ANNUAL MEETING.

The Anniversary of the Society was held on Sunday and Monday, June 8th and 9th, in the Bible Christian Church, Little Britain. On Sunday, two sermons were preached; in the morning, by W. S. Pascoe, and in the evening by W. Luke. In the afternoon, a public service was held, in connection with the Sabbath School. Addresses were delivered by W. Hooper, and E. Roberts. On Monday, at 2:30 P.M., the public meeting commenced; J. Parsons occupied the chair. The Secretary, J. Harris, read the Report, when the following resolution was moved by J. Chapple, and seconded by W. Hooper:

Res. That the Report, an abstract of which has been read, be printed and circulated under the direction of the Missionary Committee, that our friends may fully acquaint themselves with the work of the Society, and the doings of its missionaries, so as to secure their heartiest support.

The meeting then adjourned for tea. At the adjourned meeting, J. Hull, Esq., presided; G. Webber moved, and W. Luke seconded the following resolution:

Res. That we gratefully acknowledge the success that has attended the labors of the Denomination in every land where the missionaries of this people have gone, and believing that our past struggles have, under God, resulted from the devoted piety, the Christ-like love, the self-sacrificing zeal, and the generous liberality of our ministers and people, we solemnly pledge ourselves to renewed consecration, and self-denial, and liberality in the cause of missions.

It was intended for the Brethren, W. R. Roach, and H. J. Nott, to have spoken to a second Resolution; but the enthusiastic effort to meet the year's expenditure, prevented it.

REPORT.

The first Bible Christian Society was organized in the parish of Shebbear, Devonshire, England, Oct. 9th, 1815, and was composed of 22 persons,—most of whom had been awakened to a sense of sin through the agency of Rev. Mr. Evans, a Church of England clergyman,—and who were desirous of meeting to confirm each other's faith, and to persuade men to be reconciled to God. The good work quickly spread, hundreds of souls were saved, other Societies were formed, and several Circuits were

soon organized.

The want of systematic Missionary effort was soon felt. A pressing call came from Chatham, for two missionaries. There being no Missionary Society, the late James Thorne, travelled through the Denomination, to obtain funds wherewith to open the Mission. On Feb. 21st, 1820, Jas. Thorne and William Lyle, the two Missionaries, met at Exeter, and started for London, by stage. About a month after their arrival at Brompton, near Chatham, they formed two classes, four persons in each class; a few were added every week, until, in June, the two classes numbered 69 persons. In 1821, the Bible Christian Missionary Socity was formed, and many of the friends took a deep interest, and manifested considerable zeal in the good work. A Mission was commenced in London, April 29th, 1821, by a preaching service in the open air, in Webb Square. The work

In 1823, a Missionary was sen: to Jersey and Guernsey; the Lord so blessed the preaching of His Word, that many were brought to a knowledge of the truth, and 102 persons joined the church. The Mission in the Isle of Wight was opened in 1824, and at the following Conference, 265 had been gathered into the church. In the same year, a Missionary was sent to Mounmouthshire; here sinners were converted and classes were formed. At Redbrook, a small Society was organized, where J. H. Eynon, the pioneer of the Bible Christian Denomination in Canada, united with them. Thus the work proceeded, the Lord owned and blessed the labors of his servants, multitudes became obedient to the faith, and there were added to the Church daily such as should be saved.

The desire to save souls was so strong in the infant Denomination, that its Missionary efforts could not be confined to the British Islands. The prayers and faith of our fathers, went out in intense longings to win victories for the Saviour, in other parts In 1831, one Missionary, Francis Metherall, was of the world. sent to Prince Edward Island; and another, John H. Eynon, was sent to Ontario. In 1850, two Missionaries were sent to South Australia. A Mission was opened in Victoria, in 1855. In 1866, a Mission was established in Queensland. And in 1877, a Missionary was sent to New Zealand. Very gratifying success has attended these Australasian Missions. The Missionaries have carried the light of Salvation to the Colonists who have trusted in its promises and rejoiced in its joys and hopes. Conference, there were in Australia and New Zealand, 48 Missionaries, 208 Local Preachers, 171 Churches, 3214 members, and 7782 S. S. Scholars.

Most of our readers are more or less acquainted with the early struggles and successes of our pioneers of the Canadian Conference, as well as with the consolidation and extension of more recent years. It rejoices our hearts to know that the God of our fathers is still with us, blessing our efforts in the salvation of the people; and our most earnest desires are, to be more abundantly instrumental in carrying the Gospel tidings to those that are beyond.

