OF THE

FOR THE YEAR ENDING APRIL 30TH, 1863.

The Missionary Committee to the Friends of Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada West :

Again it is our duty to come before you with another yearly Report of the Primitive Methodist Missionary Society. These annual occasions and the matters they embrace strongly remind us of the flight of time, and the importance of doing our duty in the state of life to which it has pleased God to call us.

Although it is to this quiet corner of the world, where we have found a home as Colonists, that our attention is more especially called, yet we cannot be insensible to the spiritual condition of the world's family, of which we form a small fraction. Political and commercial changes have followed each other so rapidly of late, accompanied with new modes which science has invented for bringing the various races into fellowship, that Christianity has immensely gained, and the Mission work rendered accessible to human beings of every hue of skin and height of stature, in all lands from the equator to the poles. But if the ancient barriers are fallen, and access is everywhere given to the Missionary, who is now found elevating the Banner of the Cross on the five quarters of the globe; yet the task of converting the people to the faith of Christ would appear hopeless, did we not believe that many

have believed the truth, and the same record assures us that "the mountain of the Lord's house shall be established upon the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills, and all the nations shall flow unto it." To reach this grand climax, much has been done; but a vast balance is still required. There are nine hundred and sixty millions of human beings without the saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus, and there are but three thousand *regular* missionaries sent forth,—this amounts to *one* missionary to every three hundred thousand persons.

We rejoice however to know, that the Bible Society and the Missionary Societies of the Churches in Europe are advancing. Our own Church in Britain marches on with the rest, and is sanguine in relation to fulfilling her part, notwithstanding the heavy privations which hundreds of our brethren are suffering in Lancashire and elsewhere, in consequence of the war in the States of America. The last Report of the Society at home shows progress in Australia and New Zealand, an increase in funds and membership, and new missions contemplated in Africa and elsewhere.

But Canada is our text on this occasion. This question will be sufficiently large for us to expatiate upon if we had a thousand times more means of resources and power to be brought to bear. This Colony, one of the most important of the forty which constitutes the Colonial Empire united under one sceptre, a hundred years ago was almost an unbroken forest down to the water edges, where silence and solitude reigned, except a few RED MEN gliding along in hunting expeditions. Now Canada East contains 1,110,664 inhabitants, and Canada West 1,396,091; total, 2,506,755; being an excess for Canada West of 285,427 inhabitants. Several Churches have powerful Missions distributed over the large territory in which this population is spread; and the British Primitive Methodist Church, having a mission from God, over thirty years ago proceeded to carry it out in these lands. The Mission commenced in Toronto, with a few emigrants; and, without enumerating the self-sustaining Stations, we now number 29 Missions, 35 Missionaries, and 2,721 Members; increase during the year, 381 Members. there was expended on these Missions \$6,255 14 ; there was raised \$4,419 15 ; which balance was met by profits on connexional books sold, and a grant from our English Conference. During the year a number of new churches have been erected, Sabbath Schools formed, fresh places missioned, and congregations raised ; and as evidence of the grace of God, several have departed this life, to be "forever with the Lord."

Our friends will know from the last printed Report 1862 , which nearly all our subscribers have examined, that our operations annually enlarge, and that the Committee is continually urged to appoint additional Missionaries to old Stations ; to divide Missions, to work them with greater effect, as some extend over a dozen townships ; and also to take up fresh places on new ground, where many of our Members have moved, and immigrants lately from the old country. But to carry out *all* the suggestions of the Missionaries, and to respond to all the calls of the people to go over to help them, is impossible.

To some of our sanguine Missionaries and zealous people, the conduct of our Missionary Committee appears scarcely sufficiently enterprising, in not pushing on, and taking up the *whole* country ! But it should be remembered, that it is a maxim in our church polity never to run into debt, nor trade on borrowed capital. If the funds will not meet the demands, then the labourers must go *short* in equal proportions. Were the Committee to answer every call, and rush out hosts of men that are waiting to go, the means would not correspond, and Missionaries on Stations would be *seriously short*, not merely of their Conference salaries, which even now are not in all cases made up, but of the quarterly grants apportioned by the Conference to each Mission Station. The Committee is therefore, with all the prudent zeal and careful management they can exercise, often found between a sharp cross fire—from the calls of the Missionaries and people for increased help—the Treasurer, who holds up his diminishing cash in hand—and the Home Authorities admonishing us of reduced assistance, and the necessity of self-reliance and becoming independent.

