An Act to authorize the Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Montreal to borrow an additional sum for the purpose of completing the new Water Works in the said City, and to restrict the annual expenditure of the Council of the said City within certain limits.

WHEREAS it is necessary for the good working of the Water Works Preamble. of the City of Montreal, to complete certain works and to make new ones; and whereas the Council of the said City have, by their Petition, asked for the authority they require to borrow the sum neces-5 sary for that purpose; and whereas it is expedient to restrict the annual expenditure to be made by the said Council within certain limits; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

I. All the powers, privileges and authority already possessed by the Acts 7 Vic. c. 10 Corporation of the said City, in and by the Act 7 Victoria, chapter 44, 44, and 16Vic. and by the Act 16 Victoria, chapter 127, are hereby conferred upon and shall appertain to the said Corporation in so fewer they may combat to the said Corporation in so fewer they may combat to the said Corporation. shall appertain to the said Corporation, in so far as they may apply to this Act. the purposes of this Act, and the same may be required for the objects hereinafter mentioned; and each and every section of the two above 15 cited Acts shall be held to form part of the present Act, in so far as the same may be consistent with the provisions of this Act.

II. The said Corporation is hereby authorised to increase the motive Corporation power of the wheel-house by means of which the water conveyed through may increase the newly constructed aqueduct is forced into the reservoirs of the said the wheel-20 City, either by adding one or more wheels to the said wheel-house, or oth- house, and erwise, and to construct and open, upon such site as will appear most con- construct a venient, a tail-race, by which the waste water coming from the new aqueduct into the wheel-house, may be carried into the river St. Lawrence; and for that purpose to acquire, in the manner and form and upon the 25 conditions prescribed in and by the said Act, 16 Victoria, chapter 127, all real estate, or any part thereof, which may be required for the construction of the said tail-race.

The said Corporation is hereby authorised to borrow, for the Corporation purposes mentioned in the preceding section, as also for enlarging the may borrow 30 storage for water, for providing an additional rising main, and for completing the laying of the distribution pipes throughout the said City, a poses relating sum not exceeding two hundred thousand dollars, and to issue, under to the Water the hand of the Mayor and seal of the said Corporation, Debentures or Works. Corporation Bonds, to the amount of two hundred thousand dollars, 35 aforesaid, payable twenty-five years after the date of the issue thereof respectively, and bearing interest payable semi-annually on the first days of May and November in each and every year, and at a rate not exceeding six per centum per annum; and all such debentures may be issued from time to time, at such periods, and for such amounts as shall be

deemed expedient; and they may have coupons annexed to them, for the half-yearly interest payable on them, which coupons, being signed by the Mayor or the Treasurer of the said Corporation, shall be respectively payable to the bearer thereof, when the half-yearly interest therein mentioned becomes due, and shall, on payment thereof, be de- 5 livered up to the said Corporation; and the possession of any such coupon by the Corporation, shall be prima facie evidence that the halfyear's interest therein mentioned has been paid, according to the tenor of such debenture; and all such debentures, and as well the interest as the principal thereof, are and shall be secured on the general funds of 10 the said Corporation, as well as by a special privilege on the Water Works of the said City, on the property to be acquired, and on the Mortgage for works to be made under the authority of this Act; the same being hereby specially mortgaged for the payment of the Debentures, both in capital and interest; provided, however, the aforesaid privilege and 15 mortgage shall in no manner or way interfere with or injure the rights of holders of debentures or coupons issued in virtue of the above cited Acts, or of any Act amending the same.

The amount which the said Corporation is empowered to borrow where debenby the preceding section, may be borrowed either in this Province or 20 elsewhere, and the principal sum, and interest thereon as aforesaid, may be made payable either in this Province or elsewhere, and either in sterling money aforesaid, or the currency of this Province, or in that of the place where the same shall be payable, and generally all the provisions of the Acts now in force as to debentures issued by the said Cor- 25 poration, shall apply to those to be issued under this Act, except only in so far as they may be inconsistent with this Act.

V. From and after the civic year which shall commence for the said City on the first day of February, one thousand eight hundred and sixtytwo, it shall be the duty of the Council of the said City to make every 30 year, on or before the first day of May, an appropriation of the amounts necessary to meet the expenses of the current year, by providing-

1. For the payment of the interest, and sums required for the sinking fund on the debt due by the said City;

- 2. For the general and ordinary expenses of the City;
- 3. For the sums required for contemplated improvements;
- 4. For a reserve of not less than five per centum to meet unforeseen expenditure;

Such appropriation shall never exceed the amount of the receipts tions limited. from the preceeding year, added to the balance of the said receipts which 40 shall not have been expended.

VI. It shall not be lawful for the said Council to expend beyond the amount so appropriated, and the amount of the other sums at their disposal out of the receipts of the current year, except in the cases and under the conditions hereinafter set forth; but the Council may at any 45 time vary the application of the sums set apart for improvements, and make use of the amount reserved for unforeseen expenditure.
