Articles the produce or manufacture of Canada passing in transit through Czechoslovakia and articles the produce or manufacture of Czechoslovakia passing in transit through Canada shall be reciprocally free from all transit duties whether they pass through direct or whether during transit they are unloaded warehoused or reloaded.

## ATMAYOTEO ARTICLE 4 CIVIA ACCAVIAN

It is understood that in all matters governing the import, export and transl of merchandise Czechoslovakia grants to Canada and Canada grants to Czecho slovakia the treatment of the most favoured nation.

To enjoy the benefit of the tariff advantages provided for in the foregoing articles, without prejudice to the stipulations of Article 4, goods the production or manufacture of Czechoslovakia shall be conveyed without transhipment freign a port of Czechoslovakia, such being understood to be a port of a foreign country in which Czechoslovakia has defined rights under treaties to which Canada is a party, or from a port of a country enjoying the benefit of Preferential or Intermediate Tariff, into a sea or river port of Canada.

The present Convention, after being approved by the Parliament of Canada and by the competent authority on the part of Czechoslovakia, shall be ratifications shall be exchanged at Ottawa as soon as possible. It shall be come into force fifteen days after the exchange of ratifications and shall be inding upon the Contracting Parties during four years from the date of coming into force. In case neither of the Contracting Parties shall have good notice to the other twelve months before the expiration of the said period four years of its intention to terminate the present Convention it shall remain force until the expiration of one year from the date on which either of the Contracting Parties shall have given to the other notice of its intention to terminate it.


