An Act to repeal certain parts of the Ordinances relative to Winter Roads in Lower Canada, in so far as regards the District of Montreal,

5 **W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Ordinances of the Preamble.
Legislature of the late Province of Lower Canada, relative to Winter Roads, so as to exempt from the operation thereof the District of Montreal; Be it therefore enacted, &c.

10 That from and after the passing of this Act, so much of the Part of Ord. of Specl. com. L. C. 3 and 4 Vic. c. 25, and 4 Vic. c. 33, repealed as regards District of Montreal.
Ordinance of the Legislature of the late Province of Lower Canada, passed in the Session held in the third and fourth years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled, "*An Ordinance to provide for the improvement during the winter season, of the Queen's Highways in this Province, and for other purposes;*" and of the Ordinance of the said Legislature, passed in the fourth year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled: "*An Ordinance to amend the laws relative to Winter Roads,*" as enacts that no cariole, traine, berline, or other winter vehicle, other than the sleighs described in the said Ordinances, shall be used on any of the Queen's highways
15 or public roads in that part of the Province heretofore Lower Canada, shall be, and so much of the said Ordinances is hereby repealed in so far as regards the District of Montreal.