Our expenditure, for several years, has somewhat exceeded our income; this has not arisen from any lack of economy, but from the large amount of work performed. That this work has been successful, there can be no room to doubt, when we consider the fact, that in the four years from 1874, to 1878, the membership of the Denomination increased, after making up deficien-

cies, arising from deaths, removals, etc., about 25 per cent. If our friends will consider the importance of the great work, we are engaged in, surely the few additional dollars necessary to overtake our expenditure, will be at once supplied.

Belleville.—We have been suffering during the year, from continued removals; a number of names have also been dropped from our list. An unusually large amount of sickness among the families of our friends, during the winter months, considerably thinned out our congregation; but of late, the attendance has somewhat increased. The continued financial depression has made against us; there are those among us, however, who have liberally sustained the cause by their means, as well as built up the spiritual interest of the Church.

HUNGERFORD.—A few souls have been converted. There are some whose constant kindness, and cheerful liberality, bear testimony to their devotion to our Church interests, and love for the kingdom of Christ.

Campbellford.—We made two special efforts: one at Clark's, and the other at Campbellford. We had many blessed meetings, but not the ingathering for which we fondly hoped. Our congregations, on the whole, are good. Our services are generally seasons of refreshing from the presence of the Lord. Our Bible Readings and Prayer Meetings in the village, are well attended, as also our week evening preaching at Clark's. Our finances are encouraging. We have raised for all purposes, during the year, about \$800. The debt on the Parsonage is reduced to \$550.

PORT HOPE.—Our congregations, on the whole, have been good, and the Word preached has been accompanied with the Spirit. Several have professed living faith in Christ, and have united with us in church-fellowship. The attendance at the prayer-meetings is the best we have ever seen. Our Sabbath School was never larger nor better managed than at present. We have an able staff of officers and teachers, who are thoroughly imbued with the Spirit of their Master, and deeply interested in The adult Bible Class, in charge of the their beloved work. Pastor, with an average attendance of from 25 to 30 persons, is a fine field for religious labor, and we are glad to say it has borne rich fruit, in the conversion of several. A Temperance Association, formed during Bro. Kestle's pastorate, under the auspices of the Sabbath School, holds its meetings quarterly, when there is usually a large attendance.

PERRYTOWN.—We are glad to say that our Societies are living in peace among themselves, and a goodly number of them

seem to prize and enjoy the social means of grace, as well as the public services of the sanctuary. Our congregations are good and very attentive. At Perrytown, the congregation has more than doubled during the year, and is still increasing in numbers and interest.

PICKERING.—A few have been induced to forsake sin, and lay hold on the hope set before them in the Gospel. The members of the church have been consistent and faithful in their confession of Christ before men. We have erected a small church at Frenchman's Bay, the entire cost of which was provided for at the dedication.

PRINCE ALBERT.—It affords us pleasure to be able to report that generally, we live in peace. Our congregations continue about as usual, and class and prayer meetings moderately well attended. Special meetings have been held at two places, with some apparent fruit. The debt on the Parsonage has been lessened to the amount of \$70. The S. School department is encouraging. Our greatest want is a more entire consecration of all we have and are to God.

Peterboro.—The special services, held during the year, resulted in the ingathering of a few souls in each place, while those who were admitted last year, are, many of them, holding on their way. The Sabbath Schools are in an encouraging condition; and while affording a sphere for Christian activity, are the means of exciting our hope in the future prosperity of the cause. During the year, a portion of the debt on the Peterboro property has been paid off, and the church finances put in a more favorable condition. The attendance on the public services are, on the whole, encouraging; but what we want is a more complete consecration to God, and a fuller baptism of the Holy Ghost.

ASHBURNHAM.—As a Society we are sorry we are unable to report a larger ingathering of souls; yet there is room for thankfulness, in as much as some souls have been saved, and we are able to return three members above the members returned last year, after losing several through removals, death, etc. Financially, some of the triends have done nobly, when we take into consideration the depressed state of trade, and the hardness of the times generally. After the first Quarter, we formed a Bible Class, which meets on Tuesday evening; it is well attended and not wanting in interest.

Manvers & Cartwright.—During the year, the work on the Circuit has proceeded evenly and peacefully. The congregations in some places have improved a little. Our membership is about the same as last year.

