

CAP. I.

An ACT to continue, for One Year, " An Act to provide for the performance of Quarantine, and more effectually to provide against the introduction of Infectious or Contagious Diseases, and the spreading thereof in this Island."

[20th September, 1834.]

WHEREAS a certain Act was passed in the General Assembly of Preamble. this Island, in the Third Year of the Reign of his present Majesty, King William the Fourth, intituled "An Act to provide for the per- 8. Wm. 4., Cap. 1. " formance of Quarantine, and more effectually to provide against the "introduction of Infectious or Contagious Diseases, and the spreading " thereof in this Island ;" And whereas the period limited in the said Act for its duration is now about to expire; and, the said Act being found highly beneficial to this Colony, it is deemed expedient to continue the same, in the manner hereinafter provided :

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly of Act above recited Newfoundland, in Colonial Parliament assembled, that the said Act continued in force passed in the Third Year of the Reign of His Gracious Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled "An Act to provide for the performance of "Quarantine, and more effectually to provide against the introduction "of Infectious or Contagious Diseases, and the spreading thereof in this "Island," and every matter, clause, and thing therein contained, shall be in force and continue for the further period of One whole Year from the passing of this Act, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly of this Colony, and no longer.

CAP. II.

An ACT to suspend, until the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-Five, the operation of an Act passed in the last Session of Parliament, entitled "An Act for registering the Names of Persons entitled to Vote at Elections."

[20th September, 1834.]

WHEREAS a certain Act was passed in the General Assembly of Preamble, this Island, in the Fourth Year of the Reign of His Present Majesty, A Wm 4 intituled "An Act for registering the Names of Persons entitled to 4. Wm. 4., Cap. 15. Vote at Elections;" And whereas circumstances have occurred to prevent the said Act being carried into operation within the time thereby intended, and it is therefore necessary to extend the period for the commencement thereof, in the manner hereinafter provided :

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, of Operation of the Newfoundland, in Parliament assembled, that every thing required or above recited Act allowed by the said Act to be done at or by the Courts of General 1835. or Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be held next after the First Day of July, in this present Year, shall and may be done at or by the Courts of General or Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be holden next after the First Day of July, that will be in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-Five, and that every thing required or allowed by the said Act to be done in this present Year, shall and may be done or allowed to be done in the said Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-Five, upon the same Days of the Month, or at or within the same times of the Year, as such things are respectively required by the said Act to be done or allowed in this present Year; and that every thing so done in pursuance of this Act shall be as good and valid, to all intents and purposes, as if done in this present Year in conformity with the said first-mentioned Act.

II.—And be it further enacted, that in the Election of all and every Voters at Elections Member and Members to serve in the Commons House of Assembly in held prior to 1836, not required to be this Colony, whose Election shall take place previously to the Thirty- registered.

First Day of December which will be in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-Five, no Vote of any Householder or Elector of any District of this Island, shall be refused or rejected at such Election or Elections, on the ground, or by reason of the non-registration of the Names of such Elector or Householder, but such Vote shall be as good and valid as though the Voter's or Elector's Name had been duly registered.

CAP. III.

An ACT to authorize the Issue of Treasury Notes.

[20th September, 1834.]

BE IT ENACTED, by the Governor, Council and Assembly of Newfoundland, in Parliament assembled, that it shall and may be lawful for the Governor or Acting Governor of Newfoundland, for the time Governor authorized being, when and as soon as he may deem necessary, to appoint three sioners to issue fit and proper Persons as Commissioners to issue Treasury Notes to Treasury Notes. the amount of Five Thousand Six Hundred Pounds Sterling as follows:

Twenty Treasury Notes of One Hundred Pounds each; Fifly Treasury Notes of Fifly Pounds each; Forty-Four Treasury Notes of Twenty-Five Pounds each:

which Treasury Notes shall bear Interest at the rate of Six \mathcal{P} cent \mathcal{P} Which are to bear annum, from the Day they shall be issued in payment from the Trea-sury, and shall be indented and impressed with the words "Newfoundland," signed by the Treasurer of the Colony, and Countersigned by the said Commissioners, and contain the following figures and words:

All which Notes shall be of the same Date, and when so completed and Signed, shall be delivered to the Treasurer by the Persons vered to Treasurer, appointed to Countersign the same; and the Treasurer shall be whole to be accoun-table for them. accountable for all such Notes so delivered to him.

