Fire in Wingham.

The premises belonged to a person in Calross, whose name we could not learn. They were uninsured.

An Important Suit.

The Windsor Record says:—A case will be tried at the Oxford Assizes, before Chief Justice Draper, in which Mr. Rankin is plaintiff, and John McEwan, Esq., Sheriff of Essex, defendant. THE AMERICAN WAR.

New York, Nov. 12.—The *Special* correspondent says that the Richmond papers of Thursday are greatly exercised over Lincoln's election.

Hood is said to be marching on Chattanooga and the Confederates are confident that Grant is preparing for another battle. The Confederate journals almost unanimously reiterate the opinion that there is no probability of success for the Union army. Washington, Nov. 12.—Hear Admiral Porter, writing from the navy depot from on board his flagship, the *Richmond*, says that the roads, under date Nov. 10, says:—Some days since I went to the United States steamer Stepping Stones up to Mob Jack Bay to put a stop to the smuggling going on there. The Stepping Stones returned on the morning of the 10th, having in tow two vessels, the *Rebecca* and *Little King*, captured by the *Rebecca* and *Little King* respectively. The *Rebecca* was carrying a quantity of rum, and the *Little King* was carrying a quantity of rum and other articles.
