DIRECTORS REPORT

The Directors of St. George's Hall Company, Limited, have much pleasure in submitting their Report for the year 1899.

From the Financial Statement herewith presented it will be seen that there is a substantial and gratifying increase in the revenue derived from rentals, while the expense items show a decrease, arising principally from the fact that the insurance premium paid in 1898 was for three years. Instead of writing anything off the Building and Furniture the Directors deemed it wiser to begin a Reserve Fund to provide against depreciation and other contingencies. As the nucleus of this Fund the sum of \$1.000 has been set aside out of the surplus of the year, after providing for all expenses and charges, leaving \$673.59 still at the credit of Profit and Loss

This, therefore, has proved the most satisfactory year the Company has had since the erection of the Building and the hope expressed in the Directors' last report has been realized.
