

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HISTORICAL.

THE necessity for a larger Cemetery near the city was forced upon the attention of the citizens early in 1847. The Old Burial Ground within the limits of the city was about to be closed by law, and the ground near the Marsh Bridge, which exclusively belonged to the Church of England, with a small area, was rapidly filling up, while the population of the city was gradually increasing. Under these circumstances a number of public spirited citizens, desiring to interest in the scheme all classes and denominations, prepared and addressed a circular to the office-bearers of the several churches in the city. pointing out the crowded condition of the cemeteries then in use and appealing to them to join in the effort to procure a larger one. All responded to this appeal excep. the Roman Catholics and Methodists, they having cemeteries of their own. The result was the appointment of a general committee to select a site and place the scheme on a business basis. After a lengthened and labored investigation of all the localities in the vicinity of the city likely to be suitable for the purpose, the committee concluded to purchase seventy acres of land from James Peters, Junior, Esquire, and forty acres from Henry Gilbert, Esquire, forming a part of the present site of the Cemetery. The price paid for this property was ten thousand four hundred dollars, a lot being reserved for each of the proprietors. A subscription list for stock in a proposed company was then prepared. Each share was placed at ten dollars, and in a very short time the stock was all taken up. A meeting of these stockholders was immediately held, when twelve directors were chosen, who prepared a bill for the incorporation of the company, which was finally enacted by the Legislature of the Province on 30th March, 1848.

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By the terms of this Act, it will be seen that the capital stock of the company was twelve thousand dollars, which was expended in paying the purchase money of the property, and in laying out and improving the grounds. As lots were sold this stock was paid off and cancelled, and there is none of it now outstanding.

Last year (1897) the Cemetery was enlarged by the purchase of the adjoining property, making the total area now to be one hundred and forty-four and a half acres.

Acts of Assembly relating to The Saint John Rural Cemetery Company.

11 VICTORIA, CAP. 56,

AN ACT FOR THE INCORPORATION OF THE SAINT JOHN RURAL CEMETERY COMPANY.

PASSED 30TH March, A. D. 1848.

WHEREAS, From the great increase of the population of the City and County of Saint John, the want of a suitable place for the burial of the dead is much required.

- I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That ROBERT JARDINE, Honorable ROBERT L. HAZEN, BEVERLEY ROBINSON, JAMES PETTINGELL, SOLOMON HERSEY, WILLIAM G. LAWTON, GEORGE P. PETERS, JOHN M. WALKER, WILLIAM PARKS, CHARLES DRURY, ADAM JACK, and LEBARON BOTSFORD, their Associates, Successors, and Assigns, be and they are hereby declared to be a body Politic and Corporate, by the name of The Corporation of The Saint John Rural Cemetery Company, and by that name shall have all the general powers and privileges made incident to a Corporation by Act of Assembly of this Province.
- II. And be it enacted, That the Capital Stock of the said Corporation shall consist of the sum of Three Thousand Pounds, and shall be divided into Twelve Hundred Shares of Two Pounds Ten Shillings each, and be paid in such sums, and at such time or times, as the directors of the said corporation shall from time to time appoint. And every shareholder in the said corporation shall have and be entitled to have a certificate under the seal of the said corporation, and signed by the president and secretary thereof, certifying his property in such shares as shall be expressed in the certificate.
- III. And be it enacted, That whenever any assessment shall be made, it shall be the duty of the treasurer to give notice thereof in two or more newspapers printed in the City of Saint John, requiring payment of the same within thirty days, and if any shareholder shall neglect or refuse to pay to the treasurer the amount of such assessment upon his share or shares, at the time prescribed, it shall be the duty of the treasurer to advertise such delinquent's share or shares for sale at public auction, giving at least ten days' notice of the time and

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place of such sale; and such share or shares upon which the assessment or assessments, or instalments thereof shall then remain unpaid, shall be sold to the highest bidder, and such sale shall be a legal transfer of the share or shares so sold to the purchaser or purchasers thereof, and shall be recorded accordingly in the book so to be kept by the directors for that purpose as aforesaid; and such purchaser or purchasers shall be entitled to receive a certificate in the form prescribed in the second section of this Act.

IV. AND WHEREAS, A piece of land containing one hundred and ten acres. and lately belonging to the late JAMES PETERS, Junior, and HENRY GILBERT, Esquires, situate in the Parish of Simonds, in the County of Saint John, has been secured for the purpose of a burying ground, and with the exception of a portion which has been laid aside for the Church of England, shall be forever free to all denominations of Christians, to be divided into lots and sold to such individuals as may be willing to purchase the same, and which said land is desc. bed as follows, to wit: Beginning on the north-eastern side of the Marsh Road at the north-west corner of lands owned by Thomas Traffon, thence north forty-seven degrees thirty minutes west along the Marsh Road twenty chains ninety-one links to the south-western line of WIGGINS' marsh; thence south forty degrees east to the edge of upland; thence along the edge of upland and marsh to the south-west line of JARVIS' upland; thence south forty degrees east twenty-three chains to the Old Westmorland Road; thence along the Old Westmorland Road thirty-seven chains south-westerly to the north-eastern line of Thomas Traffon's farm; thence north forty degrees west twenty-seven chains and fifty links to the place of beginning;

Be it therefore enacted, That the said land above described be, and hereby is declared to be exempted from all rates, assessments and taxes, so long as the same shall remain dedicated to the purposes of a Cemetery.

V. And be it enacted, That all persons who shall hereafter become proprietors of lots in the Cemetery aforesaid, of a size not less each than one hundred and fifty square feet, shall thereby become members of the said corporation, and shall have, and be entitled to have a certificate under the seal of the corporation, signed by the secretary, in the form following: (See Amendments 25 Vic. ch. 73 and 26 Vic. ch. 30.)

