The FOURTH ANNUAL MEETING of the NEW BRUNSWICK and PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND CONFERENCE, began in FREDERICTON, N.B., at 9 o'clock, a.m., on Thursday, June 28th, 1877, the REV. ROBERT DUNCAN, President in the chair.

After the reading of the Scriptures by the Secretary, the 478th hymn was sung and the Revds. John Lathern and John Prince offered prayer.

3. That more attention should be paid to the theological education of our children, and to this end we would urge a more general use of the admirable Catechisms of our Church.

4. That we think it advisable to hold a public meeting in the interests of Sabbath-school work, in connexion with each annual District Meeting, similar to that held at the Conference, and that a collection be taken on such occasions in aid of the funds of said Society.

5. That following the example of the British Wesleyan Conference, and the General Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church, we think the time has come when some brother should be set apart to this work, and the Conference is respectfully recommended to give this matter its most serious consideration.

6. From the subjoined schedule we rejoice to learn that there has been an increase in the number of Schools, Scholars, Teachers and Receipts, as compared with last year.

I. THE DESTRUCTION OF CONNEXIONAL BUILDINGS  
BY FIRE IN SAINT JOHN,

Whereas, in the recent fire in St. John, relatively the most awful calamity of the kind that has ever fallen on any city on this continent, two churches and parsonages and a mission chapel have been destroyed, and the congregations connected with them have suffered such losses of personal property as must make it impossible for them to restore the connexional buildings: *Therefore* resolved,

(1.) That believing the sympathy of Methodists everywhere will respond to an appeal made in behalf of the churches of the desolated city, we immediately appoint deputations to solicit subscriptions for the re-building of the churches and parsonages in St. John.

(2.) That Rev. Howard Sprague, M. A., Secretary of the Conference, and Pastor of the Centenary Church, destroyed by the fire, be appointed to visit England immediately for this purpose: that the Rev. R. Duncan and Rev. H. McKeown, visit the United States; that the Rev. D. D. Currie and the Rev. J. Lathern visit our Western Conferences; that the Rev. Jos. Hart and Rev. S. T. Teed, visit Nova Scotia; that the Rev. E. Evans and Rev. S. R. Ackman be the deputation for the Conference of New Brunswick and P. E. Island, and Rev. Dr. Stewart for Newfoundland.

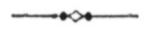

(2) That, as Financial Agent of the Conference; as the originator and, for many years, the Secretary-Treasurer of the Supernumerary Fund; as Book Steward and Editor of the Provincial Wesleyan, taking the charge of these interests, at a time when they had become greatly embarrassed, and, by successful management putting them in a better condition than they had ever been in before, Dr. Pickard has placed our Church in the Maritime Provinces under great and lasting obligation.

(3) That, as Principal of the Educational Institutions at Sackville, for the period of twenty-seven years, from the opening of the Male Academy in 1843, his devotion to the cause of education, his untiring energy, and wise administration were instrumental in raising those Institutions to a very prosperous and influential position, and have won for him a place not only in the grateful memory of the Church, but also in the public history of our land.

(4) That, in granting his request, the Conference assures Dr Pickard, that it does so with a sincere regret that the necessity for it exists, and with the hope and prayer that he may long be spared to give to the councils and enterprises of our Church, the benefit of his experience, and administrative ability; and that the remaining years of his life may, by the blessing of Heaven, be years of continued health and peace.

### III. THE ANNUITANT SOCIETY.

That the Conference approves of the formation of a Mutual Annuitant Society, and of the appointment of a Committee to prepare, during the year, Rules and Regulations for such a Society, and to furnish each member of the Conference with a printed copy of them before the meeting of Conference next year.

**APPENDIX I.**  
**STANDING ORDERS.**

**I.—DISTRICT MEETINGS.**

The Chairmen of Districts are peremptorily required to procure three complete copies of the Minutes of the several annual and other meetings of the District Committees, financial and ordinary, duly signed by the Chairman and Secretary; one of these copies shall be inserted in the District Records, the second shall be reserved for the use of the Conference, and the third shall be delivered to the Secretary for preservation in the archives of the Conference. Furthermore, it is required that the last mentioned copies be handed in on the forenoon of the day preceding that on which our first preparatory committee meeting may be appointed to be held, that the secretaries may prepare classified lists of all matters which are to come before the Conference, and thereby expedite business.

