REPORT.

To the Friends and Supporters of the Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada :—

DEAR FRIENDS,—It affords us much pleasure again to address you as our wont is. Since the last report was published one more year of trial and blessing, of labour and reaping, of conflict and triumph has passed. Those who in the order of Providence have the responsibility of conducting and prosecuting the work of our Lord Jesus Christ in connection with Christian Missions, either foreign or domestic, cannot expect to be free from the trial of their faith and endurance. To those who have the oversight of Missions there are many things that are trying and perplexing to be grappled with. So it is in all the walks of life. We may not expect to engage in anything great or good without meeting with difficulties ; nor need we hope to achieve anything of lasting benefit to the world without conflict ; and we are persuaded none know the truth of this better than Christian missionaries, whether at home or abroad, and those who have the direction of mission work. But, it is also as true, that in no field of labour are results more sure. No seed is more certain to spring up and rejoice the labourer's heart with a rich harvest than the seed of God's word faithfully sown. No trials are succeeded by such rich blessings, and no conflicts have such glorious triumphs. The object for which Jesus came to this world was to teach and suffer and die, and rise again, that he might save sinful lost souls—that by faith in Him they might be renewed in righteousness, made holy, happy and useful during life on earth, and then be taken to the home of blessedness, which He has prepared for His sanctified ones. For whom He sanctifies, them He also glorifies.

This blessed work of saving people, in which angels would delight to engage, God condescends to call believing saved men and women to engage in. How highly honored are they? They are co-workers together with God—divine and human agency combining to promote the divine glory by sanctifying and saving sinful human souls,—such is the purpose of God in the preaching of the gospel of His grace. Such is the object of Christian missions—and such the work of Christian missionaries. To such work the universal Church of Christ is called—is called of God. She has received her commission to preach the gospel in all the world and to every creature, and what the primary work of the church universal is, all the sections of the church are called to. Therefore we, as a section of the church, have received our commission. We have our responsibilities in relation to God's purpose to save the world, and God will hold us accountable to himself for the performance of the work he has given us to do. We cannot evade that work and escape condemnation. Nor shall we perform that work and fail in obtaining the rich and honorable reward promised by God to His faithful servants. No one section of the church can lose its identity and responsibility in the whole church, and when the great harvest home day shall come the churches that have gathered sheaves into the Lord's garner shall be recognized by Him and shall have their recompense ; and these words are as true of us as individuals as they are true of us as a church. As individuals we have a work to do, each has his own work to do and sphere to fill, according to the purpose of God, and the gifts which he has bestowed upon us. In great national conflicts all are not called to join the army. Some do, but the majority remain at home to do business, till the ground, provide the nation's bread, and supply munitions of war, and each man at home is responsible as much as the soldier in the field. So in Christian mission work. Some leave home at the churches' call—and God's call—to preach the reconciling word, and they, like the army, look to those left behind at home to supply the means for carrying on the spiritual warfare. They have given up their worldly calling, their means of making money. They have gone forth at the bidding of God and the church to do the work of God and the church. They have gone in faith, faith in

God, faith in the church—in the honesty, sincerity, consistency and liberality of the church, and they and God, whose servants they are, look to the church to honorably, faithfully and cheerfully supply the means for carrying on the good work. Shall our God and His servants look in vain to be sustained in working for the overthrow of Satan's kingdom, in saving people from sin and misery, sanctifying and making them happy forever?

This is a question to which it might reasonably be expected that those composing our membership would unitedly reply "No." This is a work which must be sustained, even if we have to deny ourselves of some luxuries which we have been in the habit of indulging, and if the work is entered into in this spirit by our ministers and people, and followed up by earnest work, and liberal giving, God will give His blessing, and prosperity shall smile on our fields of labour.

During the past year God has blessed the labours of His servants. Numbers of souls have been blessed and gathered into the fold of Christ, as will be seen from the few extracts from mission reports, which we publish in connection with this Report. Our numerical growth is not proportioned to the number of conversions and members brought into the Church, arising from the unsettled and migratory spirit abroad in the country, by which we lose a great many members yearly. But, though in the nature of things we cannot retain them, we may nevertheless thank God for the good they have become the partakers of, and that by the blessing of God they may carry the good seed of the kingdom with them where they go, and so we should rejoice that God counts us worthy to disseminate His word in this manner, and so multiply the number of redeemed souls and bring glory to our glorious Saviour. Who would not feel honoured in taking part in a work so God-like and eternally blessed as that of saving immortal souls from sin and hell, and placing them among the pure and glorified spirits of heaven who have been washed in the blood of the Lamb?

Our friends will be pleased to know that financially we report improvement for the past year. This fact is encouraging both to the missionaries and our subscribers.

