Miramichi Advance. "Advance" Scientific Miscellany. Some experiments were lately made in a Russian town with fire-extinguishing powder. Upon contact with the flames, the powder produces heavy fumes in such overwhelming quantities as to completely stifle the fire.

Observations as to fuel consumed have been made on locomotives of the Hanover Bremen railway, showing, among other results, that the locomotives are sometimes run with a loss of only fifteen or twenty per cent of heat up the chimney. Sea-water contains about two percent of salt, while the water of Great Salt Lake has twenty-two per cent.

The number of varieties of insects is vastly greater than that of all other living creatures. The oak supports 450 species of insects, and 200 are found in the pine. Canada House Building. CHATHAM, September 8th, 1880. Some time ago Prof. Foral, experimenting with the albumenized paper of photographers, reached the conclusion that light cannot penetrate in water to a greater depth than about 125 feet. More recently, however, M. Apert has exposed more sensitive photographic plates at a depth of 300 feet under water, and the traces of light were distinctly left on the plates. Light must therefore, penetrate clear water at least 300 feet, while rays so feeble as to escape detection by any means at our command—and yet so powerful as to exert an influence upon the forms of sub-aquatic life—may reach still greater depths.
