## PROSPECTUS.

Cette Institution fut fondée par la Congrégation de Sainte-Croix, en 1847, et incorporée par un acte du Parlement, en 1849. ### OBJET ET DIVISION DE L'ENSEIGNEMENT.

#### *Cours Préparatoire.*

Ce cours est une préparation au cours commercial et au cours classique. Il se donne dans une maison spéciale, dirigée par la même Congrégation, Notre-Dame, Côte-des-Neiges. On y reçoit les enfants de cinq à onze ans. Des soins particuliers leur sont donnés, en rapport, autant que possible, avec les soins de la famille.

#### *Cours Commercial.*

C'est surtout par ce cours que le Collège de Saint-Laurent se distingue et se place au niveau des meilleures institutions commerciales du Canada. Ce cours comprend cinq années. Il embrasse toutes les branches des sciences, et tout ce qui constitue la haute éducation commerciale. Les élèves y sont surtout exercés à la pratique des affaires.

On délivrera des diplômes aux élèves qui auront subi un examen avantageux sur les matières d'enseignement de la classe d'affaires.

*Cours Classique.*

Ce cours comprend six années.

# ST-LAURENT COLLEGE

(NEAR MONTREAL.)

## PROSPECTUS.

This Institution was founded by the Rev. Fathers of the Congregation of the Holy Cross in 1847, and incorporated by act of Parliament in 1849. It combines the advantages of a christian education with those of a thorough commercial and classical course; as is fully testified by the positions now occupied by its Alumni and the continued patronage of the public in general.

### OBJECT AND DIVISION OF THE COURSE.

#### *Preparatory Course.*

This course serves alike as a preparation for the commercial and classical courses. It is composed exclusively of pupils between the ages of five and eleven. A special house (Our Lady, Côtés-Neiges) is set apart for their reception, furnishing an excellent opportunity for the particular advancement of young children, while it facilitates, at the same time, the means of bestowing on them that necessary attention which their age requires.

#### *Commercial Course.*

It is the superiority of this course which has always distinguished the College of St-Laurent, and placed it in the foremost rank amongst the commercial institutions of the country. It embraces all branches of science included in a complete theoretical and practical commercial education. Diplomas will be delivered to those who pass a satisfactory examination on all branches connected with practical commerce. This course embraces five years.



*Classical Course.*

This course comprises six years.

N. B.—One of the particular advantages of this Institution is, that the different courses, viz : preparatory, commercial and classical are taught through the medium of the French and the English languages.

Pupils entering after the commencement of the term are charged only for the remaining portion, no deduction however is made for a month already commenced. Pupils are received at any time during the year.

Each student must constantly be provided with at least :  
2 completé suits (including cap or hat) besides overcoat and fur-cap for the winter season, 12 handkerchiefs, 12 shirts, 6 pairs of socks, 2 pairs of shoes or boots.

For the better maintenance of order and discipline, pupils coming from other institutions are received only on the best recommendations.

All mail matter addressed to students, is subject to the inspection of the President or his delegate.

Parents will receive a semi-annual Bulletin of the progress, application, health, &c., of their children.

There is no uniform.

No deduction is made for the month of June.

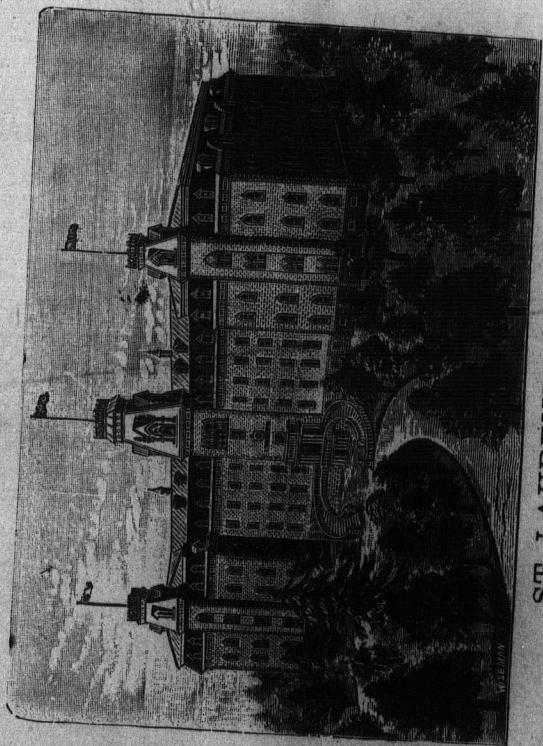