VI. And be it enacted, That a general meeting of the stockholders and proprietors of the said corporation shall be held at the City of Saint John on the first Monday in May (see 17 Vic. ch. 56) in each and every year, for the purpose of choosing twelve directors for the management of the said corporation, which directors so chosen shall remain in office for one year, or until others are chosen in their stead. And shall at their first meeting after the election choose one of their number president of the said corporation: Provided always that not less than five directors do form a quorum for the transaction of business; and in case of the absence of the president, the directors shall have power to appoint one of their number chairman for the occasion.

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VIII. And be it enacted, That every person owning a share in the capital stock of the said corporation, and every proprietor of a lot not less each than one hundred and fifty square feet, shall be a member of the said corporation and entitled to vote at all meetings of said corporation; and members may give as many votes as they may own shares, and absent members may vote by proxy, such proxy being a shareholder, and producing sufficient authority in writing from his constituent. Provided nevertheless that no stockholder by himself or proxies shall have more than one hundred votes.

IX. And be it enacted, That the shares of the said corporation shall be assignable and transferable according to such rules and regulations as may be established in that behalf, but no assignment or transfer shall be valid and effectual unless the same shall be entered and registered in a book to be kept by the directors for that purpose.

X. And be it enacted, That in case of any vacancy among the directors by death, resignation or disqualification or otherwise, then and in either of such cases the said directors shall and may fill up such vacancy by choosing one of the shareholders or proprietors of lots of not less each than one hundred and fifty square feet. And the person so chosen by the directors shall serve until another is chosen in his room.

XI. And be it enacted, That the several shareholders in the said corporation shall be members of the same until they shall be repaid (out of the funds of the said corporation) the amounts by them respectively invested, together with interest on the same at the rate of eight per centum per annum, when they shall cease to have any interest in the Cemetery, and the property shall from thence be vested in Robert Jardine, Henry Gilbert, John M. Walker, George P. Peters, James Pettingell, William G. Lawton, Lebaron Botsford, William Parks and Edward B. Peters, being the present proprietors of lots in the said Cemetery, and all future proprietors of lots of not less each than one hundred and fifty square feet.

XII. And be it enacted, That from and after the payment to the several shareholders of the amount so invested by them respectively, together with interest as in and by the eleventh section is provided, the proceeds of all sales of lots after deducting the annual expenses of the said Cemetery, shall be forever devoted and applied to the preservation, improvement, embellishment, and enlargement of the said Cemetery, and for no other purpose whatsoever.

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XIII. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons shail wilfully destroy, mutilate, injure, or remove any tomb, monument, grave stone, or other structure placed in the Cemetery aforesaid, or any fence, railing, or other work for the protection or ornament of any tomb, monument, grave stone, or other structure aforesaid, or shall wilfully destroy, remove, cut, break or injure any tree, shrub or plant within the limits of said Cometery, or shall play at any game or sport, or discharge any gan or other fire-arm, save at a military funeral, within the said Cemetery, or who shall wilfully and unlawfully disturb any persons assembled in the Cemetery for the purpose of burying any body therein, or who shall commit any nuisance within the said Cemetery, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall, upon conviction thereof before any justice of the peace, be punished by a fine of not less than one pound, nor more than five pounds, or be committed to the common gaol for the space of not more than ten days, according to the nature and aggravation of the offence. And such offender shall also be liable in an action of trespass to be brought against him in any court of competent jurisdiction in the name of the Corporation of the Saint John Rural Cemetery Company, to pay all such damages as shall have been occasioned by his or their unlawful act or acts, which money, when recovered, shall be applied by the said corporation to the reparation of the property destroyed or injured as above. And members of the said corporation shail be competent witnesses in such suit.

XIV. And be it enacted, That the lots in the said Cemetery shall not be levied upon or taken in execution, but shall be altogether free from seizure at the suit of any person or persons whomsoever, and that the property in any of such burial lots or part thereof, shall not prevent any confined debtor from receiving support under the law in force for the relief and support of confined debtors.

AMENDMENTS.

16 VIC. CHAPTER 56.

An Act to Amend an Act for the Incorporation of The Saint Join Rural Cemetery Company.

PASSED 3rd May, 1853.

WHEREAS, The time for holding the annual general meeting of The Saint John Rural Cemetery Company is found very inconvenient, and it has become necessary that the same should be altered:

Be it therefore enacted, &c. :

- 1. So much of the sixth section of the Act of Incorporation as applies to the holding of the annual general meeting of the said company is hereby repealed; and in lieu thereof, from and after this present year, the annual general meeting of the stockholders and proprietors of the said company shall be held on the first Monday in April in each and every year, for the purpose of choosing directors, etc., as expressed in and by the said sixth section.
- 2. The lots in the said Cemetery shall be indivisible, but upon the death of any proprietor of any lot in the said Cemetery containing not less than one had been been and fifty square feet, the devisee of such lot or the heir-at-law as the case may be, shall be entitled to all the privileges of membership, and if there be more than one devisee or heir-at-law of such lot, the directors for the time being shall designate which of the said devisees or heirs-at-law shall represent the said lot and vote in the meetings of the corporation, but nothing herein contained shall prevent the heirs-at-law of such proprietor of a lot from burying in the same lot under the by-raws of the said company.

25 VICTORIA, CAP. 73.

An Act in Amendment of the Act intituled an Act for the Incorporation of The Saint John Rural Cemetery Company.

PASSED 23rd April, 1862.

WHEREAS, The form of conveyance of the lots in The Saint John Rural Cemetery Company has been found too vague and indefinite, and likely to lead to much confusion and inconvenience:

Be it enucted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly:

1. The Directors of The Saint John Rural Cemetery Company for the time being shall be and are hereby authorized, notwithstanding the provisions contained in the fiftieth section of the said Act, to make and prescribe such form for the con deem fi tions as

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the conveyance of lots in the Rural Cemetery as they may from time to time deem fit, under and subject to such conditions, covenants, agreements and regulations as may by them be deemed necessary and proper.

