

BILL.

An Act to lessen the expense of Solemnizing Marriage by License.

WHEREAS it is in accordance with the dictates of **Preamble** sound policy, to encourage early Marriages in a thinly populated country, by lessening the expense of obtaining Marriage Licenses: and whereas it is expedient to relieve the Governor from the trouble of granting and signing such Licenses, and to authorize certain County and City Officers to grant and sign them: Be it therefore enacted, &c,

That after the passing of this Act, the Governor shall not By whom I i-10 have the power to grant licenses for the solemnization be granted in of Marriage; but the authority now vested in the Governor future. to grant such licenses shall henceforth be given to and conferred upon the Register of any County and the Mayor of any City, who are hereby severally authorized and em-

- 15 powered to grant licenses for the public solemnization of marriage, without publication of banns, by any person legally qualified to solemnize and perform the ceremony or rite of marriage, within the limits of their respective jurisdictions.
- 20 II. Every license to solemnize marriage shall state Form of Lithe name and place of abode of each of the contracting parties, and be signed by the County Register (or Mayor as the case may be,) who shall also affix thereto his office seal; and all such licenses shall be in the following form 25 of words:

nize and perform the same: Provided always, that by reason of any affinity, consanguinity, pre-contract, or any other lawful cause, there be no legal impediment in this behalf; otherwise, if any fraud shall appear to have been committed, at the time of granting this license, either by 5 false suggestions or concealment of the truth, that then this License shall be null and void, to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

III. And be it enacted, That before granting a license given before for the solemnization of marriage, in any case under the 15 authority of this Act, the County Register, (or Mayor) shall require two reputable freeholders, or householders, resident in his County, (or City,) to come before him and state that they are personally acquainted with the con-20 tracting parties, and know of no lawful impediment to their marriage : such freeholders or householders, being in the opinion of such Register (or Mayor) good sureties, shall then be required to enter into a bond to the Queen , that there is no lawful 25 in the penal sum of cause or impediment to hinder the contracting parties from being married, which bond or obligation shall be fyled by the Register (or Mayor) as a record of his office, and be in the following form of words:
