It is, unfortunately, true that a very large number of people entertain the idea that there are hardly two sides to this question, and we, too often, hear the popular dogma advanced that as the lumber of the Province belongs to the people, the Government ought to take every cent they can squeeze out of those who are engaged in sending it out of the country.

It is true that the lumber lands of the Province belong to the public, but, in administering them, it is only reasonable and right to give credit to those by whose enterprise they have been made valuable.

It is a grievance, we suppose, in the Times' estimation, that "no net tax is imposed upon the flow of tide," but no one hereabouts can comprehend the meaning of the phrase.