FENELON.—The year has been one of great anxiety, owing somewhat to the general failure of crops, which has materially The membership, in most inaffected our financial accounts. stances, have done well in contributing to the support of the Gospel. In our work, we have not labored in vain. lon Falls, two or three requested the prayers of the Church. The protracted meeting held at Verulam, resulted in bringing many

LINDSAY.—Heavy financial liabilities, on both Church and Parsonage, together with monetary depression of the times, render our work in this department very trying. Revision of membership roll, has necessitated a reduction of numbers. theless, the addition of a few from other Circuits, and several conversions, the consolidation and enlargement of our Sabbath School work, the renewed vows and more earnest service experienced in our Class and Prayer Meetings, the increased congregations, afford reason gratefully to acknowledge "Our Father's"

UXBRIDGE.—Peace has dwelt within our borders, and God's blessing has characterized our services. Two of our members, ripe in years, and rich in heavenly dispositions, have passed from this scene of suffering, to that of rest. The public services have been, on the whole, well attended, and the social means-prayer, class, and Bible meetings-have been well sustained, and pro-Special services were held during the ductive of much good. winter, in the village, and at Zion. The Sabbath School is progressing, and the character of our adherents becoming more reliable. With care and God's blessing, this Church cannot fail to be a centre of much good in the city, and a power in the Denomination. But considering Toronto's position, as the metropolis of Ontario,—and in a very important sense, of Canada—and as the centre of education, care must be shown in its supply, and we strongly believe it should be made the official centre of Denomination work.

Hamilton.—We report a decrease in our membership, this year. Financially, it has been a hard year with us. The introduction of Gas-light into our church, and several other changes, have been decided improvements, and have added very much to the comfort of minister and people. For several months, we have been holding an afternoon service in what is called the "Mountain Mission Church," with good prospects. Many of our members give evidence that "they have been with Jesus," adorning "the profession of their faith." With an efficient pulpit supply, union and co-operation on the part of the members, and the benediction of Heaven secured, prosperity awaits Hamilton, in the near future, beyond anything realized in the past.

PALMERSTON.—At Palmerston, we have spent about \$80 in repairing the church and property, which makes a great improve-The temperance cause has wonderfully grown in our midst. What is wanted, and what, in our opinion, must be, before Palmerston will ever be very strong, is preaching morning and evening, every Sabbath. The Society lives in peace. At Maitland, we have a good Society, a working people, and they are living in peace among themselves. Some have moved away since Conference. We held a few weeks special meetings, and several gave their hearts to God. The class and prayer meetings are well attended. At Fordwich, we have formed a small Society. This place has grown. We have now a membership of 18; 11 full members, and 7 on trial. If this place can have proper attention, it will, before long, become a very important appointment. After allowing for the dropping of 16 names from our list, we now report a membership of 63, and 13 on trial, an increase of 10 over last year.

CLINTON.—The removal of Bro. Broad, so soon after Conference, through ill-health, proved detrimental to the successful working of the Circuit, especially after arrangements had been made for two ministers. The working of the Circuit, during the past four months, with two ministers, has been satisfactory. The

congregations are as good as ever, in town and country. Prayer and Class Meetings in town, are much better attended, and a gracious spiritual influence generally obtains. Holmesville Society holds its own without any noticeable change. The other country Churches hold no meetings, unless the ministers are present, and consequently, religious experience is not what we could Numerically we have suffered loss, 22 having removed from the Circuit, and 4 having been called to their eternal home. The veteran, and venerable Father Greene, and Bro. Mowbray, of younger years, alike sleep in the dust; and our beloved Sisters, Gibbings and Walker, have put off mortality, and our hope is that they are now with the church of the First-born above. While we mourn our loss, we humbly submit to the rule of Him who doeth all things well. Special services have been held, believers have been quickened, a few professed conversion, and 9 have been admitted into the Church.

LONDON EAST.—The year's operations have been characterized by general good will-and hearty co-operation. The Sabbath congregations have been well sustained; the attendance at the regular class meetings, improved; the Sunday School is considerably augmented; and the membership somewhat increased. Our school-room has been enlarged, by the addition of a wing, 14X16 feet, affording us much needed accommodation. After providing for the cost of this, (\$150), the General debt on the Trust property has been diminished by \$313.03. We have this year raised, for Connexional purposes, the noble sum of \$1107.68. shows what can be done, when proper effort is put forth, even by a new and numerically weak Society, without the advantage, either, of what may be called a wealthy membership. And now, encouraged by the past, we are beginning to look with confidence With suitable supply, and the fostering care of Conference, for a very few years, we consider our permanence and future prosperity assured; and, as the result, our denominational status in Western Ontario much improved.