For several years past the expenditure exceeded the income a little. This year the balance is on the right side of the sheet. And it is well it is so. As by necessity the English grant is less this year by £100 than last year, and less by £200 than it was three years ago. Our income for the past year has been increased, and it is to be hoped it will this year be increased still more as in view of the diminished grant from England, and the increased number of laborers, there will be increased demands upon the funds. The English Conference has voted us £450, and but for the necessities of the Home Mission Fund this grant would have been more. For this and other evidences of kindness we express to them heartfelt thanks, and the hope that great prosperity will continue to attend them. In reference to the missionary income, as above intimated, it is extremely desirous that it be largely increased this year, and our friends will bear with us while we again refer to the manner in which it may be done. 1. By those contributing who have not hitherto done so. 2. By those who do give increasing their subscriptions. 3. As suggested last year, so we again request our worthy collectors, while they use every effort to secure all the large subscriptions they can, whether new ones or lapsed ones, to look diligently after the small sums. 4. Let the ministers see to the children being engaged in the good work as much as possible, and let the work be entered upon early in the season, and not left as the most important matter to the last. If all these suggestions are taken up and faithfully worked the income this year may be raised to what it was a few years ago. It can be done, friends. We urgently but lovingly appeal to you to help in this object. Let us make the income this year equal to or more than it has ever been before. We can do it. Let it be said of us, they have done what they could. Life is passing, our opportunities for helping the cause of Jesus will soon be past, as they fly let them be improved.

REPORTS FROM STATIONS.

BARRIE.—The past year has been somewhat trying to this Station in the unusually large number of removals of our members and adherents to try their fortunes in the "far west." But our congregations have kept up very well, and the Sunday School has increased two-fold. The church debt has been reduced one-half, and we have purchased a very commodious and comfortable parsonage, and placed it in easy circumstances.—**J. MILNER.**

BRADFORD.—*Dear Bro. Bee.*—I am thankful to say that this Station shows signs of prosperity. There is a marked improvement both in the congregations and spirit of our hearers. Considering the state of this society seven months ago, we are thankful to the Giver of all good that we have held on our way, and that now a brighter day dawns. I leave this station with the good wishes of many very kind friends, praying that under the preaching of Bro. J. Dobson they may increase more and more.—**J. JACKSON.**

BRACEBRIDGE MISSION.—During the past year many souls have been converted on this field, but the large number of removals characteristic of this place prevented us from reporting numerical progress. The Lord has very preciously manifested his presence in many of our services. Our new church at Mathiasville has been finished sufficiently during the year to be opened and occupied, and that appointment has been given to help to form the new Gravenhurst Mission. We have also built a neat and comfortable parsonage during the year. We have retaken up the appointment at Falkenburg. Here, during Rev. R. Pattison's first term on the mission he built a small log church, which was the first church of any kind or denomination built in the Muskoka District; but, all the members having moved away from the neighbourhood, it has not been occupied for several years. We commenced preaching in it during the year, and, after a couple of weeks of special meetings, organized a society of twenty members. We have many discouragements here, but we can truly say, "The Lord of Hosts is with us."—**R. WELLWOOD.**

CARADOC.—*Dear Bro. Bee.*—The past year has been one of earnest and successful toil in leading souls to Christ. Six months out of the twelve were spent in revival services, at which some forty persons were led to accept Christ as a precious personal Saviour. According to our expectations, as stated in last year's report, we have built a handsome frame church in the village of Komoka, 30x40; land and church worth \$1,200, all of which was provided for at the dedication in October last. We have also erected a shed adjoining the Komoka church, 22x60, costing in the neighbourhood of \$100, which will be provided for at the anniversary in October next. The parsonage debt has been reduced \$89. The missionary money has also increased fifty per cent. We are now re-painting and beautifying our Mount Carmel church. The Station is in a healthy condition, and will, we hope at no distant day, ask to become a self-supporting circuit. Missionary money expended on this mission has been money well spent.—**J. E. MOORE.**

CHATHAM STATION.—*Dear Bro. Bee.*—During the last year very strenuous efforts have been put forth to further the interest of the connexion in this part of the work. Two protracted meetings were held, at which thirty-five professed faith in Jesus. After making up for vacancies, caused by removals, deaths, etc., we were able to report a small increase. The ordinary income increased largely, and a very comfortable house has been purchased for a parsonage. The property is worth \$900; is in a pleasant part of the town; and has only a mortgage of \$400, which will be paid yearly in \$100 instalments, interest and principal, as a rent, so that in a few years the whole debt will be removed. The connexion ought to succeed in Chatham, especially now the church debt is so light and a parsonage obtained. May rich blessing of grace fall upon both pastor and people, and this coming year be one of increased prosperity.—**J. DYKE.**

CHARING CROSS BRANCH.—Is in a healthy growing condition. Two protracted meetings were held, both of which succeeded well, giving an increase of thirty members. We need a new church at the Town Line appointment, and then it will not be long be-

fore this Branch is able to sustain a regularly ordained minister. May the brethren upon this part of the work lay the foundation of permanent success.—J. DYKE.

COLLINGWOOD MISSION.—During the past year we held about twelve weeks' protracted meetings, at which about eighty professed to be converted, besides a few at the regular services. After filling all vacancies, caused by removals, fallen, etc., we have an increase of twenty-one members for the year. We have an increase in missionary money of \$42.68; an increase in ordinary income of \$82.38, and nearly all the other funds in proportion. Praying that God may bless us more abundantly during the incoming year, and to Him be all the glory.—I am, yours truly, J. J. NOBLE.

