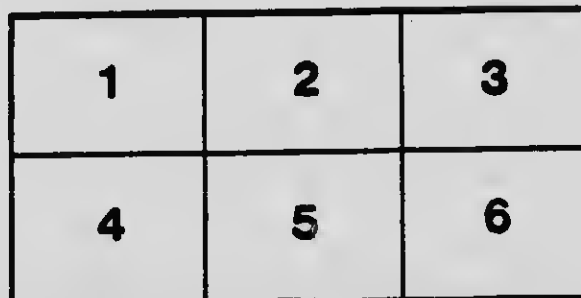
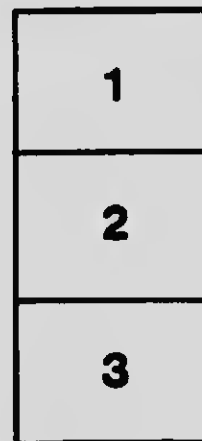

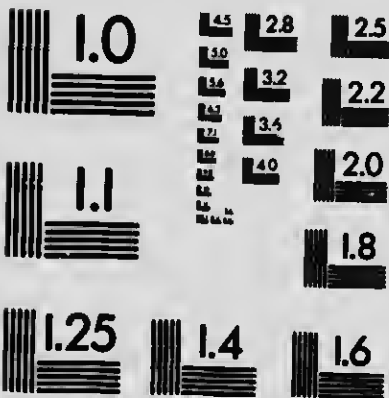

RULES.

FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF DOG SHOWS AS ADOPTED BY THE PACIFIC KENNEL LEAGUE.

Every Club or Association, a member of this League, shall be the arbitrator of its own internal affairs, and shall have power to suspend or expel its members, or disqualify any other person from exhibiting at its shows. It shall have the right to hold shows under the rules of this League, offer such prizes as it sees fit, except that no prize shall be offered where one breed shall compete with another; a fine of \$20 is provided for each infraction of this rule, and perform any other act not in conflict with the Constitution of the League or the powers it has delegated to the League by becoming a member thereof.

Every Club or Association, a member of this League, shall hold its shows under the following rules, which it shall publish in its premium list.

I. Every dog must be the bona fide property of the person or kennel making such entry on the day of closing the entries, and the entry blank must contain his or her name or the name of the owner of the kennel. The entry must clearly identify the dog to be exhibited by name, and, if known, its date of birth, name of sire and dam, and the name of its breeder. Should any of these particulars be unknown to the exhibitor, it must be stated on the entry blank. If the dog is registered in any stud-book, the name and number of stud-book should be given with the entry. No entry can be accepted of a puppy whose age, sire or dam is unknown.

II. If the name of a dog which has won a prize be changed, the old name must be given on the entry blank, and inserted in the catalogue, together with a list of all prizes won by the dog, until such time as it wins a prize under its new name.

III. The breeder of a dog is the person owning the bitch at the time of her whelping.

IV. The Bench Show Committee may decline any entries they see fit, or may remove any dog on account of disease, vice or any other good cause.

V. A castrated dog or spayed bitch will be disqualified. Total blindness, deafness or lameness shall disqualify. If the judge or veterinary surgeon is satisfied that the deafness or lameless is temporary, the dog shall be allowed to compete.

VI. A dog suffering from any contagious disease shall be disqualified and shall be at once removed from the building. The regularly employed veterinary surgeon shall alone decide as to the condition of the dog, and his decision must be given in writing.

VII. A judge may disqualify a dog which, in his opinion, has been improperly tampered with, subject to the decision of the veterinary surgeon. Should the judge's disqualifications not be sustained, the class must be re-judged.

VIII. Discretionary power is given the judge of each class to withhold any or all prizes for want of merit, and appeals can only be entertained where misrepresentation or breach of the rules is alleged.

IX. Should an appointed judge be unable to fill his engagement, the committee shall have the right to fill the vacancy.

X. In any class where there is a limit of weight, a dog entered in such classes may at any time after the opening of the show, and before the judging, be weighed, and the weight of the dog shall be registered and hold good at the time of judging.

XI. Regular Classes.

1. The Puppy Class shall be for all dogs over 6 months and under 12 months of age, and no entry can be made of one under 6 months or whose date of birth, breeder, sire or dam is unknown.

2. Novice Class, for dogs never having won a first prize in any recognized show, puppy class excepted.

3. The Limit Class shall be for all dogs never having won four first prizes in said class at any recognized show, but no dog having acquired the title of Champion shall be eligible to this class.

