THE PROVINCIAL STOCK FARM.
The Manager's Report to the Board of Agriculture.
The following is the report of the Manager of the Stock Farm, Mr. T. P. Barker, which was submitted to the Board of Agriculture at its Annual Meeting, and which is incorporated in the Agricultural Report for 1884:—
I arrived at the Farm on November 11th, 1884. I found the house in a good state of repair and the barns somewhat better than an ordinarily found upon farms throughout the country; but the latter needed some repairs which I made. other chance without going over a mile and a half away. I had a calf pasture I decided to use the ten acre field for that purpose. About five acres of this field were in crop the year before I went to the Farm, and the other part in grass. I plowed the sod and sowed four acres in oats, four bushels to the acre, and threshed forty-eight bushels. This poor yield was owing partly to the rough grass, which smothered them before they ripened, and partly to a frost which was in the oats that year. I sowed one acre in buckwheat, which yielded about fifteen bushels. On the remainder of this field I planted turnips, fodder corn and potatoes. I put on this part of the field I planted 500 bushels of turnips and four hundred pounds of superphosphate to the acre. The next year I sowed between three and four acres to grass, cutting this year about two tons on the whole field. In three years I have used in all over one hundred and fifty tons of manure, and about \$850 worth of special manure.

throughout the season, but on being pulled were very uneven in size. There are a number of apple orchards consisting of Fameuse, Red Astrachan, New Brunswick, Alexander, etc., in full bearing, also many other varieties of ungrafted fruit. No pure bred herds, a number of grade, Short Horns, Ayrshire and Herefords. The Short Horns is held in high estimation for best purposes, the Ayrshire for their milking qualities. There are a number of good flocks of sheep, no pure bred, but well mixed with Leicester blood. This Society held its annual show on the 17th of October. A good attendance from Fredericton and the surrounding country was on the grounds. The show was not equal to former years, owing to the coldness of the day. The show of horses and colts were excellent, cattle small, sheep fair, and swine no where. Roots and grain were up to the mark. Domestic manufactures were represented. The Society imported a quantity of seeds, etc., from a reliable seedman, which was sold at remunerative prices. Much of the grain raised from this seed is now that of the Society, and has been much better than from home raised seed. Farmers must learn that change of seed will pay 10 or 15 per cent every time.