2. That as much trouble has been caused at different sessions of Conference in consequence of alterations made in the District Minutes, it is determined that when the Minutes of the several Districts shall have been signed by the Chairmen and Secretaries, they shall not be altered, except by special permission of the Conference.

**II.—PROVINCIAL WESLEYAN.**

That in regard to subscriptions for the *Wesleyan*, inquiry is to be instituted in the District Committees respectively, as to the fidelity of each brother responsible for the collection of such moneys—the accounts being previously sent to the chairmen, and distributed at the Annual District Meetings.

**III.—MISSIONARY LISTS.**

Each Superintendent is required to present, at the Annual District Meeting, prepared on foolscap paper and made up in Canada currency, a perfect list of all Missionary moneys col-

lected on his circuit; and each Chairman is required to present such lists to the Missionary Secretary, in a state ready for publication, on the day previous to the meeting of the Missionary Committee.

#### IV.—CHILDREN'S FUND.

The Financial Secretaries of the several Districts are required to send to the Secretary of the Children's Fund, immediately after the Annual District meeting, the names of all the Ministers in their respective Districts, who are claimants upon the Children's Fund for the current year; and to state the number of children for whom allowance is claimed; and, as far as possible, the name and date of birth of each of the said children.

#### V.—BOOK ROOM ACCOUNTS.

*Resolved.* That every Minister and Preacher is peremptorily required to settle his account with the Book Steward each year, at or before the meeting of Conference.

#### VI.—TIME FOR COLLECTIONS IN AID OF THE CONNEXIONAL FUNDS.

#### VII.—FINANCIAL ECONOMY.

The Conference recommends to the Quarterly Official Meetings of the several circuits the following plan, by which it is hoped they may more effectually secure the amount necessary to meet the allowance of the ministers and preachers:—

1. Let the Quarterly Boards, at the beginning of each financial year, estimate the amount needed for the year.

3. Let these sums be entered by a Steward appointed for that purpose in a book which he shall keep as Treasurer of the Quarterly Board

4. If the total amount of these sums does not equal the amount needed, then let the Steward apportion the deficiency among all such as are willing, for Christ's sake, to assume such deficiency, setting down to each person, with his or her consent, the additional amount which they think he or she ought weekly or monthly to pay.

5. Let the Steward then adopt and carry out the plan by which every one shall have the opportunity of regularly contributing each week or month by envelope or otherwise, not grudgingly or of necessity, the sum which has been pledged by him or her. Let these contributions be paid over regularly to the Steward appointed to receive them, and be brought up by him to the Quarterly Meeting. The said Steward shall keep an individual account of all these pledges and contributions, and shall pay over the same, under the direction of the Quarterly official Meetings, to the preacher or preachers authorized to receive them.

6. That Quarterly Official Meetings, adopting the envelope system, be recommended not to include in their estimate the claims of Missions, but to provide for these as in times past by special collections and subscriptions.

7. That in the opinion of this Conference, the minimum salary of ministers should be \$750.

8. That in the opinion of this Conference, the minimum amount of young men's salary should be \$200.

9. That in the opinion of this Conference, the salary of ordained, but unmarried, ministers should be \$520.

10. When a deficiency occurs upon a Circuit having two preachers (a married and single man), it shall be borne by each, according to a *pro rata* amount.

#### VIII.—MINISTERS REMOVING.

In the case of ministers removing, they shall be held responsible for the supply of the pulpits on the Circuits which they are leaving, for two Sabbaths after the close of the Conference, and shall be required to provide for the pulpits of their new Circuits on the third Sabbath after Conference.

DEARLY BELOVED BRETHREN :—

Assembled in Annual Conference we again greet you in the name of our common Lord. Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. We gratefully record the fact that since our last Annual Address to you our ministerial ranks have not been broken by death.

As usual our Session has been devoted to a thorough consideration of the affairs of our Church, and its various Funds and Institutions have passed under review. These all originated in necessities most urgent and continuous and are worthy of your liberal support.

