**CHANGE TO METRIC SYSTEM**

**DOES NOT MEAN CONFUSION**

Former Minister to Norway and Sweden Gives History of Its Adoption There.

Referring to the fear that a change from the English units of weights and measures to the metric system would entail confusion in the minds of the people, Mr. Ferguson of Washington, former minister to Sweden and Norway, gives testimony on how the change was brought about in those countries.

"You will observe," said he, "that this scale is marked in two ways: The metric units are indicated on one side and the English units on the other. In order to facilitate the change from the old system to the new the Swedish government marked the metric equivalents on any scale sent to it by any citizen. At first the merchant or housewife would be puzzled by the two scales, but would note the metric equivalent until they were as familiar with the one as with the other.

"The period of transition in Norway occupied about three years. During the first year or two the people had the old weights had them corrected by the government, so that the 'kiloponds,' which is about one English pound, was increased to one-half kilogram. The old steel yards were changed to make the metric of weight on the beam equal to one-half kilogram for each old pound. The bureau made for each yard a bushel, and 70 liters made a half bushel. I obtained in 1872 a report from the Swedish officer of assay and control on the results of the change in Norway. This report says that the metric system was introduced in Sweden in 1876. STREET CARS NEED SPACE  
LOOPS AND EXTENSIONS

Works Committee Adopts Report  
and Council Will Consider It  
at Special Meeting.

Mayor Coatsworth announced to the city works committee yesterday afternoon that he would call a special meeting of the council next Monday to consider the report the committee had just adopted in regard to the street railway loops and extensions. Engineers' recommendations were not all concurred in without numerous suggestions as to better plans and details. It was pointed out that the adoption of a more detailed scheme particularly in regard to down town extensions and what hours they would be operated would be to the convenience of the citizens as well as that of the Street Railway Company.

The outcome of the many close conferences which have been held and at which the city representatives and those of the Toronto Railway Company, at a special meeting of the works committee to go on to council, it is in the opinion of the mayor, to extend and lay down a double line of rails on Lansdowne-avenue from College-street to York-street, to be paved with granite blocks at the cost of \$287,000, to be covered by an issue of debentures. Ald. McBride spoke strongly in favor of a line from that street to come east by the Arthur-street route.

The proposed Scott-street extension was endorsed. It provides for a double line of rails on Scott-street from Front-street to connect with tracks to be laid on Wellington-street, the track allowance created thereby on Lansdowne-avenue to be paved with granite blocks at the cost of \$287,000. The Wellington-street extension would be from Scott to Yonge, paved with granite blocks or concrete, to cost \$150,000.

There was a lot of discussion over the proposed double line of rails on Richmond-street from York to Victoria. At a cost of \$187, which also includes the cost of widening the present railway on Victoria-street, from Richmond to Queen at a cost of \$272, for track allowance and for the street widening.

### STRAIGHT BUSINESS MATTER ARGUMENT OF SUPPLY MEN

Choice Between Custom of 5 or 95 Per Cent. of Trade—Lodge Membership Combinations.

G. H. Watson commenced his argument before Chief Justice Mulock yesterday in behalf of Alexander A. McMichael, P. McMichael and H. P. Lodge membership combinations are no more necessary or proper than meetings among men of business. He can refuse to sell or he can charge high or low prices. No person can tell him how to conduct his business, that is his own affair.

"The acts of these men are only reasonable and fair," continued Mr. Watson. "It was a hold-up by the plumbers, but it was a hold-up by the option was offered to them of selling to the 5 per cent. or to the 95 per cent. Any business which did that these men did are only fit for the lunatic asylum."

The argument will be continued in the judge's chambers at Osogood Hall to-day.

### PRIVATE BILLS COMMITTEE. Making of Lawyers by Act of Parliament is Discussed.

Asked for his personal view he declined to give it, saying he appeared as an advocate and had presented the case fairly. Mr. Bruce of the Law Society, Chairman Carleton, Hon. J. E. Foy and G. H. Ferguson strongly opposed the admission, while Hon. A. G. McKay and others scored the Law Society for appearing a year ago in favour of a similar application. The committee decided to admit Mr. Redman, who had been 19 years in the law at a cost of \$20,000. ### CITY AFTER CHEAP POWER ASK GOVERNMENT PLAN

So That Niagara Falls Might Furnish Ontario Municipalities at Reasonable Rates.

"Whereas the power at Niagara Falls is a heritage of the people and its benefits should be conserved for the people; and whereas there is no regulation sufficiently effective to enable the people to obtain power at reasonable rates from the holders of any existing franchise; therefore, be it resolved that the municipal council of the City of Toronto do memorialize the Ontario government, strongly urging the necessity of the government themselves at once proceeding to establish a plant at Niagara Falls for the purpose of developing electric power for distribution to Ontario municipalities, and further that the co-operation of other Ontario municipalities in the matter be requested."

The above resolution was presented by Controller Jones to the location and reception committee of the city council at a meeting yesterday afternoon, and was endorsed after a very light discussion. But the seriousness of the subject was not overlooked. In view of the coming appointment of a commissioner of industries the probability of power at reasonable rates will be a great help to their new official in doing his work.

The committee also dealt with Ald.
