### AGRICULTURAL ENGAGEMENTS.

Sept'r 1—Last day for entry of cattle, sheep, swine and poultry, at the Kentville Exhibition. H. Lovett, Secretary.

Sept'r 3-5—Floricultural and Poultry Exhibition at Halifax.

Sept'r 7—Last day for entry of horses, cattle, sheep, swine and poultry, at the Provincial Exhibition, Truro. W. D. Dimock, Secretary.

Sept'r 21—Last day for entry of plants, flowers, fruit, grain, roots, vegetables, implements and manufactures, at the Provincial Exhibition, Truro.

Sept'r 28—Last day for entry of plants, fruits, flowers, grains, roots, vegetables, implements and manufactures, at Kentville Exhibition.

Sept'r 30-Oct'r 4—Provincial Agricultural and Industrial Exhibition at Truro.

Oct'r 4—Public Auction at Truro of thorough-bred cattle, sheep and pigs imported from England by the Central Board of Agriculture.

Oct'r 7-10—King's County Agricultural and Industrial Exhibition, Kentville.

Dec'r 3—Annual Meetings of all Agricultural Societies throughout the Province for election of officers and other business.

### FRUIT FOR THE PROVINCIAL EXHIBITION.

YARMOUTH, 14th Aug., 1878.

DEAR SIR,—Persuade your fruit-growers to get together a collection of apples from Halifax County for the Provincial Exhibition at Truro. A collection was exhibited there in 1876 by W. C. Archibald of Musquodoboit, but none was shown last year at Kentville. "Not necessarily grown by the exhibitor," is the condition of the prize list.

I shall address all the off counties, and try to get a fuller representation this year than we have ever had of the adaptability of the several counties of the Province to fruit growing. In the last volume of the American Pomological Society, I was both amused and surprised to observe how far the President of the Fruit Growers' Association of Ontario went out of his way to decry Nova Scotia. I have not the volume on hand, but it was to the effect that "except in and around Annapolis, a dreary waste existed in this Province"; and this in the face of and oblivious to the excellent report of Dr. C. C. Hamilton in the previous volume of the same Society, covering several pages, and giving the history, progress and present status of fruit growing in the several counties, estimating the production of apples in 1874 as 200,000 barrels in the three counties alone of King's, Hants, and Annapolis.

Probably no county in the Province offers conditions more adverse to Fruit Growing than the County of Yarmouth, and yet within the last ten years we have succeeded in growing very fair specimens of some forty odd standard varieties. Any of the kinds shown from this County I am quite confident could be grown anywhere in the Province; several of our seedlings are worthy of adoption, and I am more desirous of seeing the kinds that do well in the coast counties than to note the finer specimens of the Annapolis Valley, with which we can never compete, and many of which are quite useless for us, while the former might succeed.

The Keswick Codlin will grow vigorously, bear early and annually, heavy crops, anywhere in the Province; the Duchess of Oldenburg comes next with me, and Gravenstein is third. I am waiting patiently to see what will come 4th, 5th, &c., on our coast line.

Inland we can grow even the Newtown Pippin. I had two trees of this among my kinds on trial, for some six or seven years. Convinced, at last, that they would never grow to any size, or fruit with me, I dug them up, and sent them to our Club Farm, at Carlton, some fifteen miles inland; in two years they were transformed from stunted, moss-covered scrubs, into healthy, vigorously growing trees; this year one of the trees has one apple on it, for which I have offered one dollar, if it be kept to maturity, and for exhibition.

Should this be in time for next number of *Journal of Agriculture*, and there be room for it, will the officers of the several Agricultural Societies in the Counties of Digby, Lunenburg, Shelburne, Cumberland, Antigonish, Guysborough, Cape Breton, Richmond, Inverness, and Victoria, kindly accept it as equally addressed to them, and take measures to secure a representative collection from their respective counties at the Exhibition. There is no competition between the counties. Usually, if but one collection only is shown, first prize is awarded, but it will be interesting and instructive to learn the relative standing of the several Counties of the Province, and from time to time hereafter, to record changes and progress, as industry, enterprise and perseverance attain success.
