PARLIAMENT OF CANADA. (Special to the News) OTTAWA, May 15. On motion of Mr. Cartwright for a third reading of the Tariff Bill, a discussion arose on an amendment to recommend the bill, in order to expedite the passage relating to tobacco grown in Canada.

Dr. Tupper said this was a negative in duty, which the increased tax was calculated to destroy. He had voted on a former occasion against a proposition to repeal the tax on native tobacco; and he would vote against an increase of the tax, as this bill proposed, especially when it had been clearly shown that there was no necessity for the increased three millions taxation.

After a debate the amendment was lost—yeas, 31; nays, 108. Mr. Boyd moved that tea and coffee be struck from the taxable articles.

Dr. Tupper stood in opposition to the bill. He showed that the Finance Minister had secured by revotes more revenue than could be received from the tea and coffee tax. These unexpended balances brought forward more than covered the revenue likely to be raised from tea and coffee.

Mr. McKay spoke in favor of the tax. The amendment was lost—yeas, 118; nays, 118.

BYRON (Montreal) moved an amendment that the tea and coffee duties be of uniform. A discussion took place as to whether this was in order or not. The Speaker ruled that such an amendment could only be made in Committee.

The bill was read a third time. (Special Telegram to the Tribune.) OTTAWA, May 15, 1874. After several number of private bills passed.

Mr. Ross, Minister of Militia, explained the Premier's Military College bill at length, and it passed a second reading. The House adjourned at midnight.

Body Found. The body of McAfee, who wandered away from his home at Golden Grove, about two months since, was found yesterday afternoon in Big Lake Leonard.

At the time he left home he was supposed to be partially insane. Search was made for him, but no tidings could be heard. It is supposed he lost his way on the ice and perished in the cold. Coroner Earle holds an inquest this afternoon.
