placing on a firm footing the future support of the Church in this land. The zeal shewn by our brethren of the Irish Church in this respect, may serve as a worthy stimulus to us here, whose necessities, in many respects, are precisely similar.

There now remain a few miscellaneous subjects, which I shall group together, touching upon each of them very briefly before I close. In my last address I expressed my opinion that we ought no longer to depart from the established rule of our Church regarding the celebration of marriages in the House of God, and there only. I requested the clergy to bear in mind that it was my wish, if possible, to carry out this rule. I will take this opportunity of thanking them for their readiness in doing so; and I desire also to express my gratification that the laity have so cheerfully fallen in with the request of their bishop. There is a growing custom which has of late prevailed in the churches of this city, which, I confess, a little grates against my idea of what is consistent with the dignity and decorum of the Christian Sanctuary. I refer to the plan of advertising the preacher for the coming Sunday. Even if it were unobjectionable in itself, I cannot but think that it fails to produce the effect that is looked for; for, if a few migratory hearers are *attracted* to one church by the announcement of a particular preacher, they would most likely be *drawn away* from that same church on the following Sunday to listen to another. But I must regard the practice as somewhat subversive of the solemnity of Public Worship, as giving an undue prominence to the words of man, and as fostering that taste for

excitement which is not altogether healthy. There are, of course, occasions when it is not only permissive, but also desirable, to announce both the preacher and his subject; as, for instance, when a special sermon is preached, and for a special object, or when a stranger of mark comes among us. I shall be quite content if the clergy and their churchwardens will give this subject their thoughtful consideration; and I feel sure that they will not mistake my motive in alluding to it. I am anxious to know the mind of the Synod regarding a General Harvest Thanksgiving Day—whether a Sunday or week-day should be chosen, whether it would be well to make an effort to unite all sections of the Church in the observance of the same day, and whether a day could not be fixed upon to be observed in common by our brethren in the neighboring dioceses. I am very glad that notice of a motion on this subject has been given, and this will probably draw out the opinion of the Synod on the subject. I may add that an application which I made to the Government last year was kindly and courteously received; but it was felt that there would be a difficulty in carrying out officially the suggestion.

I cannot conclude without expressing my thankfulness for the blessings of the past year, for the peace which the Church has enjoyed, for the harmony which for the most part exists among our clergy and their several flocks, and for the apparent success which has attended our endeavours. I hope that we shall all, in our respective positions, labour with increased energy, for there is a great work still before us, and the time is short. Let me reiterate the earnest request which I made at the last Synod, and which you so entirely carried out, to bear in mind wherefore we are come together, namely, to consult, to deliberate, to give and receive brotherly council, to strengthen one another's hands, to cheer one another's hearts, to draw closer together. May we be guided and influenced by that Holy Spirit who presided in the Councils of the Apostles, and whose presence we have solemnly asked! May we, each one of us, so speak and so act that we may have nothing to regret, and that this meeting of our Synod may greatly help forward the Church's work and the cause of our common Master in this land!

ANNUAL REPORT FROM THE DEANERY OF BEDFORD.

JUNE 17TH, 1871.

MY LORD,—In making the usual Annual Report the Rural Dean has occasion to notice very few changes in the Deanery since the last Annual Meeting.

There are now *eighteen* clergymen in Priest's Orders holding distinct charges in the Deanery. One mission, that of Milton, is vacant.

One assistant minister is engaged at Knowlton, ministering at different out-stations in the townships of Brome and Sutton, and one lay assistant in the Mission of Waterloo.

The vacancy at Milton has been caused by the removal of the Rev. Thomas Godden, to the Diocese of *Ontario*. It becomes a question whether this Mission should be supplied with another resident minister, or attached to the mission of Abbotsford. Were the Mission Fund in a more flourishing condition than it is at present, *Milton* might be the centre of useful missionary work, and, having a parsonage and local endowment, be the residence of the clergyman ministering at Abbotsford. But this, at present, does not appear to be practicable. It is right to state that the people here and at South Roxton have made creditable exertions in raising a considerable sum for the support of their Mission.