2. Such conveyance under the seal of the Corporation of The Saint John Rural Cemetery Company and signed by the secretary for the time being, shall constitute a valid and sufficient conveyance of such lot or lots as may be therein expressed, subject to the terms of such conveyance. (See Amendment of 26 Vic. ch. 30.)

26 VICTORIA, CHAP. 30.

An Act further in Amendment of an Act for the Incorporation of The Saint John Rural Cemetery Company.

Passed 20th April, 1863.

Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly as follows:

- 1. The third section of Act 25 Vic., ch. 73, is hereby repealed.
- 2. All persons assigning or transferring lots which they may hold in the Saint John Rural Cemetery, shall give notice thereof to the secretary, who shall keep a book in which memoranda of such assignment or transfers shall be made.

61 VICTORIA, CAP. LX.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF THE ACT INCORPORATING "THE CORPORATION OF THE SAINT JOHN RURAL CEMETERY COMPANY."

- 1. Confirmation of previous issues of Bonds.

Passed 21st February, 1898.

 $\it Be\ it\ enacted,$ by the Lieutenant Governor and Legislative Assembly, as follows:

1. The issue of the various bonds or debentures heretofore made by the president and directors of "The Corporation of the Saint John Rural Cemetery

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Company," on the second day of January, 1894, the twenty-sixth day of May, 1897, and the fifth day of July, 1897, respectively, are hereby legalized, ratified and confirmed, and the said bonds and debentures (being distinguished by the numbers six to twenty-five inclusive, and aggregating six thousand seven hundred dollars) are hereby declared to be valid obligations of the said "The Corporation of the Saint John Lural Cemetery Company," and shall be payable by the company according to the tenor thereof respectively.

- 2. The provisions of "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, 1893," and all amendments thereto, shall apply to the said "The Corporation of the Saint John Rural Cemetery Company," and shall be read as a part of this Act in so far as the said "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, 1893," and amendments, may not be inconsistent with this Act, or with the provisions of the Act 11 Victoria, Chapter 56, incorporating the said company, and subsequent Acts in amendment thereof.
- 3. In case a resolution authorizing the same is sanctioned by a vote of not less than two-thirds of the members of the said company (as defined by section eight of the Act 11 Victoria, Chapter 56) then present in person, or represented by proxy, at a special general meeting duly called to consider the resolution, the directors may borrow money on the credit of the company, and issue bonds, debentures or other securities, and may sell, pledge or otherwise hypothecate the same for any sums borrowed, or deposit the same as collateral security for any promissory note or overdraft of the company at such prices or for such amounts as may be deemed expedient or necessary: provided, however, that such debentures, bonds or securities shall not be for a less sum than one hundred dollars, and that the total amount of the outstanding indebtedness of the company upon such bonds, debentures or securities (including the debentures mentioned in section one of this Act) shall not at any time exceed the value of ten thousand dollars.
- 4. The said "The Corporation of the Saint John Rural Cemetery Company" is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire, hold, own and deal with the following described lot of land and premises:
- "All that lot, piece and parcel of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Parish of Simonds, in the County of St. John, and Province of New Brunswick, being bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point on the northern side line of the old Westmorland road at the south-west corner of land now owned and in the possession of 'The Corporation of the St. John Rural Cemetery Company,' at a point distant one hundred and eleven feet from the south-east corner of the outermost of the four granite posts placed at the present entrance to the said Cemetery property; thence south-westerly along said northern side line following its various courses twelve chains and ninety links, more or less, to the south-east corner of lands now owned by Alexander C. Jardine; thence north thirty-seven degrees fifteen minutes west (by the magnet of the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven) along the north-east

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side line said Alexander C. Jardine's land and of land owned by John McDonale, junior, twenty-five chains and forty-one links, more or less, to a point on the southern side line of the Great Marsh Road at the north-east corner of the said land owned or occupied by the said John McDonald, junior; thence north fifty degrees thirty minutes east along said side line of the Great Marsh Road, twelve chains and twenty-two links to the north-west corner of the aforementioned lands owned by 'The Corporation of the Saint John Rural Cemetery Company,' thence south thirty-eight degrees east twenty-eight chains and twenty-three links to the place of beginning, containing thirty-four and one-half acres more or less."

- 5. The said lot of land and every part thereof, with all the buildings and improvements thereon, so long as the same may be held or owned by the said company for the purposes of a Cemetery, or for any purpose incidental thereto or connected therewith, shall be exempt from all rates, taxes and assessments of every nature and kind.
- 6. When and wherever in the Act 11 Victoria, Chapter 56, incorporating the said "The Corporation of the St. John Rural Cemetery Company," or in the subsequent Acts in amendment thereof, there shall be used the words "the Cemetery," "the said Cemetery," "in the Cemetery aforesaid." "the Saint John Rural Cemetery," or other words of like import, such words shall be taken to mean, include and designate, in addition to the lot of land described in the said Act 11 Victoria, Chapter 56, the lot of land and premises described in section four of this Act, and all other pieces and parcels of land hereafter acquired or purchased by the said "The Corporation of the St. John Rural Temetery Company" for the purposes of a Cemetery.
- 7. It is expressly declared that in connection with the authorities and powers conferred by section thirty-five of "The Joint Stock Companies' Act, 1893," the directors of the said company, or their duly authorized committee, have power to contract with any persons or person for the perpetual care of any lot, or of any monument, structure or improvement, now or hereafter to be made or placed on any such lot, within the limits of the land owned or controlled by the said company, which contract may be in the form set forth in Schedule A to this Act annexed, or in such other form as may be from time to time approved, prescribed or adopted by by-law of the company.
- 8. All such contracts heretofore entered into by the said company with any person or persons in form substantially the same or similar to the form referred to in, or in accordance with the provisions of the preceding section, are hereby legalized, ratified and confirmed, and are respectively declared to be valid contracts binding upon the said company according to the tenor thereof.
- 9. It is hereby expressly declared that in connection with the powers conferred by section thirty-six of "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, 1893," the directors of the said company have power to make by-laws, not inconsistent with this Act, relating to or connected with the perpetual care of lots, the making

or execution of perpetual care contracts, the receipt and investment of moneys received from such contracts, the establishment of a perpetual care fund, and such other things as are incidental thereto.