11.-And be it further enacted, that when and so often as Money shall become due and payable by virtue of any Act or Acts already passed, or that may be passed, by the General Assembly of this Colony, Warrants on the and Warrants for the same are produced for Payment to the Treasurer payable of the Colony, he shall pay the amount of such Warrants, on demand, in Notes or Silver at in Silver, or in the said Notes, to the Person or Persons entitled to the receive the same, at his or their Election, which Notes shall be again received at the Treasury in this Colony at their specified value,

111.—And be it further enacted, that the Treasurer of this Colony on each Note the shall, on the day and before he issues any of the Notes in Payment as day it was issued, aforesaid, write on the same the Day of the Month and Year they are so trom which time in-terest shall com- issued, and sign his Name thereto, and from the time so written by him in the said Notes so issued, they shall bear the Interest aforesaid.

IV.—And be it further enacted, that when the said Notes, or any of Officers of Customs them, shall be received by the Collector or Sub-Collectors of Customs in Payment of Da-ties, to be cancelled of this Colony, in Payment for Duties, the said Collectors or Subon being paid into Collectors shall write on the said Notes the Day of the Month and Year the same were so received ; and the Person or Persons delivering them in Payment, shall sign his or their Name thereto; and the said Notes, when received by the Treasurer of the Colony from the said Collector or Sub-Collectors, shall not again be issued from the Treasury, but shall be Cancelled in such manner as the Governor or Acting Governor for the time being shall deem expedient.

V.--And be it further enacted, that if any Person or Persons whomsoever shall Counterfeit any of the Notes aforesaid, issued by virtue of this Act, or alter any of the same so that they shall appear of greater value than when originally issued, or shall knowingly pass, or give in Payment, any of the Notes aforesaid so Counterfeited or altered, every Person convicted thereof, shall be transported for the period of his or their natural lives, or be imprisoned and kept to hard Labour for such period as the Court before which such Party or Parties shall be so convicted, shall determine.

VI.—And be it further enacted, that so soon as the Treasurer of the Colony shall, by advertisement in the *Royal Gazette*, appoint a time at which he will receive such Notes and Pay the amount thereof, together with the Interest due thereon, in Gold or Silver, giving Sixty Days' notice of such redemption, and mentioning the number so required to be produced for Payment, and in failure of such Notes being produced at the time limited, all future interest on the same shall cease; and no other or greater amount of Interest shall be paid on such Notes so called in, than was due and payable at the date the same were required to be presented to the Treasurer as aforesaid.

VII.—And be it further enacted, that the Treasurer of the Colony, together with the Persons appointed to Countersign the said Notes, tract for Printing the are hereby empowered to contract for, and superintend the Printing and completing of such Notes, as are directed to be issued by virtue of this Act.

VIII.—And be it further enacted, that in case the Governor or Acting Governor of the said Colony, for the time being, shall, within the period of *Twelve Months* from the passing of this Act, by his Warrants or Warrant, require the said Commissioners to re-issue Notes to the amount of such aforesaid Notes so received in Payment at the Treasury, or to the amount of any part of such Notes, it shall and may be lawful for the said Commissioners to issue New Notes to the amount which such Warrant or Warrants shall require; Provided the amount of new Notes so to be issued shall not exceed the amount of the Notes so from time to time received at the Treasury.

An ACT for granting to His Majesty the Sum of Five Hundred Pounds, Sterling, to be appropriated and applied towards defraying any Expenses which may arise in the event of the introduction and spreading of Asiatic Cholera in this Colony.

[20th September, 1834.]

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY,

WE, His Majesty's dutiful and loyal Subjects the Commons of Preamble.
