Having thus (at an additional and entirely unwarranted expense of $\$ 6,058.80$ to the Province) unloaded their obligations for the benefit of twenty-six of their friends anc supporters, they unblushingly devoted themselves, as everybody knows, to their own person legal and other profitable business.

As has been sald, the Legal Expenses of the Province for the year 1906, make a grand
