**An Act to remove all doubts as to the manner of constructing gates on lands intersected by Railways, and to facilitate the communication therewith to the parties concerned.**

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Railway Clauses Consolidation Act, and to remove all doubts as to the manner of constructing gates on lands intersected by Railways, and to facilitate the communication therewith to the parties concerned; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: Preamble.

I. The words "*openings, gates or bars,*" contained in the thirteenth section of the Act above cited, shall be held to mean and shall in all cases imply frame gates upon iron hinges, opening and shutting with a wooden cross bar: Provided always, that nothing in this Act shall be interpreted to the profit of those proprietors and tenants of lands crossed by Railways in this Province, who have already received compensation from the Railway Companies, for having omitted the erection of the said gates.
