A Mad Engineer.

In a railway accident on the Pennsylvania railroad, near Derry, Saturday, James Monaghan, the engineer, was knocked from his cab with his skull broken. He was taken from the ground screaming with agony. His scalp was almost torn from his head. At the base of his head there was a terrible gash seven inches long and a stream of blood could be seen the skull which had been abraded by the iron coupling. Blood was pouring from his mouth and saturating his clothing. He was carried to
