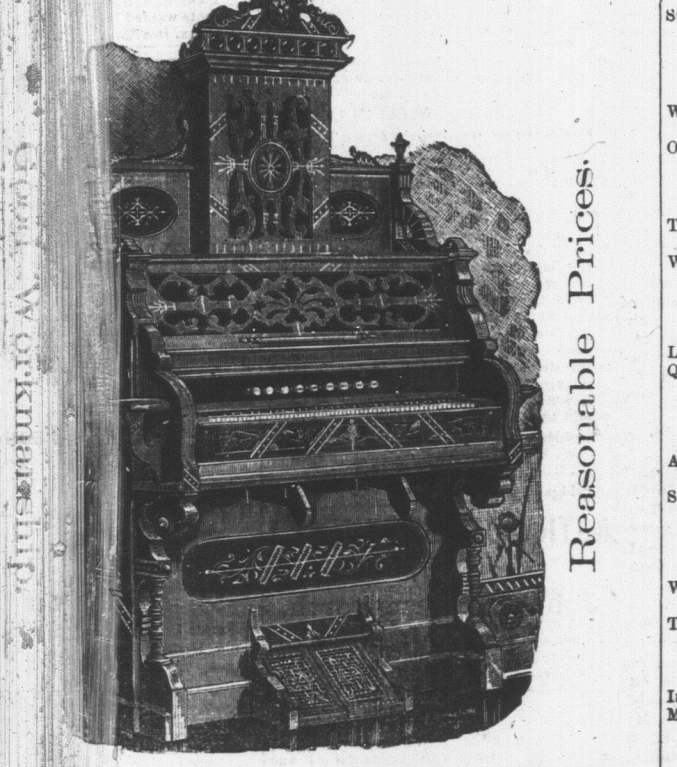

The Private Dairy. If the making of butter is simply a matter of setting the milk, collecting the cream and using the churn, there would be no difficulty in making butter on every farm...