LONDON SOUTH.—Gratefully acknowledging the assistance of God, we gladly report progress in this part of the Master's vineyard. The congregation manifest interest in the services, and attentively regard the ministration of the Truth. Notwithstanding the enlargement of the church, some two years ago, thinking thus to afford ample accommodation for some time to come, there are now but a few seats for the requirements of the public, in a rapidly growing community. Our Sabbath School, which suffered severely at the beginning of the year, by changing the hour of service, as did likewise our congregation, has now more than recov-

We have a slight increase of members over last year; and in point of attendance upon, and enjoyment of the means of grace, we rejoice in a decided improvement. That we have dwelt together in love and unity, give a pleasant retrospect of the past.

LAMBETH.—Although we have not been visited with any special outpouring of the Holy Spirit, yet we have had many evidences of God's presence with us, in the means of grace, and seventeen souls have been gathered into the fold of Christ. Nevertheless, we have to report a decrease, chiefly arising from removals. Unity and peace obtains in all our borders, and a good spirit of hearing is seen in our congegations. As a Church, we are not very numerous or strong in this Mission, but we are united in affection, prayer, and effort to sustain and extend the cause of the Redeemer. We feel, however, the need of more "power from on high," to render more effectual the efforts put forth, and our prayer is,

"Come, Holy Spirit, heavenly dove, With all thy quickening powers, Come shed abroad a Saviour's love, And this shall kindle ours."

Then shall Jacob arise and do valiantly for the Lord of Hosts, though "he is small."

INGERSOLL.—The congregation is somewhat fluctuating. The Sabbath School is a very pleasing part of our work. We have an excellent Superintendent, united and diligent teachers. Considering the hard times, we have done well in financial matters, having raised for all purposes, \$438.43.

PUTNAMVILLE.—We are living together in peace; our congregations are good, and the preaching services are often enriched with the Divine presence.

TALBOTVILLE.—At Talbotville, our membership has slightly increased. The Sabbath School is doing a good work. The Church debt has been diminished by about \$200. At Front Street, the Master has been pleased graciously to smile upon our efforts to win souls. A Society of 13 members has been formed, and others are manifesting a desire to flee from the wrath to come. The friends determined to arise and build; a brick church, 28x40, is in course of erection, towards which \$500 are promised.

St. Thomas.—Our S. S. has grown considerably, and the congregations have largely increased; our Missionary contributions have exceeded those of any former year in our history. Twelve persons have been received as members, and sixteen are on trial. Our Class and Prayer Meetings, on the whole, have

been well attended, and many of our Church services have been seasons of rich spiritual power and blessing. With a Society of only 40 members, we have raised for Church purposes, over \$560. Some of our friends here, are "ready to every good word and work." "Neither is he that planteth anything, nor he that watereth, but God that giveth the increase."

COLCHESTER.—We have been moving peacefully along, this year, with the exception of our Sandwich East appointment, where the trustees have closed the School House against us. Our congregations continue good. We have had some removals, etc., but the Lord has led others to himself to fill their places. Our membership continues about the same as last year. Our church property is slightly improved.

West Cape, P.E.I.—Difficulties, arising from various sources, have somewhat retarded the work, during the year. Nevertheless, the grace of God has been manifested in the midst of the people.

WHEATLY RIVER.—In the midst of our labors, many have been the refreshing manifestations of God's presence. The congregations are generally good. An appointment has been taken up at Hunter River, with very encouraging results. The S. S. at Wheatly River, has greatly improved in numbers and interest. At Prince Town Road, a new church is being built, at a cost of about \$700; nearly \$400 has been paid, and most of the balance promised; to be paid next fall.

SUMMERSIDE.—We have harmony among ourselves, and our services are times of refreshing from the presence of God. Considering the great depression, we have done well, financially.

BURLINGTON.—Through the year, we have lived in peace, and the Church has been quickened into higher spiritual life.

LITTLE PRAIRIE—We rejoice over the few earnest, faithful, and willing ones who attend the public and social means of grace, with whom the Lord has been pleased to meet, and we have enjoyed many refreshing seasons coming from the presence of the Lord, while thus worshipping together. God very richly blessed His people at La Grange appointment, while engaged in special effort for the salvation of souls, through which a few were induced to turn to the Lord, and inquire, "what must we do to be saved." Our congregations are generally good.