10. All moneys heretofore or hereafter received by the said company, by virtue of any such contract for perpetual care (except income arising from investments thereof as hereinafter mentioned), shall be invested by the directors in Dominion, Provincial or Municipal bonds, or in bonds of the said company, or in the Government Savings Bank, or in a chartered bank of Canada, in accordance with the by-laws, and shall form a "Perpetual Care Fund," the title to which shall be vested in the said company as trustees. No portion of the said perpetual care fund shall be expended by the company for any purpose, nor shall the same be subject to any form of taxation, nor to any execution, nor any similar warrant or process issued against the said company, or any of the members thereof; the income arising from such fund shall annually be expended by the company in the preservation and care of the various lots included in or covered by the said perpetual care contracts, according to the tenor of such contracts respectively.

11. The word "company" when used in this Act shall be taken to mean "The Corporation of the Saint John Rural Cemetery Company."

SCHEDULE A.

AN AGREEMENT made between The Corporation of the Saint John Rural Cemetery Company, of the one part, and the proprietor of Lot Number in the Saint John Rural Cemetery, of the other part.

In consideration of the sum of dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said The Corporation of the Saint John Rural Cemetery Company hereby agrees to and with the said assigns, that it, the said company, during the existence of its charter, will keep the grass and turfing in and upon the said lot in reasonable condition and preservation, and properly cut and trimmed. (Add here other clauses which may be desired, relating to the care of trees, shrubs or monuments.)

BY-LAWS.

ARTICLE I.

ANNUAL MEETING.

The annual meeting of proprietors of lots in the Cemetery of a size not less than one hundred and fifty square feet shall be held on the first Monday in April in each year, for the election by nomination and ballot of twelve directors for the ensuing year, and for the transaction of other business connected with the Cemetery.

Notice of each annual meeting shall be published by the secretary during at least the six consecutive days, not including Sundays, immediately preceding a meeting, in one newspaper published daily in the city of St. John.

ARTICLE II.

DIRECTORS.

Pursuant to section six of the Act of Incorporation the directors shall, at their first meeting, by nomination and ballot, elect the president of the company for the ensuing year from among their number, and shall also at the same meeting, and by the same method, appoint a treasurer, secretary, and superintendent, to hold office during the pleasure of the directors, or until, but not later than the first meeting of directors following the next annual meeting.

Pursuant to section ten of the Act of Incorporation vacancies among the directors may be filled by the directors. In the event of a vacancy in any of the offices above provided for, such vacancy may be filled at any regular or special meeting of the directors, the person then appointed holding office during the balance only of the period for which his predecessor was appointed.

In the event of the omission or neglect to appoint the treasurer, secretary, or superintendent at the proper time for such appointment as above set forth, it shall be lawful for the directors to make such appointments at a special meeting of directors to be called forthwith upon the discovery of such omission, and as such meeting to confirm and ratify all transactions of the acting officials during such intervening period.

Neither the secretary, treasurer, or superintendent may be members of the board of directors. Their salaries for the ensuing year shall be determined any willy by the directors.

The directors shall meet quarterly on the first Monday in July, October, January and April, or at the call of the president; special meetings shall be called by the president at any time when thereto requested in writing by three directors.

ARTICLE HI.

PRESIDENT.

The president shall preside at all meetings of the corporation and of the directors; shall fix time and place of special meetings of the corporation and of the directors, and the method of calling the same. In the absence of the president his place shall be supplied by a temporary chairman.

ARTICLE IV.

SECRETARY AND TREASURER.

These offices may be held by the same person. It shall be the duty of the secretary to attend all meetings of the corporation and of the directors, and to keep the minutes of such meetings; to receive applications for sales of lots and to lay the same before the committee on lots; to draw all conveyances directed by such committee, numbering the lots consecutively as sold, and collecting from each purchaser on behalf of the corporation the sum of one dollar for each conveyance; to keep a register of all such conveyances of lots, and of assignments and transfers of the same; to prepare and execute under the direction of such committee, and on behalf of the corporation, contracts with lot owners for the annual or perpetual care of lots, and to keep a detailed record of the same; to keep a record of all interments in the Cemetery, showing name, age, residence and occupation of the person interred, and the number of the lot where interred; to preserve in a portfolio all plans of lots which may be deposited with him for safe keeping, and generally to do and perform all such other acts and duties as may at any time be ordered by the directors.

It shall be the duty of the treasurer to take charge and custody of all the moneys, securities, and other evidences of property belonging to the corporation, subject to the control of the executive committee; to make, under the direction of such committee, investments of such of the funds of the corporation as may be received under contracts for the perpetual care of lots; to collect all amounts due the corporation for sales, contracts or services of any kind; to purchase all supplies required by the corporation and to pay all bills therefor after their approval by the president or by the chairman of any committee duly authorized by the directors to order an expenditure; to keep proper books of account showing separately the general fund of the corporation and the perpetual care fund, which books shall be balanced annually or oftener at the pleasure of the executive committee; to furnish at the annual meeting a statement of the yearly receipts and expenditures to the 15th of March in each year, and of the financial condition of the corporation, showing separately the general fund and the perpetual care fund; and generally to do and perform all such other acts and duties as may at any time be required of him by the directors. He shall also deposit in such bank, as the directors may order, to the credit of the company, and to be drawn upon by the president and himself, all moneys received by him over and above forty dollars which he may retain on hand to meet contingencies.