KINGSTON.—With gratitude to the great head of the church we review the labor of the past year. A special meeting held in the winter resulted in a goodly number being converted to God. Twenty-three of whom united with the church. After filling up a loss of twenty, occasioned by death, removals, &c., we were still able to report an increase of members; and while we have attended to the spiritual, we have not been unmindful of the temporal interests of the church. We have paid for repairs and improvements \$157, discharged an old debt, met all current expenses, and paid all claims of quarter day board. Our people are not wealthy, but willing. The Missionary money has gone up more than a 100 per cent. in five years. This has been achieved by the blessing of God on continued effort. Competition on church matters was never so strong since we came here, five years ago, but by working hard, minding our own business, and looking to God for his blessing, we hope to prosper more and more.—Yours, T. W. JOLLIFFE.

MINTO MISSION.—*Dear Bro. Bee,*—During the past two years the great head of the church has been pleased to bless this station with a measure of prosperity. A very neat church has been built in the rising Town of Listowel, which is now estimated at one thousand dollars in value, and when the subscriptions are all collected, will be in very easy circumstances. Here we have a membership of about thirty, and an average attendance of upwards of two hundred people, which gives promise of a prosperous future for this part of our work. After filling up the vacancies for some forty removals and deaths during the two years we have been able to report an increase of eight members. The ordinary income is about One hundred dollars in advance of what it was two years ago. We could earnestly hope that the time is not far distant when this station may become self-sustaining. May a large measure of prosperity attend the labors of the present minister, and Heaven's loving smile rest upon its band of noble office-bearers, is the prayer of yours in Christ, W. HUGGINS.

MCGILLIVRAY WEST CIRCUIT.—*Dear Bro. Bee,*—We are glad to report favourably of this station, both financially and spiritually. The church at Moray has been seated, painted and trimmed, also a set of chandeliers has been provided,—amounting in all to about one hundred dollars; all has been paid for. The Salem church has been repaired inside and the debt lessened considerably. Two new Sabbath schools have been begun and are doing well; also we held two protracted meetings with good success, fifty souls were converted to God. The Missionary money was a little in advance of last year.—H. D. TYLER.

PLATTSVILLE.—Looking over the year just closed we have much to be thankful for. As a rule, the year has been one of earnest striving to promote the work of God. In this respect we have not laboured in vain. No doubt more might have been done if all had tried to do something to make known the great salvation. The congregations keep up pretty well at Plattsville, Bethel, and Haysville. At the last place there is an intention of trying to put up a church as soon as circumstances will permit. Our efforts in Drumbo and Baden do not yield the results we could wish. However, the seed has been sown, and it must, with God's blessing, spring up and bring forth fruit. Our two Sabbath Schools are doing well, especially the one at Bethel. Two protracted meetings were held, in which several sought and found an interest in the Saviour, and joined us in fellowship. Finances on the whole somewhat improved, with the exception of the missionary money, which is a trifle less than last year. In the prosecution of our work we have had our fightings without and our fears within, but we have triumphed through the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. All things considered, the out-look for this part of the work is hopeful. A little more zeal, prayer, faith, self-denial, and enlarged liberality on part of our people will make this portion of our Zion increasingly prosperous.—J. B.

STRATFORD MISSION.—*Dear Bro. Bee,*—The success of Stratford Mission is worthy of a record in your missionary report. Last fall we opened a beautiful brick church, worth at least five thousand dollars. The public around here think that it is almost miraculous that such a feeble few should have made such a bold stand. The fact is that your missionary has worked very hard behind the scenes, and God has blessed the effort. Since the opening of the new church our congregation and our financial income have increased at least one-third. Also last spring we held revival services for nine or ten weeks. The struggle was great, but the result was glorious. This, however, was almost a union revival, for members of other churches flocked into warm themselves at the Primitive Methodist fire, and professed to be greatly blessed. Of course our own society did not reap all the fruit, but we gathered sheaves enough to fill up all vacancies and to report an increase of seven members for the year. During the revival one young man, who was trying to be an infidel, burned his infidel works, got converted and joined the church with his wife. If space would permit we could give many more details. We have commenced this confederal year with every prospect of further success.—GEO. WOOD.

WOODSTOCK.—The church property has been properly conveyed to the Connexion; it cost over six thousand dollars. Three thousand dollars has been realized by mortgage for nine years at 7 per cent. There is a floating debt of some six or seven hundred dollars. The balance has been raised by subscription, etc. Some twenty names have been removed from the roll, and still a small increase reported. The congregations have increased fifty per cent. and the ordinary income over forty per cent. There is much for encouragement and there is also much to cause anxiety. The debt and running expenses of the church are heavy for the few noble souls who form the society. It is absolutely necessary that some outside help should be rendered in the matter of debt. Could it be reduced to fifteen hundred dollars the friends would have some prospect of paying their way with something like ease and comfort.—C. S. WILLIS.