We have noted with much satisfaction, the steady growth of our Educational Institutions at Sackville. greatly increased circulation. Our Book Room you will be glad to know continues to prosper. In its carefully selected books for Sabbath School libraries and general reading you have at reasonable cost a literature that ought effectually to shut out of your homes, everything of a merely sentimental and spurious character. As of vital importance, we advise you to guard well the reading matter of your families which so largely moulds the character and directs the life.

The increasing number and efficiency of our Sabbath Schools is highly gratifying and gives much promise for the future. This Institution of the Church is worthy of your continued interest and most generous support. See to it that the children and youth of your community, so far as they are under your care and control have the advantages which the Sabbath School is designed to afford.

We commend to your co-operation the cause of Temperance. The vice with which this reform purposes to grapple meets us at every step in our work and is one of appalling magnitude, most hostile and defiant in its attitude towards the Church of God. Let your position in regard to it be no doubtful one. With emphasis we repeat the admonition of our great Founder against drunkenness, buying or selling spirituous liquors, or using them unless in case of extreme necessity.

With us you have been stunned with the suddenness and extent of the desolating fire in the city of St. John. By this appalling calamity, property to the value of nearly Thirty Millions of dollars has been destroyed, and thousands of families rendered homeless, while several persons have lost their lives. Among the sufferers are several of our ministerial brethren, who have met with heavy financial loss. Three of our churches have been consumed and their congregations left without a sanctuary in which to worship God. The case of these suffering ones should promptly secure our sympathy and aid.

Watching over your souls as those that must give account, we rejoice in your steadfast adherence to our doctrines and discipline. As intelligent students of the Word of God, be ever ready to give a reason of the hope that is in you. Seek to conform your life to the truth you accept. Give no countenance to the dissipating ball-room or popular dance. The friendship of the world is enmity against God. Known and read of all men be ye living epistles. In

constant conflict with sin in its various forms put on the whole armor of God. Quit you like men; be strong. Called not unto uncleanness but unto holiness, leave the principles of the doctrine of Christ and go unto perfection. In the prosecution of your Christian course you need all possible help. The earnest and devout of our membership have all along the history of our Church set a high value on the class-meeting. Do not forsake your place there; forsake not the assembling of yourselves together, as the manner of some is, but exhort one another daily, and so much the more as ye see the day approaching. Regularly take your place in the prayer-meeting, at the table of the Lord, and in the public congregation. "Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy." Forget not its Divine appointment, its sanctity and constant obligation. Not less important are the obligations of family religion. Upon parents we would impress the duty of training your children in the nurture, and admonition of the Lord. By godly precept and example create in your homes such an atmosphere as will conduce to the growth of whatsoever things are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, and of good report.

## APPENDIX IV.

Our summary of the present state of our Missionary work must be necessarily brief, but the facts which we are able to note are very suggestive.

At the last Annual Meeting of the Society held in connection with the meeting of the Central Board, it was reported that there were then 42 Missions to the Indians—with 31 Missionaries, 6 native teachers and six Ministers who aid the Missions near their own Circuits. These have a membership of 3,334, an increase within the year of 305.

In Japan there were then two stations, with Messrs. Geo. Cochran and Davidson McDonald, M. D., to care for them. Since that time Messrs. Eby and Meacham have arrived in the country, and have entered upon their work under the most encouraging circumstances. The French and German Missions present interesting features, and the former Mission, particularly, is full of promise.

The domestic Missions throughout the Dominion are doing so important a work, and are doing that work so successfully in widening the influence of the church and in leading souls to Christ that they demand continued and generous support. In the six Conferences there are 339 Missions, 383 Missionaries and 36,472 Church members. A recapitulation of all Missions, including Japan, shows the following exhibit:—

Missions, 424; Missionaries, 460; members, 40,937. There are 30 day schools with teachers, and 21 interpreters; the total number of the paid agents of the Missionary Board being 517.

The entire income of the Society was \$162,639.73, and the expenditure \$158,677.64—giving an excess of income over expenditure of 3,962.09—by which the debt of the Society has been slightly reduced; the debt remaining being \$25,338.70.