4. The Open Class shall be for all dogs of any age over 6 months. No prize winner shall be debarred from competing.

5. *The Winners' Class shall be open only to winners of first prizes and the winner of 5 wins in this class will thereby become a Champion of Record, will be so recorded in the Pacific Kennel League Record of Wins, and will be entitled to a Pacific Kennel League Champion certificate. Before awarding "Reserve" in this class, the dog or dogs having been placed second to the winner in any of the regular classes, must be brought before the judge for competition with the remaining dogs in said Winners' Class. No class winner can be withdrawn or withheld from competition in the Winners' Class, and no entry fee shall be charged for said competition in this class. A dog that prior to December 31, 1900, has won once in the

*Exhibitors will take notice that no entries are received for the Winners' Class, only first prize winners being eligible to compete.

Winners' Class shall qualify as a Champion by two additional wins in the Winners' Class, and a dog that has won twice, qualifies with one additional win in the Winners' Class. The Winners' Class can be divided by sex provided that the required classes announced in the Premium List are also divided by sex.

N. B.—Judges are requested to be particularly careful in awarding a prize in the Winners' Class. While a puppy might merit a first prize in the Puppy Class, it by no means follows that he is worthy of a first prize in the Winners' Class if alone.

6. The Miscellaneous Class shall be open to all dogs of established breeds for which no regular class has been provided in the Premium List. Entries in this class must specify the breed of the exhibit. Failure to comply with this condition shall disqualify the dog and cancel the award.

XII. Should a dog win a first prize subsequent to the entry at some show held between the time the entry was made and the judging at the show for which he has been entered, the committee shall transfer him to his right class and have him judged therein.

XIII. Whenever a dog has been entered in the wrong class, either on account of weight limit or other cause, the committee, if satisfied that no fraud was intended, shall transfer him to be judged in the class in which he properly belongs.

XIV. Should a prize winner be disqualified, the next dog, as placed by the judge, shall be moved up to his place; provided, that no dog shall be moved into any place where the prize has been withheld by the judge.

XV. Equal first shall not be given, but the judge may divide second and third between two dogs, in which case the win shall count as a second for each dog.

XVI. All dogs eligible to compete for specials must be judged, unless it is stated on the entry blank that the dog "will not compete for specials." No special prize can be accepted after the show has opened, nor can any special be accepted for the best in the show, or in any way where one variety competes with another.

XVII. The age of a dog shall be computed up to the day preceding the opening of the show.

XVIII. Bench Show Committees may receive bitches with puppies of any age for exhibition only.

XIX. Any exhibitor or his or her representative may file an objection to any dog, in writing, stating the reasons therefor, at any time prior to the close of the show, and depositing with the committee the sum of \$2.00,

which shall be forfeited if the decision is against him. In which case the committee shall meet at once and decide the matter, and from their decision there shall be no appeal.

XX. No person under sentence of disqualification, suspension or expulsion, by the club holding the show, or by the League, can exhibit a dog or handle a dog in the ring for anyone else. The sentence of disqualification of an owner disqualifies all his dogs. But this rule must not be so construed as to abridge the rights of an innocent party.

XXI. The handler of a dog or the person whose name appears on the entry blank as the handler shall be considered as the agent of the owner in all transactions, unless the Club is otherwise notified.

XXII. Entries shall close not less than five days before the opening of the show.

XXIII. The word "dog" as used herein, is used in its generic sense.

XXIV. Dog Show Committees may provide such classes for dogs of recognized breeds as they may choose; provided that such classes do not conflict with the conditions of the foregoing classes.

XXV. The Secretary of the Pacific Kennel League must, after careful investigation, cancel all wins when satisfied that these rules have been violated by an exhibitor, in the following cases: when the entry has been made after the advertised date of closing entries. When a dog has been entered in the name of an agent only. When a puppy is entered, being under 6 months of age. When a dog is entered in the Novice Class, having previously won a first prize, puppy wins excepted. When a dog is entered in the Limit Class, having previously won four or more prizes in such class. When a dog is entered in the Miscellaneous Class, and the breed is not specified or recognized. When a dog, by authority of its owner, is led into the judgment ring by or in charge of a person not in good standing. When a dog is entered by an owner or his agent, if either is not in good standing.

XXVI. Secretaries of Clubs must send a copy of the Premium List to the Secretary of the Pacific Kennel League for approval before issuing to the public.

XXVII. The above rules must be published in all Premium Lists of Clubs holding shows under Pacific Kennel League rules.

XXVIII. All prize money must be returned to the show officials in case a dog is disqualified by the Pacific Kennel League subsequent to the closing of the show.

