A. B. C. Priest Lectures to Presbyterian Theological Students on the Subject of Preaching. (New York Herald Dec. 4.) For the first time in the history of the Union Theological Seminary, and probably for the first time in the history of any Protestant divinity school in this country, the lecture platform was last evening by a priest of the Roman Catholic Church in presence of the liberal which has long actuated the authorities of that well known Protestant institution.
