BREACH OF PROMISE.

A faithless widower and his injured love.

A Queer Way of Escaping Matrimony.

A Promise to Marry Settled for \$60; but a further Demand of \$1,000 on the part of the Lady—The Plaintiff Non-suit.

At the Assize on Thursday morning, the case of Robert v. Booth was the first to be called. Messrs. Rose & Blackstock announced that they were ready to go on behalf of the plaintiff, and Mr. Fullerton said that he was prepared with the defence. The case was one involving a breach of promise of marriage. The plaintiff, who claimed to have been the companion of a Miss Selina Roberts, has been in Canada about ten years, and has resided for a considerable portion of her time with her first and second husbands—Mr. and Mrs. Frank Anderson—of Leveille. At the house of her relatives she met the defendant, Mr. Samuel Booth, a builder, doing a good business in the eastern part of the city, and a resident of the vicinity of Leveille. Mr. Booth, who is a widower, set out, courted her for some considerable time, and finally a few months before the birth of their child—promised to marry her. This promise he failed to carry out, hence the suit for damages. For the defence, the plaintiff put in, first, the promise he had given; and, secondly, that all liabilities for damages were settled, by agreement, between the parties concerned for the sum of \$60.

The case was opened by Mr. Blackstock, who detailed at some length the various attentions which the defendant had paid to the plaintiff and alleged promises which he had made to her, which had resulted in her making preparations for marriage, which the defendant had failed to carry out. Besides all this, the defendant had seduced the plaintiff, and had not only seduced her, but had also seduced her child, and was now considering the extent of the damages to be assessed.

The first witness called was FRANK ANDERSON, of Leveille. He said defendant is a builder in the east end of the city. At his own request he was during last August several months introduced to the plaintiff, who was then companion to a lady, and a frequent visitor at his house. She is his wife's aunt. Plaintiff had been living with her for some time. One night in November last, defendant came to my house with Miss Roberts and introduced her as his wife. She was very much excited about it, and afterwards told me that she had come back to marry her. He had gone away with the intention of not marrying her, but his wife would not let him do so. He turned with a view to marrying her on the following Sunday. We went away to get a license, and told her that we were going to his house on Sunday, and Rev. Mr. O'Leary would marry her to him. He afterwards came back to me, and said he could not marry her.

"Did he give any reason?" "Yes, he said that to marry her would be a bitter dose."

"Did he turn up on the Sunday to get married?" "When next did you see him?" "I think Miss Roberts went to see him next, but he put the marriage off. I know Mr. Booth's handwriting. Defendants brought Miss Roberts to our house one day in the spring and introduced her as his wife. I did not know her, but she was saying anything to them about their marriage, which she only stayed at the house five minutes, and then she went away. I think the Misses Padden were there. I partly believed that they were married."