MISSION OF BOLTON.

The Mission of Bolton has been for some time vacant since the removal of the Rev. E. J. Fessenden to the Diocese of Toronto. The services of that Mission have been supplied by Mr. McFarlane, lay reader, residing at Knowlton. Mr. Clayton, a candidate for orders, has since been appointed to that Mission.

DEANERY MISSION BOARD.

The Mission Board, appointed by the Bishop, held a meeting convened by me under the Bishop's direction at Waterloo on Tuesday, November 22nd, 1870.

I understand that Board as being appointed to give information to the Lay Committee in order to their framing their Report, and convened for

that purpose only. If it were to be continued as a permanent institution of the Deanery, it must be seen that it would neutralize the proper action and usefulness of the Annual Deanery Meeting.

STATISTICS.

Papers of Questions have, by direction of the Bishop, been issued to the Clergy of the Deanery and the churchwardens.

They have all been returned answered, and with the exception of *three Missions* from which no answer has been received, and *Milton*, which is vacant. I have compiled the statistical information which these answers convey, and beg leave to present it in a condensed form, comprising the returns from *fifteen Parishes and Missions*.

NUMBER OF STATIONS.

Forty-four Stations are returned as occupied by sixteen clergymen, including the assistant minister at Knowlton.

COMMUNICANTS.

The number of communicants returned is *nine hundred and twenty*.

OFFICIAL ACTS OF CLERGY.

Of these acts there are returned *two hundred and thirty-two Baptisms*; two hundred and three persons have been presented for *Confirmation*; *thirty-two Marriages* have been solemnized, and *one hundred Burial Services* have been performed.

FINANCIAL RETURNS.

The first of these, referring to the Salaries of the Clergy, gives the sum of \$8,617.89 received as salaries by the Clergy. Of this amount \$4,357.71 is contributed by the congregations, and \$4,389.36 from the different Missionary Funds, making almost exactly one-half contributed from sources external to the Missions.

ENDOWMENTS.

Return is made of Endowments amounting in the aggregate of *eight* separate Missions to \$21,539.25.

LOCAL CONTRIBUTIONS.

These amount under the head of *Sunday collections* to \$1,247.90, and of *Special collections* to the sum of \$835.26. This is independent of other local efforts, which will be mentioned in the closing portion of this Report.

INSURANCE OF CHURCH PROPERTY.

The Church property appears to be generally insured, as no less a sum than \$123,105.00 is returned under this head. *Three Missions* return their Church property as not insured.

SMALL AMOUNT OF DEBT.

One pleasing feature in the Financial Report is the freedom from debt, the amount returned under this head being trifling.

LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS.

A good deal has been effected in this way in the different Parishes and Missions of this Deanery. In *Bedford* a chancel has been added to the Church at a cost of \$300.00, all raised in the Mission. The woodwork on the outside of the church has been painted and new windows put in throughout at a cost of \$149.00 contributed by kind friends in Montreal. A font has been also purchased at a cost of \$20.

A Church has been commenced in *North Ely*, which will be completed by the ensuing autumn. Some improvements have been made in the schoolhouse Chapel at *Boscobel*.

The Church at *Granby* has been thoroughly repaired and refitted at an expense of \$2,600.00. Of this sum \$2,200.00 is the generous donation of *John Bradford Esq.*, of that place, and \$400.00 was contributed by the congregation.

At *Iron Hill* some improvements have been made in the fitting up of the Parsonage and completion of the churchyard fence.

At *Knowlton* the Church has been painted and the Parsonage repaired.

The Rectory at *Frelighsburgh* has been re-shingled, and a Parochial school-room built.

The Rev. J. Constantine reports that important repairs and additions have been made to the Church at *Stanbridge East*.

At *West Farnham* the Church School ground has been partially fenced in.

