During the Canadian Festival of the Arts which will be held at the John F. Kennedy Centre for the Performing Arts in Washington from October 13 to 26, 1975, the Hon. Hugh Faulkner, Secretary of State, will represent the Government at the premiere of the Royal Winnipeg Ballet on Tuesday, October 14. He will be accompanied by Mrs. Faulkner.

Mr. Robert S. Ingersold, Under Secretary of State of the U. S. Department of State, has accepted the invitation of Ambassador Warren to attend the premiere with Mr. Faulkner. Other American guests of honour will include the Hon. John Warner, Administrator of the American Revolution Bi-Centennial Administration and Miss Nancy Hanks, Chairman of the National Endowment for the Arts.
