NOTICE TO HOLDERS OF TIMBER LICENSES

Curse Laws Order, 24 July, 1896. The attention of all holders of Timber Licenses is called to Section 19 of the Timber Regulations, which reads as follows:—

"No Spruce or Pine trees shall be cut by any Licensee under any license, not even for fuel, which will make a log, at least 18 feet in length and ten inches at the small end, and if any such shall be cut, the Licensee shall be liable to double damages and the Licensee be forfeited."

The above Law is hereby notified, that for the future, the provisions of this section will be rigidly enforced.
