BILL.

An Act to afford greater facilities to duly qualified Persons to practise as Land Surveyors in this Province.

WHEREAS, it is expedient to afford greater facilities to duly qualified persons to practise as Land Surveyors in this Province; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: Preamble.

I. From and after the passing of this Act, it shall and may be lawful for any person desirous to practise as a Land Surveyor in this Province, to do so after examination had before either of the Boards of Examiners appointed under the Acts twelfth Victoria chapter thirty-five, fourteenth and fifteenth Victoria, chapter four, and eighteenth Victoria, chapter eighty-three, in Upper and Lower Canada, to hold such Examinations; and if the person so examined be found duly qualified, he shall receive a certificate thereof under the hands and seal of the Board holding such examination, which shall entitle him to practise as a Land Surveyor in this Province. Any duly qualified person may be admitted to practise as a Land Surveyor after examination.

II. Such parts of the said before-recited Acts as prevent any Person from practising as a Land Surveyor without having first served two years' Apprenticeship in Canada, shall be and the same are hereby repealed. Acts repealed.

III. This Act shall be a Public Act.