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ARTICLE V.

AUDITOR

The directors shall annually appoint some person not a member of the board to audit the treasurer's account and books, and to check the funds on hand. The auditor shall make a report thereon in writing to the directors, making such suggestions as to method, system, or otherwise, as he may think necessary.

ARTICLE VI.

SUPERINTENDENT.

It shall be the duty of the superintendent to supervise, direct and control all work carried on within the limits of the Cemetery; to take charge of the Cemetery grounds; to engage workmen to the number allowed by the directors or a committee thereof, with power to discharge and re-engage; to pay such workmen at the end of each week such wages as the directors may allow, and in such manner as they may direct; to lay off lots or avenues within the Cemetery under the direction of the committee on lots or the chairman thereof; to fulfil all contracts made with proprietors for the annual or perpetual care of lots; to maintain order within the Cemetery; to abate nuisances; to remove incumbrances, keeping the avenues, paths and grounds in neat and satisfactory order; to attend and supervise all funerals, requiring from each undertaker such notice of funerals as shall be sufficient to enable him to have everything in readiness, and to avoid delay and confusion; to keep regular and accurate records of all interments, including the names, ages, residences, occupations and date of death of the persons interred, and sending a weekly statement thereof to the secretary; to accompany persons desiring to purchase lots, pointing out to them the lots unsold; to receive applications from intending purchasers and to transmit the same to the secretary; to collect all burial fees, fees and charges for preparing, grading, improving or dressing lots, or for repairs of monuments under temporary arrangements with proprietors; to collect the proceeds of sales of produce of lands belonging to the corporation; to keep an account of all collections hereby authorized, and at the end of each week to remit the amount to the treasurer with a statement of account; and generally to perform such other duties as the directors may require of him.

The superintendent shall not receive, accept or retain, or allow any employee to accept any gratuities from visitors or proprietors, or any remuneration for work done at any time within the Cemetery, other than the salary or wages allowed by this corporation.

Cattle shall not be allowed by the superintendent to graze on any unsold lands belonging to the corporation.

ARTICLE VII.

COMMITTEES.

There shall be two standing committees, each to consist of three or more directors, and to be chosen by ballot, namely the executive committee and the committee on lots. Other temporary committees may be appointed by the

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president on motion, carried, authorizing him to do so. Vacancies in the committees may be filled in the same manner as the committees are respectively chosen.

At each meeting of the directors the standing committees and the temporary committees then existing shall make a report showing all important matters that have received their attention since the last meeting, and what has been ordered or performed by them in connection therewith; the directors may thereupon take such action upon the matters reported as may to them seem desirable.

ARTICLE VIII.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

The executive committee, except as hereinafter specified, shall have general supervision of all the business of the corporation; the control of the funds belonging to the corporation; the making of investments and reinvestments, through the treasurer of the "Perpetual Care Fund," under such limitations as may be prescribed by the by-laws and the Act 61 Vic., Cap. 60; the control of the superintendent and officers and servants of the corporation; the general oversight and charge of the grounds, trees, shrubs, avenues and fences within the Cemetery, with power to order such improvements or alterations as they may think desirable; and generally the supervision, direction and control of all other requirements of the corporation not specified as within the jurisdiction of the committee on lots.

ARTICLE IX.

COMMITTEE ON LOTS.

The committee on lots shall have general supervision and control of all sales, locations, and enlargements of lots, the settlement of values of lots, the fixing of boundaries and settlement of questions relating thereto; the determination of questions of descent or representation under the Act of 3rd May, 1853; the issuing of deeds; the form and making of contracts with proprietors of lots for the annual or perpetual care of such lots, or for the care, repair or preservation of monuments or erections thereon.

The committee on lots shall at least once in each year inspect cach lot concerning which a contract for the care thereof shall have been made with the proprietor, to see that the contract has been properly performed.

ARTICLE X.

LOT OWNERS AND LOTS.

All present holders of lots within the premises owned or controlled by the company, and all subsequent grantees of lots therein shall hold the same subject to the limitations following:

1. The said lot shall not be used for any other purpose than as a place of burial.

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2. Subject to the approval of the directors of the company or the executive committee, and to the by-laws and regulations of the company, proprietors of lots may erect and place upon such ! ts any vaults or monuments, with suitable approved inscriptions, and may also, subject to the same limitations, cultivate upon such lots any trees, shrubs, plants or flowers. In the event of such approval to any such erections, monuments, inscriptions, or growth being withheld or being subsequently withdrawn, the same shall be removed by the proprietor or by the directors or executive committee, their servants, agents, or employees.

3. Trees once planted upon any such lot shall not be cut down, removed, or in any way interfered with, except by orders of the directors or the executive committee.

4. Except as hereinafter in this paragraph specified, no work of any kind shall be performed in the cemetery, whether on public or private lots, by other than the authorized employees of the company, or by persons contracting with the company. Work may be done on private lots by the owners, personally, or by workmen permanently in their employ, for purposes not connected with the cemetery; such workmen to be first approved by the directors or the executive committee, and their names communicated by the secretary to the superintendent. Skilled workmen may be employed by lot owners for the erection, maintenance, and repair of monuments or monumental work. The proprietor shall be responsible for all injury done either by himself, or his employees, or workmen to the grounds or other property of the company, or of any other proprietor, and for the removal of all rubbish that may be made in the performance of the said work. The proposed grade of lots must be submitted to the superintendent, and lots when sodded must not be higher than the adjoining lots. All work permitted by this paragraph shall be subject to the direction, supervision and control of the superintendent.

