SCATHING REBUKE FROM SIR WILFRID

Lavergne and Bergeron Introduce Creed Cry into House Over Saskatchewan Act.

Ottawa, April 21.—When the House of Commons resumed, after the Easter recess today, an ill-advised attempt was made by Armand Lavergne (Independent, Montmagny) and J. G. H. Bergeron (Conservative, Beauharnois) to stir up trouble over the school question in Saskatchewan.

Hon. Mr. Aylesworth, in a clear-cut and forceful speech, said he had given the act the closest consideration, and had been unable to detect even the faintest shadow of illegality.

Members in Inquisitive Mood. When the House opened there was a small attendance and the members were in an inquisitive mood.

Mr. B. Northrup (Conservative, East Hastings) wanted to know if George Watson, K.C., who had been appointed as counsel to assist in the investigation of the marine department, was the same who figured in the inquiry into the provincial election case in the county of West Elgin.

National Transcontinental Accidents. Mr. E. Talbot (Liberal, St. John's) drew attention to a disaster in his county whereby ten men were killed by an explosion of dynamite.

Mr. Lavergne's Unwarranted Criticism. Armand Lavergne, referring to former questions regarding the legality of the Saskatchewan legislation affecting the Catholic minority's right to be taxed for secondary education, said that while he had personal doubts as to the validity of the act, he thought the minister of justice should take the trouble to look into acts which affected the rights of this minority.

Mr. Bergeron, with some heat, declared that when the original clause was discarded for one not so decisive, it left the door open for such legislation as has just been passed by Saskatchewan.

Mr. Bergeron said Mr. Bergeron was one member of a special meeting who was more Catholic than the Pope. From the passing of the autonomy bill to the present time he had received no word of complaint from the Catholic minority in Saskatchewan.

HON. MR. CUSHING TALKS OF 'PHONES

Calgary, April 22.—"What about telephone rates?" Hon. Mr. Cushing, minister of public works of the province of Alberta, who returned yesterday morning after his visit to the purchase of the Bell telephone lines in the province of Alberta, was asked.

"What will be the result?" asked Mr. Cushing. "It will without doubt be that in the future we shall be in a position to extend the service to points where in the past we had not intended to for some time to come, believing that we should have to go into work that now will be unnecessary."

Assassin's Wager Executed. Mexico City, April 22.—Eight students of the Polytechnical institute, who made a daring attempt to assassinate President Cabrera, of Guatemala, were seized and executed without trial according to advices received here.

GREAT STATESMAN HAS PASSED AWAY

Sir Henry J. Campbell—Bannerman Died This Morning After Months of Serious Illness.

London, April 22.—Sir Henry Campbell-Bannerman, ex-prime minister of Great Britain, died this morning at his home, 29 Belgrave Square, S.W., after a serious illness that has lasted for some months.

The late statesman, whose resignation from the post of prime minister of Great Britain was officially announced on April 6, had filled that position since 1907.

He entered parliament in 1863 and continued to represent the Stirling district until his death. He served in turn as financial secretary of the war department, secretary of the administration for Ireland, and twice secretary of state for war.

While Sir Henry was universally respected, he was never regarded as a great political leader, in the sense that Gladstone and Harcourt were leaders.
