Report of Session.

In the kind providence of God, we are spared as a Session, and are called upon to review the work of the congregation for 1899. Truly a year to be remembered for its mercies and blessings, yet in it we have learned more and more that vain is the help of man. We would humbly acknowledge God's good hand and guidance in whatever success has attended the efforts of the congregation in the work. We would humbly own the failures to be ours, and this because we have not sought his guidance as faithfully and earnestly as we might have done.

We feel thankful for the interest and attendance on the Lord's day and weekly meetings, but feel that many others might encourage us more frequently with their presence. Our numbers remain about the same as at last annual report. Twenty members have been added during the year and a like number have been removed from the roll.

We feel thankful to the congregation for the liberal response in regard to the church debt, and it is, we believe, a real pleasure to know that the Lord's house in which we meet for worship is now entirely unencumbered.

In looking over the year we are reminded, as in the past, that life is brief and uncertain. Four, who have for many years been identified with the church, viz., Mr. George Hutchison, sr., Mr. David Rae, Mr. William Elder and Miss Hannah McInnis, all well and favorably known, have passed to their reward. Our bereaved friends have our heartfelt sympathy and prayer that our loving Heavenly Father will sustain and comfort them by his gracious and abiding presence.

Report of Managers.

In presenting our Annual report for the year 1899 the Board of Managers do so with a deep sense of the debt of gratitude that we, as a congregation, owe to the God of all blessing.

The church debt has been a burden on the congregation for a number of

years past, but owing to the unanimity and willingness of heart shown by the members and adherents, the whole debt has been wiped off.

There has been paid in on stipend account during the year \$882.75, so that the stipend has been paid up in full and there is \$82.75 of a balance on hand. This is the largest amount ever contributed to stipend in one year by the Chatsworth congregation.

Contributions to the schemes of the church are a little in advance of that of last year, being \$93.00, or about \$15.00 more than that of 1898, and we hope now that when there is no more building debt to pay that our contributions to the schemes may be much larger next year.

The total receipts for all purposes during the year amounts to \$2876.00. All of which is respectfully submitted in the name of the Managers.

Report of Women's Foreign Mission Society.

The Auxiliary of the Women's Foreign Mission Society meets in the vestry the first Friday in each month at 3 p. m. The topics, set apart by the Central Board for prayer and study, are taken up each day thus giving the members a knowledge of the work which leads to a deepening interest.

In October Miss Duncan, of India, addressed a large meeting in the church. A Thank Offering collection of \$20 was taken on this occasion. This amount together with free will offering of the members each month, and mite box contributions, gives a total of \$60 to be sent to the Presbyterial Treasurer. This is an increase of \$20 over last year. Apart from this we feel much good is being done which cannot be estimated by material things.

We are indebted to many "Scattered Helpers" for the aid given both in offerings and preparing the bale of clothing for the Indian Schools in the North West.

Although the membership of 15 is small in comparison with what the society would wish to have, yet we hope the time may soon come when every woman in our church shall deem it a privilege to become a member of the W.F. M.S.