5. Proprietors may not place upon any lots any iron-work, or wire-work, nor any form of fence, coping, edging, hedge, or other enclosure.

6. The deed hereafter to be issued upon sales of lots shall be in the form set forth in Appendix A to these by-laws.

Proprietors of lots of 150 square feet in size shall be entitled to attend meetings of the company, and to vote thereat on all questions under consideration.

ARTICLE XI.

ANNUAL AND PERPETUAL CARE OF LOTS.

The directors, or the committee on lots, may contract with any proprietor for the perpetual care of any lot within the Cemetery, which contract may be for either of the following three classes of service, namely:

1. For the care of grass only, which is designed to cover the keeping of the grass in good condition and properly cut.

- 2. The care of the grass as contemplated in the first class, and also the care of such trees, plants, or shrubs as may be furnished for or placed upon the lot mentioned in the contract, the contract not, however, to include the furnishing of such trees, plants, or shrubs or the replacing of the same when dead or destroyed.
- 3. The care contemplated in the first and second classes, and also the care of such granite, stone, marble, or other work upon such lot as may be designated in such contract, and the care of such additional granite, stone, marble, or other work thereafter placed upon such lot, and which the directors or the committee on lots may by written indorsement upon the contract agree to include in the same.

The contract value of the first class of perpetual service on a full lot of 150 feet square, and also on a half lot, shall be sixty dollars. One lot and a half, one hundred dollars.

For the second and third class of perpetual service on such lots the contract prices shall be of such amount as may be agreed upon by the directors or the consmittee on lots and the lot owners, due regard being had to the size, nature and value of the monuments, or monumental work, and the extent of the work to be performed.

The contract value for the first class of annual care or service shall be:

For a full lot - 150 square feet	*

The directors, or such committee, may refuse to grant perpetual care upon any lot, the condition of which is detrimental or unsatisfactory to them.

The "Perpetual Care Fund," established under the Act of Assembly 61 Victoria, Cap. 60, Sec. 10, shall be kept invested under the direction of the executive committee in bonds or debentures as therein specified, or on deposit in the Banks named.

ARTICLE XII.

PERPETUAL CARE OF GRAVES-SINGLE CARE SECTION.

The directors or the executive committee may set apart within the Cemetery a plot, tract, or section (to be known as the Single Care Section), of size and location by them considered suitable and convenient, for the purpose of selling the same in small allotments for single graves or single interments. The whole of such plot, tract, or section shall be maintained by the company under perpetual care of the first class, and for each interment therein there shall be collected the sum of seven dollars, with an increase of two dollars should such interment be made on Sunday. Of such sum of seven dollars, or nine dollars, as the case may be, one dollar and fifty cents shall be collected on account of the Perpetual Care Fund, and shall be added thereto.

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The lot committee may adopt a simple form of Perpetual Care Contract securing to the holder thereof the perpetual care of the first class of any grave within the said section, and such contract may be signed by the superintendent on behalf of the company, or may be executed in such other manner as the said committee may designate.

No mounds shall be permitted over or upon any grave or graves within the Single Care Section. The lot committee may make, alter, or vary regulations relating to the size, quality, or design of the head-stones or markers which may be placed within such section.

ARTICLE XIII.

STONE AND MONUMENTAL WORK.

All monuments, monumental work and headstones must rest either upon the solid rock or upon foundations satisfactory to the superintendent, built to a depth of at least five feet below the surface of the ground.

REGULATIONS.

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HOURS.

The Cemetery gates shall be open every day from 1st May to 1st November from 7.30 a. m. to 8 p. m., and during the remainder of the year from 8 a. m. to 4.30 p. m.

VISITORS,

Except on Sundays and holidays visitors are allowed to enter the Cemetery at any time between the above hours.

PROPRIETORS.

Proprietors and their families may receive from the secretary tickets entitling them to visit the Cemetery on Sundays and holidays between the above hours, as well as upon other occasions.

CARRIAGES, ETC.

Carriages must not be driven faster than a walk, nor turned in any avenue, and no horse shall be left unfastened without a driver.

PROHIBITIONS.

All persons are forbidden, while within the cemetery grounds -

To disturb the quiet and good order of the Cemetery by any noise or improper conduct.

To gather flowers, or to damage any growing plant, shrub, or tree.

To ride any bicycle - bicyclists must dismount.

To ride or drive any horse faster than a walk.

To smoke in any part of the grounds.

To bring or use within the Cemetery any food or other refreshment.

To bring dogs, running at large, within the limits.

To damage or remove any structure, or to erect the same without authority.

Under penalty of instant dismissal from the grounds, and, on refusal, of ejection; and under penalty of prosecution for misdemeanor.

UNPAID BILLS.

No work will be performed on any lot on which there remains on the first day of April any unpaid bill of any previous year or years.

RECEIVING TOMB.

The receiving tomb shall only be used for bodies intended for interment in the cemetery, and where the wish and consent of some lot owner that the same shall be buried in his lot has been previously ascertained, except in cases approved of by the executive committee.

Remains of persons dying of a contagious disease will not be placed in the receiving tomb except on special permit from the Board of Health specifying that the rules of the Board, regarding such cases, have been complied with.

CHARGES.

The charges for the use of the receiving tomb, exclusive of the interment fee, shall be:

For an adult for the period of two months	\$3	00

Such fees, including the interment fees, to be paid in advance.

BURIAL FEES.