Now to harmonize and hurry on this enterprise, and make real, *solid headway*, a practical attention to the scriptural direction would comport with the exigencies of the case, and the whole business would be done, with the influence of God's holy Spirit, truly satisfactory. and that is, to give as God has prospered us. Our Ministers are all subscribers to the Society; and to the numerous calls, especially on some Stations, they give with cheerful promptitude, and retain but little in hand for their varied needs, and we are not certain that they could double their subscriptions; but many of our farming, mechanical, and business friends, who a dozen years ago gave fifty cents and a dollar, their capital has grown since then from twenty to a hundred per cent., and the printed yearly Report still shows opposite their names the same amounts. Now we believe if our kind brethren and sisters pondered deeply this matter, in relation to their present means—the instructions of the Bible—and the claims of perishing sinners in Canada, they would enlarge their contributions; and then would our Missionary Society, with the blessing of God, do its work gloriously.

Now to be consistent with our holy religion, every one of us should either go in person to preach Christ, or sustain those that do go. Now, if we take any assembly as a case in point, we shall find few that can go in person—we would have to pass them by for want of physical ability, mental qualification, or aptitude to teach—therefore such must assist, and do the work by substitution; and this will be acceptable to God. Besides, giving in this sense according to the rule of our religion, the individual is blessed in the act: it checks the tendency to the vice of hoarding; and to that of loving money, which is the "root of all evil": it restrains the individual from extravagance in fine dress, furniture, high living, and waste on valueless and insignificant gewgaws: it imbues children with an example to give, which teaches them the *real use* of wealth; and inspires families with the importance of laying up treasure in heaven.

To those who are straitened and poor, (and they are the most numerous classes amongst us,) giving to the work of saving souls encourages confidence and faith in God; but

pleading poverty, as an excuse for not giving, is discrediting the promises of God, and losing sight of God's special providence ; for there is that giveth, and it increaseth ; and there is that which withholdeth more than is meet, and it tendeth to poverty. Finally, Brethren and Sisters, in connexion with your present duty—the Missionary Society—the claims of thousands of the unsaved in Canado, hear and ponder the words of God himself, “ Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might ; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom in the grave whither thou goest.”

STATE OF THE MISSIONS.

KINGSTON.—Increase, twenty-one.—We have regarded this Mission with special interest from its commencement, as forming a sort of centre of Missionary operations for our Eastern work. For several years the cause was a struggle for existence ; but of late, the erection of a commodious church in the city during the last year has given an additional stimulus to the enterprise. Open-air preaching in the summer, faithful pastoral visiting, and special revival services in the winter, have been blessed.

PORLAND.—Increase, four.—The increase the preceding year was fifty ; and although the number this year is few, yet the Mission has gained in consolidation, and it numbers a membership of 282. In July last, this Mission detached Piccadilly from itself, as a separate Station, with a few preaching places and a number of members, which partly accounts for the small increase shown. May the onward movement still be sounded !

NAPANEE.—Increase, one.—We were *sanguine enough to believe*, that as this Mission commenced the year with two Missionaries, additional places might be missioned, and consequently an increase of the membership would have corresponded. After the first quarter of the year, however, one of Missionaries was withdrawn, and the work on the old ground has not been much expanded. Still we trust that vigorous and faithful effort will realize its appropriate results on this Station.

COLLINGSBY.—Increase, eleven.—This Mission, made from Kingston, progresses ; the new church erected, and the unwearied labours of the Missionary, with the close co-operation of the official brethren, have resulted in solid improvement.

PICCADILLY.—Increase, about thirty.—In July last this Mission was formed from Portland. The working brethren need all our sympathy and help, as this is real mission ground. A new church is contemplated, which will be the first in the Township. May success reward the labours of our friends.

ORANGEVILLE.—Increase, fifty-six.—This Mission has been prosecuted with alternate failure and success for several years. The last year, an additional Missionary was employed ; and we trust that all the interests of the Mission, as well as its numerical success, indicate general prosperity. We hope the period is not far distant when this Mission will be *circuited*,—self-sustaining.

OSPREY.—Increase, nineteen.—We are glad to report an increase on this Station ; but regret that the progress has been slow from the commencement. The newness of the country the poverty of the settlers, and the frequent harvest failures, have had their influence to retard and discourage ; but we hope energetic perseverance, and the support and sympathy of the friends of Canadian Missions, will bring up in fruitfulness this part of our Lord's moral vineyard, and speedily.

COLLINGWOOD.—Increase, fifteen.—This is a new Station, made from the preceding Mission, and although feeble, we trust the yearly increase is a precursor of greater things.

WALPOLE.—This Station has had some local difficulties, which have reacted unfavorably ; and consequently the brethren have not been able to report, as most other Stations, an increase ; yet we have confidence in the work reviving, and souls being saved.

