THE NATION'S WORKING POWER.

Energy of Various Countries Estimated in Foot Tons—An Englishman's Estimate.

Among the many scientific papers read at the recent meeting of the British Association in Bath, none possesses a higher degree of interest than the brief monograph of Mr. Michael G. Mulhall on the "Growth of American Industries and Wealth." It is all the more interesting because it is the work of a distinguished English statistician, and so must be regarded as free from any taint of patriotic exaggeration.

To look upon the picture which Mr. Mulhall gives of the astonishing life, wealth and energy of the United States stirs the blood. In every one of the three principal sources of power—man, horse and steam—the greatly exceed the leading nations of Europe, as will be seen from this table of Mr. Mulhall's, showing the aggregate energy of the principal nations in millions of foot tons daily.
