Legislative Affairs.

Owing to our full report of the Supply debate taking up so much of our space we cannot keep up with current Legislative business at Fredericton.

The chief interest there at the present time, however, is centred in the proposed extension of the Chatham Branch Railway. The consideration being that they were to use their influence, as members of the Government, to secure for him the contract for the Richmond Railway.

The meetings of the committee on the charge against Messrs. Young and Kelly are, we learn, very largely attended, and Mr. Brown was on the third day of his examination, yesterday. We believe that Mr. Brown will be the next witness. The Eastern Question.

The ever-changing course of the Eastern Question still excites the attention of the world, now apparently drifting on the rocks of open hostilities, and then, by some sudden turn, gliding for a time into the calmer waters of diplomacy.

During the past week the most abstract news has been that of the British Government's call on the first class army reserves, an order which also applies to the militia, bringing out some 40,000 men for service.

In consequence of this course Earl Derby resigned his place in the cabinet which has since been filled by the Marquis of Salisbury, as Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs.

The present condition of affairs in the Balkans is such that the Russian occupation of any of the heights near the Bosphorus. A recent despatch from St. Petersburg says the circular sent to the powers by the Marquis of Salisbury, defining England's position, has caused increased irritation in Russian Government circles, and the Russian imperial staff are ordered to prepare for war with England.
