

NATURAL GAS GUSHERS.

Operations in Niagara Peninsula - The Output from Ten Completed Wells - The Outlook.

POST COLONNA, Aug. 3. - The Provincial Natural Gas, Light and Fuel Company Limited has exclusive drilling rights over 43,000 acres of 75 square miles of land in the southern and eastern parts of the county of Welland.

The company commenced drilling in July, 1918, in the township of Welland, on the farm of Philip Zavitz. The well was continued to a depth of 845 feet, when a flow equal to 1,700,000 cubic feet per day was obtained.

The second well, which is about half a mile north on Elton Zavitz's farm, was not so successful. Drilling was stopped at 811 feet below the surface. This well produced 400,000 feet a day, and has a rock pressure of 540 pounds.

The third well was sunk on Jones Zavitz's farm, in the township of Welland, and is about 700 feet deep. It has a rock pressure of 510 pounds, and is 880 feet from the surface.

The fourth well, which is about 1/2 mile north of the second well, was drilled to a depth of 570 feet and had a rock pressure of 510 pounds. It is in the township of Welland, on the farm of Daniel Zavitz.