Until otherwise ordered, the scale of burial fees shall be as follows: For persons of the age of fourteen years and upwards-In the Public Ground (so called) in addition to \$3 for the ground in the case of each interment, \$4...... 7 00 In the Sessions Ground...... 4 00 In the Marine Hospital Lot...... 4 00 In the Poor Ground, in addition to \$2 for the ground in the case of each interment, \$3...... 5 00 For children above the age of six and under fourteen years-In the Public Ground, in addition to \$2 for the ground in the case of each interment, \$3...... 5 00 In the Sessions Ground...... 3 00 In the Poor Ground, in addition to \$2 for the ground in the case of each interment, \$2...... 4 00 For children under the age of six years-In Private Lots...... 2 00 In the Public Ground, in addition to \$1.50 for the ground in the case of each interment, \$2...... 3 50 In the Sessions Ground...... 2 00 In the Poor Ground, in addition to \$1 for the ground in the case of each interment, \$1...... 2 00

SUNDAYS.

In the case of an interment on Sunday an advance of fifty per cent. on the above rates will be charged. REMOVALS.

In the case of removals within the Cemetery the charge will be fifty per cent. in advance of the above rates for opening both graves.

REMOVALS FROM PUBLIC GROUND.

No allowance will be made for space vacated by removals for the public ground. OMNIBUSES.

Omnibuses will not be admitted to the grounds.

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Hackmen must remain by their horses while waiting at funerals, to prevent damage to borders, shrubs, or trees; they must conform, while within the Cemetery, to all directions given them by the superintendent.

Soliciting employment, either verbally or by any form of advertisement, is forbidden, as is also the standing or waiting within the grounds in expectation of employment, or when not forming part of a funeral procession.

Hackowners will be held responsible for any damage occasioned by their coaches, or horses, or for any neglect or refusal of their employees to observe the company's regulations.

FUNERALS AND BURIALS.

Twenty-four hours notice for graves must be given to the superintendent, otherwise the management cannot guarantee to be ready; and in all cases the box, if slate vaults be not ordered, must be sent at once to the grounds or its exact size communicated to the superintendent.

Undertakers must observe all requirements of the superintendent, or directions given them by him.

Funerals and funeral processions on arriving at the grounds will be subject to the orders of the superintendent.

No burial of a person other than a member of the family of a lot owner will be allowed in any lot except on written permission of the lot owner filed in the office of the company, and no lot owner will be allowed to dispose of any grave or graves for a remuneration.

Only one body will be allowed in a grave except in the case of a mother and child, in which case special permission must be obtained from the superintendent and an additional fee of \$1.00 paid.

CONTRACTORS AND WORKMEN.

Soliciting any form of labor or employment, or the sale of any article, by any method, within the Cemetery, is prohibited.

Persons, other than lot owne's or their families, having work to perform within the Cemetery, must make known their business in detail to the superintendent, and obtain proper permits, before the work is begun.

Ropes or supports must not be fastened to posts, monuments, trees, or other objects, without special permission from the superintendent. Sufficient padding must be used around trees to protect them.

To protect paths, grass, or gutters from injury, planks must be laid upon them when heavy material is to be moved over them.

The use of "shoe drags," or of any other form of brake, which, in the opinion of the superintendent is liable to injure the roads or paths in the Cemetery, is strictly prohibited.

Material for the building of vaults or foundations, for the erecting of monuments or the improving of lots, shall not be deposited in the Cemetery until required for immediate use; nor shall any such material, under any circumstances, be placed on the property of adjoining lot owners; no such material

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Material not likely to be immediately used will be removed by the superintendent at the expense of the owner.

A canvas or other covering must be supplied by the contractor or builder on which to deposit earth or other material while work is going on, and all rubbish made must be removed without delay.

Work when commenced must be finished without unnecessary delay.

No workmen will be allowed in the grounds after the bell rings in the evening for the dismissal of the men, unless by special permission.

Work must be suspended in the immediate vicinity of an interment until the conclusion of all religious services.

Foundations for headstones must not be less than one foot thick.

The first course of masonry above the foundation, and all monument and other bases, must be bedded off to an equal thickness, as no building up or underpinning with chips, spalls, cement, or other material will be allowed. All monument bases, except stone posts, must be set in a bed of cement or mortar evenly covering the foundation.

All contractors, builders, and their employees are subject to the control of the superintendent while within the Cemetery, and must conform to his directions; on neglect or refusal they may be prohibited from working on the grounds.

SINGLE GRAVE SECTION.

Head-stones must be three feet high from base, one foot six inches wide, and two inches thick.

CLUBS, SOCIETIES, AND ASSEMBLIES.

Except at funerals, clubs, fraternal societies, and all other large bodies or assemblies of persons, will not be permitted to enter the grounds. The executive committee may, however, in their discretion vary or suspend this regulation, but subject to such directions as they may consider expedient.

Report of Directors.

St. John, N. B., April 4, 1898.

St. John Rural Cemetery Company:

Gentlemen: — The directors beg to submit, for your information, their fourth report, under the new regime, of the work accomplished or in progress during the past year.

They have completed the design of filling, and grading the gravel pit, so called, and the lots near it, making the section there very attractive. The lots in it are all drained by a thorough and expensive method, and are now ready for sale.

The improvement of the section at the front, or marsh, entrance of the Cemetery has been commenced, and they hope to have it finished in the course of the present season. Drain pipes eighteen inches in diameter are laid down from end to end of it, which will make all the lots there perfect so far as drainage is concerned.

But the principal and most important achievement of the year has been the purchase of the adjoining property, consisting of 34½ acres of land, with a dwelling house and barns, and making the area of the Cemetery now to be 144½ acres—sufficient to supply the wants of the city for a century.

The proprietors of lots, at a very recent meeting, approved unanimously of this addition to the Cemetery and of the issue of debentures to the extent of \$4,500 for the payment and improvement thereof. They approved at the same time of a Bill, which has since become a law, embracing sundry provisions regulating certain features of their business, and exempting the land from taxation of all kinds.