Upon the whole the state of the Church affairs in this Deanery is satisfactory, and shows a gradual but steady growth and improvement in every department of Church work.

THE DEANERY OF ST. ANDREWS.

May 24th, 1871.

At a Ruri-Decanal meeting held in the Mission of Hull, Diocese of Montreal, the following clergy were present:

The Rev. Canon Lonsdell, M.A., Rural Dean, Rev. Jno. Johnston, Incumbent at Hull; Rev. W. Ross Brown, missionary at Aylwin and Alleyne; Rev. P. W. Smith, missionary at Aylmer and Eardly; Rev. R. D. Irwin, asst. missionary at Clarendon; Rev. F. Codd, missionary at Portage du Fort;

Rev. G. C. Robinson, missionary at Clarendon Centre; Rev. J. Rollit missionary at Buckingham; C. J. Kaapcke, missionary at Thorne, &c.

The meeting was opened with prayer by the Rural Dean.

The first item of business brought forward was the present state of the Mission Fund and the causes which may have led to it, together with its special bearing on this Deanery. By the late reports it seems that two of the Missionaries have had their grants withdrawn by the Executive Committee; while two others, in the remote and poorest section of the Deanery, are considerably reduced.

Mr. Irwin reports that the congregation at Bristol Corners, (at present forming part of the Mission at Clarendon) have contributed liberally towards the erection of a Church in that locality; the services, at present held in a room, are well attended.

Mr. Robinson reports that a new Church is contemplated at Clarendon Centre; the subscription list now in circulation amongst the congregation exhibits the very handsome amount of \$1350 raised in the Mission. Work is also in progress towards the completion of St. Luke's church, North Bristol.

Mr. Kaapcke, who visits the German settlements in the Townships of Derry and Bowan, 150 miles distant from his residence, reports that the new church near Otter Lake, in the Township of Thorne, is nearly completed, and will be ready for consecration when the Metropolitan shall again visit that part of the deanery. A church has been commenced in East Thorne, to which the people, who are mostly poor German settlers, have contributed a good deal in labour and materials.

Mr. Smith reports that the church in Upper Eardly will be finished and fit for Divine service by next autumn.

Mr. Seaman is preparing materials for a church at the Pache village. \$150, with timbers for the frame work, have been contributed.

In Mr. Brown's Mission on the Gatineau there are two additional churches in course of erection, one to be finished this summer, the other as means will admit. The church at Alleyne in the same Mission is to be enlarged.

Mr. Johnston, lay reader at Hull, promised to give two services once a fortnight in the Township of Templeton, which will be a great relief to Mr. Rollit, whose Mission is too extensive.

Changes in the Deanery. Mr. Neve, who has just now retired from the Mission of Grenville, had formerly been stationed at Clarendon, then a rough country, for the most part covered with the primeval forest. Some idea of the extent of Mr. Neve's duties may be inferred from the fact that there are now ten churches in that portion of this Deanery, over which his labours extended, and, that by his constant visits to the scattered hamlets on the south side of the Ottawa, extending from Arnprior Pembroke, a portion of country now comprised within the Diocese of Ontario, he was the means of keeping alive an attachment to the church of their fathers amongst a large portion of the population.

Morin to the charge of Greaville, and parts adjacent, is succeeded by Mr. Boyd, from the Diocese of New York.

It is recommended by the Ruri-decanal Chapter that Bristol Corners and parts adjacent be erected into a separate Mission, to include the whole of the Township.

Archdeacon Bond, who accompanied the Rural Dean last January, expressed himself well pleased with the general state of the Missions, and the progress that is being made throughout the Ottawa country. The annual Missionary meetings were held during the winter, which yielded a return of \$100. The largest collection, over \$20, was taken up at Hull.

Rev. Mr. Kaapcke, has made payments on the lands in Bowman, purchased by the late Metropolitan; the documents now in possession of the Rural Dean will be handed over to the Executive Committee.
