OF THE

PRIMITIVE METHODIST MISSIONARY SOCIETY,

CANADA,

FOR THE YEAR ENDING APRIL 30TH, 1860.

The Missionary Committee to the Friends of Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada West.

1.—The Primitive Methodist Missions have been established in Canada over thirty years: their origin was very simple, and may be briefly stated. Emigration had brought many to this country connected with British Primitive Methodism, who had battled with *poverty* in the manufacturing districts, and with *bigotry* and high-churchism in the rural counties. Here in the forests, and elsewhere, by hard toil, they found a home and plenty; but scant of religious ordinances, and yearning for their own beloved Shepherds to feed them with the Bread of Life, they gave utterance to the Macedonian cry: "Come over and help us!" And this cry was answered! British labourers and money were forthcoming, and are still continued, on the very reasonable condition that Canadian brethren *help themselves* in raising up Agents for the Ministry from their own ranks, fired with love for souls; and in raising Funds to support the work, *equal* to their circumstances, and the necessities of their adopted Country.

2.—Now we have, dear friends, *this year*, great pleasure in reporting that the *past* has been prosperous, for notwithstanding the depressed

condition of this country, our Canadian Missionary contributions have exceeded any previous year, and on the Mission stations there has been a considerable increase to the membership, as this report will show. We have also taken up fresh Stations, and increased the number of our Missionaries; and have promised to supply fresh openings, in the confidence we have of your love to the cause of God, as subscribers and active Missionary collectors.

3.—From our Mission stations, with one or two exceptions, we have had, in the Missionary Quarterly Reports to the Committee, encouraging accounts of revivals and extensions of the good work. Several chapels have been built, and Sabbath-schools established; and were our funds adequate, by our subscribers *increasing* their annual subscriptions, and our Ministers *doubling* their Missionary collectors,—we could take up many advantageous openings, where many hundreds of people living in Sabbath desecration and misery, might be saved—their children rescued and trained to order and usefulness; and our country made strong in a Protestant, enlightened and happy brotherhood of peace and love.

4.—We do not wish to undervalue the labours of our Parliamentary legislators, our Magistracy, our police force, &c., but we do submit, from long and careful observation, that the preaching of the gospel, according to the command of God our Saviour, is of vast importance to Canada! To stand and look on with indifference, or to give grudgingly is now highly criminal; and without the friends of Missions increase their *givings*, this work, the noblest of all, must languish! No man in his proper senses, with the evidences before him, would desire this work to be crippled, or to wither and die. Suppose our Mission efforts, for want of support, were to collapse, our churches to be desolated, our Sabbath schools disbanded, etc.; then what would follow as the fate of Bible and Tract societies, temperance institutions, and charitable organizations, &c. &c. Were this picture of imagination made a reality, our property, liberties and happiness would be doomed at once, and we should all drift away to anarchy and destruction.

5.—Now, to advance your real interests, both for time and eternity, rally around the Missionary banner, and cheer on the standard-bearers of the Cross with your support and patronage; and, *we say*, support the Primitive Methodist wing of Immanuel's army, who have demonstrated the fact that, in proportion to the means bestowed, they have succeeded in converting the masses to protestant Christianity with *equal* success to any other of the worthy Missionary Societies in Canada West.

6.—We trust, then, that our friends will renew the campaign, this fall and winter, with redoubled energy; and that through the length and breadth of our community the cry of success will ring, and make all the lovers of Zion to be glad.

7.—The *Christian Journal*, the accredited religious Newspaper of the Body, will continue to publish, as before, every communication from our own, and other Missionaries, and we believe the Missionaries will give the subscribers all the fruits of their labours in *ample detail*, so that we need not say any more in this Annual Report of the Society's operations, but simply remind our dear brethren, the superintendents of the stations, of the importance of multiplying the number of Missionary collectors, and encourage them *immediately* to commence their honourable services. To make *early* all necessary arrangements for holding the Public Meetings at the *precise times* appointed by Conference—not *putting them off* to suit other circumstances, which is generally a mistake. To enlist the Sabbath-school and other children to collect with Missionary cards and boxes, and when practicable hold Juvenile Missionary Meetings.

8.—And now, dear friends, in the prosecution of these noble purposes and practical efforts for the happiness of our race, you will have the approval of Jesus, who was a glorious Missionary to our fallen world,—you will have the testimony of a good conscience, and the esteem of the wise and good in all lands. Now, friends of Missions, ponder the claims of this holy charity, this sanctified enterprise, consider your duty in relation to it, pray earnestly and in faith for its progress, and

give freely to its funds. Again we urge you to act without delay, for the golden opportunities of doing good, in the highest acceptation, will soon glide away for ever. "Work while it is day, for the night cometh when no man can work."
