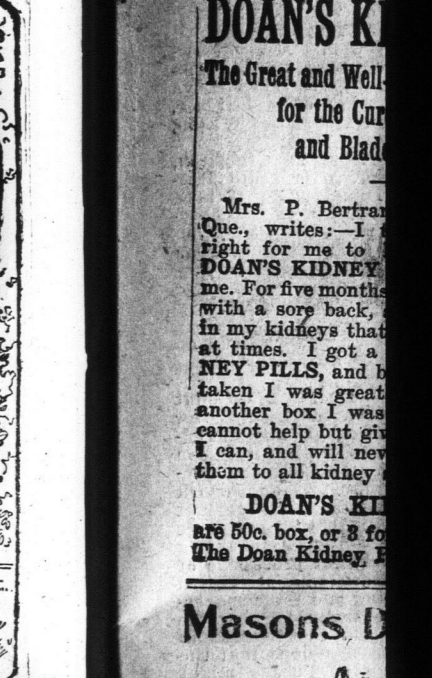

THE CASE FOR BRITISH COLUMBIA

Province's Brief In Appeal of Tomey Homma to Privy Council.

The following in regard to the Tomey Homma case, recently decided in favor of the province, will be read with interest.

Victoria, B. C., June 29, 1901. Christopher Robinson, Esq., K.C., Bank of Montreal, 22 Abchurch Lane, LONDON, ENGLAND.

Sir: I was much pleased to be advised by your telegram of the 27th inst. that the Privy Council had decided in favor of the province in the appeal of Tomey Homma to the Privy Council.
