**An Act to authorize the Courts of Queen's Bench and Common Pleas for Upper Canada to admit Peter Taylor Poussett as an Attorney.**

**WHEREAS** Peter Taylor Poussett hath, by his petition, set forth that Preamble.  
 he, the said Peter Taylor Poussett, has been duly admitted an Attorney of Her Majesty's Superior Courts of Common Law and Equity at Westminster, and hath produced evidence of his admission therein, and he has since filled offices in the administration of justice in this Province  
 5 for upwards of six years, and he is now desirous to practice the law as an Attorney; and whereas it is reasonable, under the circumstances of the case, that the Courts of Law in Upper Canada should be authorized, in their discretion, to admit the said Peter Taylor Poussett to practice as an Attorney, and it is therefore expedient to grant the prayer of his petition;  
 10 Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

**1.** It shall and may be lawful for the Courts of Queen's Bench and Courts in U.  
 Common Pleas of Upper Canada, in their discretion, to admit the said C. may admit  
 Peter Taylor Poussett as an Attorney of the said Courts, any law or Poussett as an  
 15 usage to the contrary notwithstanding. Attorney.

**2.** This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
