The Department of External Affairs announced today that the President of the Republic of Haiti, General Paul Eugene Magloire, accompanied by Madame Magloire will arrive in Ottawa on Wednesday afternoon February 9 to begin a five-day visit to Canada. The President of Haiti and Madame Magloire will also visit Quebec City and Montreal.

Members of the party will include the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs and Madame Mauclair Zephirin, the Secretary of State Marcel Fombrun, Brigadier General Antoine Levelt, Mr. Arsene Magloire, the President's brother, Mr. Daniel Theard, Lieutenant-Colonel Thimoleon Paret, Major Francis Etienne, Dr. Antenor Miot and Lieutenant Charles Turnier.

Details of the visit are as follows:

- 3:30 p.m. Arrival at R.C.A.F. cantilever hangar, Uplands Airport by Pan-American Airways plane from Boston. The President and his wife will be welcomed by His Excellency Right Honourabl Vincent Massey, C.H., Governor-General of Canada, and by the Right Honourable C.D. Howe, the Acting Prime Minister. President Magloire will review a 100-man guard of honour from Air Force Headquarters and the R.C.A.F. Station, Uplands, under Flight Lieutenant C.G. Burt inside the hangar. His Excellency will then introduce the Honourable Patrick Kerwin, Chief Justice of Canada, His Excellency A.H.J. Lovink, Acting Dean of the Diplomatic Corps, His Excellency Jacques Leger, Haitian Ambassador to Canada, other members of the Corps, members of the Cabinet and other dignitaries. Afterward the President will broadcast a brief message.

Visit of the President of the Republic of Haiti - Amendments to Program

Additional information in connection with the visit of the President of the Republic of Haiti is as follows:

- Wednesday, February 9: A bouquet to Madame Magloire will be presented by Mrs. Paul Martin, wife of the Acting Secretary of State for External Affairs. The reviewing party for the guard of honour will conist of the President and the commander of the guard, His Excellency the Governor-General and Mr. Hewe, Captain Adam Butler, the Aide-de-Camp to the Governor-General, and Lieutenant Charles Turnier, the Aide-de-Camp to the President.
- Thursday, February 10: The President and his party will arrive at Union Station at 5:35 p.m. for departure for Quebec City by train. The Presidential party will be accompanied by the Honourable Roch Pinard, Secretary of State, Mr. Martial Petrus, Charge d'Affaires of Haiti, Mr. Yvon Hyppolite, Consul General of Haiti.
- Friday, February 11: The party will alight from the train at 9:00 a.m. and will be greeted by His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor and Madame Fauteux, the Premier or his representative and the Mayor. A suite of rooms will be at the disposal of the President and Madame Magloire at Bois de Coulonge. The party will leave by train for Montreal that evening at 11:55 p.m.
- Saturday, February 12: An official welcome will be given at 8:00 a.m. at the Windsor Station by the Mayor and Executive Council. The reception by the Latin-American Consular Club of Montreal will take place at 6:00 p.m. at the Cercle Universitaire, Sherbrooke Street East. The reception by the Consul and Madame Martijn will be at 7:30 p.m.
