The Secretary of the Treasury at Washington has issued a circular to Collectors, directing them to notify American fishermen that the provisions of the Treaty with Great Britain, proclaimed July 4, 1871, relating to the fishermen will not go into effect until the laws required to carry them into operation have been passed by Congress, the Parliaments of Great Britain and Canada, the Legislature of Prince Edward Island, and to warn them that their business must be carried on subject to the ratification of the treaty.