ADDITIONAL RULES

ADOPTED BY THE VICTORIA CITY KENNEL CLUB.

I. No dog will be received before 8 a.m., nor after 11 o'clock April 6th

II. The managers will use due diligence for the care and safety of all dog exhibited. Watchmen will be kept on duty day and night ; but it must be distinctly understood by all exhibitors that the management will not be responsible for loss or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause.

III. It is desired that with each entry, the exhibitor will state the price for which he will sell his dog provided it is for sale. All transactions must be between the owner, or his representative, and the purchaser. The Secretary or Superintendent, unless requested, will not interfere, nor assume any responsibility in the matter.

IV. Each exhibitor will receive one ticket of identification for each dog entered, which must be carefully preserved, as no dog will be permitted to pass out of the building with owner until its owner shall deposit \$5 and surrender the ticket to the check clerk, both of which will be returned by 9:30 o'clock the following morning. If prize winners are taken out and not returned, the prize awarded them will be forfeited. A season ticket will be issued to each exhibitor, free, and will be for his or her individual use only. The ticket will be forfeited if transferred.

V. No dog will be received unless supplied with a strong collar and bench chain.

VI. Whenever it is possible, two or more dogs of the same breed entered by one exhibitor, will be benched together, *provided*, a request to that effect is made in the entry form at the time of entering. *Positively no request to bench dogs together be entertained after entries are closed.*

VII. The show will be open from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. each day.

VIII. The judging will commence promptly April 6th at 1.30 p.m. During the hours of judging no dog shall be taken from its stall not even by its owners ; and if any dog is not found in its stall when called for by the judge, the judge will proceed without it. This rule will be RIGIDLY enforced, that the judging may not be retarded. Owners are requested to be near their dogs, and when the class is called to bring their animals into the judging ring. In the absence of the owner, attendants will take the dog into the ring.

IX. No dog shall be permanently removed from the building until 10

o'clock on Saturday night, April 9th except by consent of the Show Committee.

X. A deposit of \$2.00 (to be made to the Secretary) must accompany all protests, the money to be forfeited in the event of the protests being held frivolous.

XI. The Bench Show Committee shall have the right to exclude or remove any dog from the show for any cause appearing to them sufficient.

XII. Exhibitors will be allowed to exercise their dogs from 7 to 10 a.m. only and 5 to 6 p.m., and no dog will be permitted off the Bench except during those hours. Otherwise, the Superintendent will see that they are exercised. THIS RULE WILL BE RIGIDLY ENFORCED.

XIII. The Secretary has executive charge of the management of the show in all particulars. The Bench Show Committee will meet at noon each day for consideration of any business properly coming before its attention. All complaints must be in writing, and handed to the Secretary before being considered by the Bench Show Committee.

XIV. Entry fees \$2.00 for each dog. If a dog is entered in more than one class, \$1.50 charged for each additional class.

SPECIAL NOTICE.

In all breeds entries of Bitches with whelps at side will be accepted for exhibition, for which an entry fee of \$2.00 for each Bitch with litter will be charged.

Parties wishing to place dogs at the show for sale or on exhibition only and not for competition, can do so by paying \$2.00 entry fee to cover cost of benching and feeding. Such entries must be made on regular entry blanks.

Entry fee \$2.00. If a dog is entered in more than one class \$1.50 is charged for each additional class.

PRIZE LIST.

To all owners of Winners, First, Second or Third, handsome Diplomas.

To winners of First in Open Classes, \$5.00 cash.

To winners of First in Limit Classes, \$3.00 cash.

To winners of First in Novice Classes, \$2.00 cash.

To winners of First in Puppy Classes, \$2.00 cash.

Four dogs or more in each class or no prize money will be paid.

A cash prize of \$1.00 per dog will be paid each handler from outside Victoria. No handler to receive any handlers money unless he exhibits 10 dogs or more.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

The following classes are provided for ; should there be entries for classes not here listed, proper provision will be made for same.

PUPPY CLASSES

For dogs over 6 months and under 12 months old.

NOVICE CLASSES

For dogs never having won a first prize at any recognized show, wins in the puppy class excepted.

LIMIT CLASSES

For dogs never having won four first prizes in Limit Class at any recognized show, but no dog having acquired the title of champion shall be eligible for this class.

OPEN CLASSES

For all dogs of any age over 6 months. No prize winner debarred from competing.

Since the Pirmium List has been in print the Officers of the Work Point Garrison have offered a fine Silver Cup, which will be placed for some representative breed.
