DETERMINED TO DIE. A BIG DEAL.

OSCAR GALLAGHER TRIES TO KILL HIMSELF WITH GAS.

It Does Not Succeed, He Then Shows His Brains out While Under the Eye of an Officer.

THURSDAY, Pa., Oct. 30.—Oscar Gallagher of the firm of Muller, Gallagher & Vogel, manufacturers of printing and lithographic ink at 105 and 107 Beakman street, New York, was killed by a suicide by inhaling gas in his room at Green's hotel tonight only to prevent himself from being arrested for a charge of embezzlement.

Gallagher registered at Green's on Wednesday afternoon in a firm business suit, which showed no evidence of his state of mind. He was seen very little about the hotel, and seemed to be an entire stranger here.

This evening at 8:30 o'clock, one of the chambermaids smelt a strong odor of gas in the corridor in the third floor, and word was sent to the office. Special Officer Hanson took the third floor, and found the occupant "had" dressed only in his underclothing, and talked with the officer a few minutes, and then ordered him to leave the room.

"I am going to stay with you," said the officer, taking a seat on the bed. "Then the man assumed a pleading tone, and said:

"Can't you see all right I am not going to kill myself. Don't you see I am only drunk."

The officer remained obstinate and refused to go. Gallagher turned away with a worried movement and was followed by the officer, who pulled the door open and saw Gallagher in a state of collapse.

"Well, if you won't go—"

"A sudden movement he snatched a pistol from his pocket and pointed it at the officer's head, and the officer was so frightened and did not know what to do, that he fled to the door and closed it behind him.

"The man was not so great and close to him that for a moment the officer thought he was about to shoot, but the next instant he saw the blood gushing from the hole in the head of the man he had in his arms."

A patrol wagon was summoned, and Gallagher was hurried to the Pennsylvania hospital; he died almost as soon as he arrived.

A search of his effects was made by a coroner's officer, and in his pocket was a piece of the hotel paper all crumpled up and blooded, the ink being little more than dry, on which was written the following in a narrow shaky hand in a marked contrast to his bold firm signature:

"Brooklyn and New York business proved a failure. Why don't you attend to business and let me go home and be in charge of my own life?"

"The letter was dated Oct. 30, and ran: 'If all my money is lost you have to see the Boston Steam Heating Company at 250 South Street, Boston.'"

"Vogel must go out of the business. I will be home in a few days."

A bundle of letters were also found wrapped up in a piece of yellow paper, on which was scrawled with a lead pencil:

Correspondence between C. H. W. Carter and Oscar Gallagher, for the latter, please deliver this as my property to my wife, Emma Gallagher."

The suicide was a large, portly man of between 35 and 40 years of age, with a full black beard, and well dressed. He was evidently a Plumber by birth, and was a professional for this trade. The clerk at the hotel said that he never remembered him as ever stopping there before.