BLENHEIM.—Increase, twenty-two.—The special efforts this Mission put forth last winter were effective, and the Mis-

sionary and Official Brethren are united in faith for a steady and general accession of souls, as their reward and crown of rejoicing.

BRANTFORD.—The work on this Mission has suffered a contraction, and the church difficulty has had influence to discourage. We sympathise with the Minister and membership, and trust they will ultimately succeed with the Brantford church, and extend in embracing *new* preaching places on the Mission.

PARIS.—This Mission, formerly a part of Brantford, has suffered partial declension : but hope is in the ascendant, and our brother appointed last Conference will not be lacking in pushing on the Mission enterprise in this town and its vicinities.

GRAND RIVER.—Increase, thirty-seven.—This Mission has, by God's blessing on the combined labours of his servants, made definite advancement. Many souls have been converted, and all are encouraged to look for still greater things.

WALSINGHAM.—Very likely and acceptable agents have been appointed on this Mission, and persevering labours have been applied, but the Station has not advanced as expectation would warrant ; still the brethren are disposed to hope, and believe on. May they soon see glorious fruit, as the reward of *united* and patient toil.

GUELPH.—This is one of the oldest of our Missions, and is stationary in relation to membership ; yet here hope is revived, as providence is opening the way in the erection of a new church, which will give more scope and opportunity to reach unsaved souls. May the plans for enlargement and success be crowned with God's special benediction.

GALT.—To give this place every advantage the Conference can render, this Mission is incorporated with Blenheim ; and we hope this arrangement the coming year God will bless to the Society and preaching places with which Galt is connected.

PEEL AND WELLESLEY.—Increase, fifty.—This Mission has made noble progress, and was last Conference made a CIRCUIT, and is now self-sustaining! We hope other Missions will speedily follow this example—drop from the Mission roll, and become independent Circuits.

BRANT.—Increase, eleven.—We are glad of an onward movement on this Mission during the year, and take it as indicating an uninterrupted progress in gathering souls in this important section of our Colony.

MINTO.—Through the affliction of the Missionary, and connecting causes, the membership is reported short of last year; but we are sanguine that the Conference appointments will result in a quick improvement. Let us have faith in God.

KINCARDINE.—Increase, sixty-two.—We are glad that on the side of the other Lake God is working with his servants. Go on brethren, and prosper, the Lord being with you.

LONDON.—From this Mission as a centre, others have been formed: and our earnest desire and prayer is, that this Mission will not pause in the career of progress; but go on again, as in the beginning, with strength renewed, in converting sinners to God.

BOSANQUET.—Increase, thirty-three.—This Mission has advanced steadily from the commencement of its usefulness, without let or hindrance. May its *future* be even more glorious than its *past*, in enlarging our Missionary Church in Canada.

MACGILLIVRAY.—Increase, four.—Although but few are reported as the fruits of the year's labour, yet we have reason to believe the work has been consolidating, and that a large amount of good seed has been deposited in good ground.

STRATFORD.—Increase, twenty-eight.—This Mission sweeps over a large extent of country, and affords a fine field for winning souls. The Missionaries are in their *youth* and *prime*—are zealous for God, the conversion of sinners, and the pros-

perity of Primitive Methodism. May they abundantly realize their hearts' desire !

PLYMPTON.—This Mission, formerly an outpost of London, is *quiet*; but we hear of signs of waking up to do its work. May the Holy Ghost be abundantly given, to crown simple, direct effort in winning souls.

CHATHAM.—Increase, eleven.—Through much labour and perseverance, the apathy and deadness of sinners have been stirred in this section. A church has been erected, and a Mission that will be powerful has been traced. A number of souls have been saved. May they be gloriously multiplied.

CARRADOC.—Increase, thirty-one.—This was formerly a wing of the London Mission; and we are happy to see gradual development and extension.

STANLEY.—Increase, nine.—The increase on this Station is small; but the Missionary, full of health and strength, and on real Mission ground, will in future, we trust, report quarterly to the Committee respectable increases. O for a mighty move in this corner of the moral vineyard !

JUBILEE.—Increase, twelve.—As the expenses of this Mission are paid out of the Jubilee Fund, EXPECTATION is strongly directed to its operations; and as the Missionary is directed to report monthly to the CHRISTIAN JOURNAL his success and progress, we hope, through the faith and prayers of the Church, the Missionary's journal from time to time will be a glorious record of sinners saved; and that the Mission, established upon a solid foundation, may be an enduring monument of the liberality of the contributors to the Primitive Methodist Jubilee Fund, inaugurated Anno Domini 1860.
