

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

ART. 1.

NAME.

The name of this organization shall be the "Sherbrooke Toboggan Club" and is established with the view to encourage Tobogganing.

ART. II.

BADGE AND COLORS.

The colors of the Club Badge shall be three stripes lengthwise of ribbon in Navy Blue, Old Gold and Cardinal, respecively.

ART. III.

STOCK AND SHAREHOLDERS.

SEC. 1.—The capital stock of the Club shall be (\$500.00) Five Hundred Dollars to be divided into (100) One Hundred shares of (\$5.00) Five Dollars each.

SEC. 2.—The Shareholders shall have sole control of the management of the Club.

ART. IV.

OFFICERS.

SEC. 1.—The officers shall consist of an Hon. President, President, Vice-President, Hon. Secretary, Treasurer, and Five Directors, who with the above Offi-

cers, shall constitute a Board of Management to conduct all business of the Club.

SEC. 2.—The foregoing Officers shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Club, by ballot. No nomination shall be made, or received. A plurality shall elect.

SEC. 3.—Any vacancy occurring in any of the foregoing Offices, may be filled by a majority vote of the Board of Officers.

ART. V.

PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENT.

SEC. 1.—It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the Club, to see that the rules are strictly enforced, to declare votes, and to have a general supervision over the affairs of the Club.

SEC. 2.—The Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President in his absence or indisposition.

ART. VI.

HON. SECRETARY.

The Honorary Secretary shall keep an accurate record of the proceedings at all meetings of the Club and Board of Directors. He shall conduct all correspondence of the Club and keep copies of all letters written, and fyles of those received.

ART. VII.

TREASURER.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to collect all moneys due to the Club, give a receipt therefor, and have charge of the same; to pay all bills upon vote of the Board of Directors; to keep an account of all receipts and expenditure, with vouchers therefor, and submit at the Annual meeting a report of the condition of his official affairs with vouchers.

ART. VIII.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

The Board of Directors shall have charge of and control all matters affecting the welfare of the Club, subject to this constitution, decide upon the applications of those wishing to become annual subscribers, and decide all questions of difference that may arise affecting the welfare of the Club. They shall also have full powers to regulate the use of the slide and to declare it closed whenever they deem it necessary.

ART. IX.

REMOVAL OF OFFICERS.

Any officer may be removed from office for just cause, by a vote of two-thirds present at any general meeting convened for that purpose, and his successor imme-

ART. X.

MEETINGS.

SEC. 1.—The Annual General Meeting of the Club shall be held on the 1st Friday in the month of November, at such place as the Board shall decide upon.

SEC. 2.—Special general meetings may be called at any time by the President, or by any two Officers, or by ten shareholders, by a written notice to the Secretary who shall notify the shareholders at least one day before the meeting. Ten members shall form a quorum.

ART. XI.

BOARD MEETINGS.

Meetings of the Board may be called at any time by the President, or upon the written application of two members of the Board to the Secretary, who shall give at least one day's notice in writing to all the members of the Board of such meeting.

ART. XII.

ORDER OF BUSINESS AT MEETINGS.

The order of business at all meetings of the Club shall be: 1st, Reading of

minutes of previous meeting. 2, Reports of Committees. 3, Communications. 4, Collection of Dues. 5, Deferred Business. 6, New Business.

ART. XIII.

MEMBERSHIP.

SEC. 1.—The Club shall consist of the shareholders whose privileges are defined in Art. III. Sec. 2. Subscribes shall not pay any subscription fee for the seasons of 1886-87 but shall pay the annual subscription fee in subsequent years and those who do not pay such annual subscription fee will not have the privilege of holding office or using the Slide.

SEC. 2.—All persons wishing to become subscribers must forward their applications, accompanied by the annual subscription fee, to the Secretary, and upon being accepted by the Board of Directors shall have the privilege of using the slide on all occasions when used by the Club, during the current season. In case of rejection the deposit will be returned.

ART. XIV.

SUBSCRIPTIONS.

The annual subscription fees shall be: Adults, \$3.00; Boys (under 18), \$1.00. Ladies will be admitted free to the slide, but must be accompanied by a shareholder or subscriber. Children of shareholders (under 18) will be allowed to slide free.

VISITORS.

Non-residents of the city may be introduced by a shareholder or subscriber, and will be furnished with a pass to the slide good for two weeks on application to the Secretary. This time may be extended by the Board of Directors.

ART. XVI.

AMENDMENTS.

Ten days' previous notice being given, in writing to all the shareholders this constitution may be altered or amended at the annual meeting, or at a meeting specially called for this purpose, by a vote of two-thirds of the shareholders present, such notice to contain the proposed amendment.

No. 4—Toboggans considered injurious to the slide, or dangerous to sliders may be removed at once by any one of the

officers or caretaker.

No. 5-Non-residents introduced by Shareholders or Subscribers can obtain a permit to use the slide for two weeks by making application to the Secretary.

No. 6 - Members wisning to give tobogganing parties may obtain permission to use the slide for any evening, other than

Club nights, on payment of a fee of 50c.

for each gentleman.

No. 7—Any member guilty of ungentlemanly conduct may be suspended from the privileges of the Club by the Board of Directors.

No. 8—Shareholders, Subscribers and others must make themselves known to caretaker by wearing Club Badge conspicuously, or producing their tickets when wishing to use the slide. Lost badges or tickets can only be replaced at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

No. 9.—Provisional Amendments to these rules shall be made by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors, and shall remain in force until the next ensuing
