PREFACE TO SUPPLEMENT.

Encouraged by the success which has followed the publication of the Ontario Law Index (1867-1895), and the favour with which it has been received by the Legal Profession and the general Public, I feel warranted in preparing a Supplement thereto, bringing the work down to the present date. This Supplement is framed on precisely the same plan as the former Index; and contains, not only every chapter, Public and Private, whether repealed, superseded, or still in force, but every subject upon which the Legislature has passed, including the last series of the Revised Statutes (1897), continuing the same with all amendments and additions in an unbroken succession of references down to, and including, the Acts of the present year. The Index and Supplement combined will therefore cover all the ground of Ontario Legislation from beginning to end, and will, I trust, continue to give satisfaction, and prove useful and convenient to all those interested in the legislation of the country.
