In printing (anadian postage stamps teel plates are employed and two hundred ersons are employed coloring them, ten resses with girls kept busily feeding sheets onthining two hundred stamps each. Af er the sheets of paper upon which the Louis, Mo.

two hundred stamps are engraved have dried enough they are sent into another room and gummed. The gum, used for this purpose is a peculiar composition, made of the powder of dried porotoes and other vegetables mixed with water, which is better than any other material—for in-stance gum arabic, which cracks the paper badly. This paper is also of a peculiar texture- somewhat similiar to that used for bank-notes. After having been again dried-thistime on little racks which are fanned by steam power.