There was a little uncertainty in the minds of some persons as to the legality of the perpetual care contracts entered into by the company, and as to the perpetual safety of the moneys received by them on this account. These doubts are now set at rest, as the Act provides for them in future, and makes the moneys now absolutely secure.

The directors have repeatedly called the attention of the lotholders to the advantages of placing their lots under perpetual care. They can do so now with the fullest assurance and authority. It relieves them for ever of any anxiety on account of the state of the place where the remains of those they love are laid; it proves to all that they are not forgotten, and at the same time each lot so dealt with adds to the attraction of the whole Cemetery, and thus benefits every one.

It may be useful and proper for them to state that the Act in amendment of their charter legalizes the issue of debentures, including those now outstanding, to \$10,000, and extends the rights and powers of the "Joint Stock Companies' Act" to this company. And while it does not greatly enlarge the powers of the company, it clearly gives to them, without the necessity of inference or argument,

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those general powers which are frequently called, though rather indefinitely, the inherent powers of a corporation. For example these are:

The power of the directors to make by-laws for all purposes of the company, subject to confirmation by the !.tholders.

The power in the directors in all things to administer the affairs of the company, and to make or cause to be made for the company any description of contract which they may by law enter into.

The right is granted of acquiring, holding, or conveying real estate for the purposes of the company.

The company may, if desired, change its name without appealing to the Legislature by simple petition to the Governor in Council.

A copy of any by-law of the company certified under seal is prima facie evidence in all courts.

The right is given to make promissory notes and bills of exchange if so desired. The company may maintain any form of action against any of its members.

It follows now from this outline of the enlarged powers given to the company, and in order to quiet any doubts as to the legality of their by-laws, they deemed it to be advisable to revise, amend, and consolidate them. This work has been carefully done without altering or changing materially any single by-law. They are put in such a form as any court of law may recognize and enforce them if necessary. The directors recommend that they be now approved and enacted, and together with all Acts of the Local Legislature relating to the company be printed and circulated among the proprietors.

One great object which they had in view in acquiring possession of the Trafton property was to secure a proper drainage of a large section of the Cemetery; another was to make a new entrance into it from the Westmorland road on an easier grade than the present one. The drain is completed, but to construct the new avenue it will be necessary to borrow a sufficient sum for that purpose. This work can be done this year, and in future years, when the land adjacent to it is properly graded, laid out with roads and paths through it, on some artistic design, the whole aspect of this section will be so changed as to form the finest part of their grounds. The proposed new avenue will be 40 feet wide and 1,200 feet in length. It will be a grand approach to the Cemetery. Trees will be planted on either side of it as soon as it is in order and the land repared for them.

There is another improvement which they have long desired to effect, and that is the construction of a shelter house in a central part of the Cemetery. It is necessary for several good reasons, and it can be made both useful and ornamental. It will at the same time clear and dress up a part of the Cemetery now very unsightly, unfit for interment, and difficult to improve in any way.

To secure both of these improvements they recommend that \$1,500 be borrowed at four per cent. interest per annum, payable in fifteen years from the first of May next.

They have considered for some time that the location of single graves was quite unfit and unsuitable. It was out of the way, on the side of a hill, and

The price of a grave is reduced, and, in future, it will be cared for by the company in perpetuity without any additional charge to the owner. Thus due respect and honor will be paid to the remains of those interred there. A by-law to govern this section will be submitted for your approval.

The financial position of the company is clearly presented in the accounts of Mr. F. O. Allison, secretary-treasurer. These have been carefully audited and pronounced to be correct by Mr. R. Murray Boyd, whose report is suomitted therewith: ON GENERAL ACCOUNT.

It thus appears from this statement that their receipts have fallen short of their expenditure to the extent of \$1,001.91. The reason for this can be readily explained. They retired a bond of \$200, paid for the washout in 1897; for new drain tiles, \$169; for new carriage house, \$185; trees, \$118 - charges some of which will not be repeated. On the other hand they have hay for sale valued at \$250; slate vaults, \$100, and \$246 still uncollected on annual care account.

They also expended \$60 in obtaining full and complete indices of the names of all the interments in the Cemetery. This work was necessary owing to the difficulty and delay in completing a search through the Cemetery records, and has already been found to be extremely useful. The total number of interments recorded is 12,933.

The Perpetual Care Fund continues to grow rapidly, and will do so still more rapidly when it becomes generally known that moneys on this account are now

placed under the guardianship of the law. The number of contracts entered into last year was twenty-five — making the total to be ninety-three. The moneys received was \$3,149.50, making the total now to be \$9,244.79.

The funded debt of the company amounts to \$6,700 - \$2,200 at 5 % and \$4,500 at 4 % interest.

A report is submitted from Mr. J. P. Clayton, superintendent, giving in detail an account of work done during the year. He has discharged the duties of his office to their entire satisfaction.

They addressed a memorial to the Marine Department of the Federal Government calling attention to the neglected state of the Seamen's Lot, and urging, for several reasons, that an appropriation be made towards it. They offered to accept \$1,000 to put and keep it in perpetual order. Correspondence is still proceeding on the subject, and they hope to receive a favorable reply in a short time. The matter has been brought before Parliament by Mr. Ellis, to whom they are much indebted for the interest he has taken in it.

Complaints have been made to them of the defective drainage of certain lots in some old and long settled sections. They hope to apply a remedy as far as possible this year, but it must not be forgotten that this work ought to have been done when the lots were purchased many years ago. It is scarcely reasonable, to say the least, that the present directors should be held responsible for the neglect of their predecessors. In the new sections drainage is provided for, and considered to be absolutely essential before disposing of a lot.

It must also not be forgotten that any work which they now undertake is done to the best of their ability, and with the utmost desire to secure the best results and please every one interested. But, nevertheless, they sometimes fail in their efforts, and while submitting to fair criticism, ask that due consideration be extended to them for good intentions, and to their successors in office.




