The show of Live Stock will be something like the show of Live Stock at the London Exhibition of 1883, after a voyage of nine months.

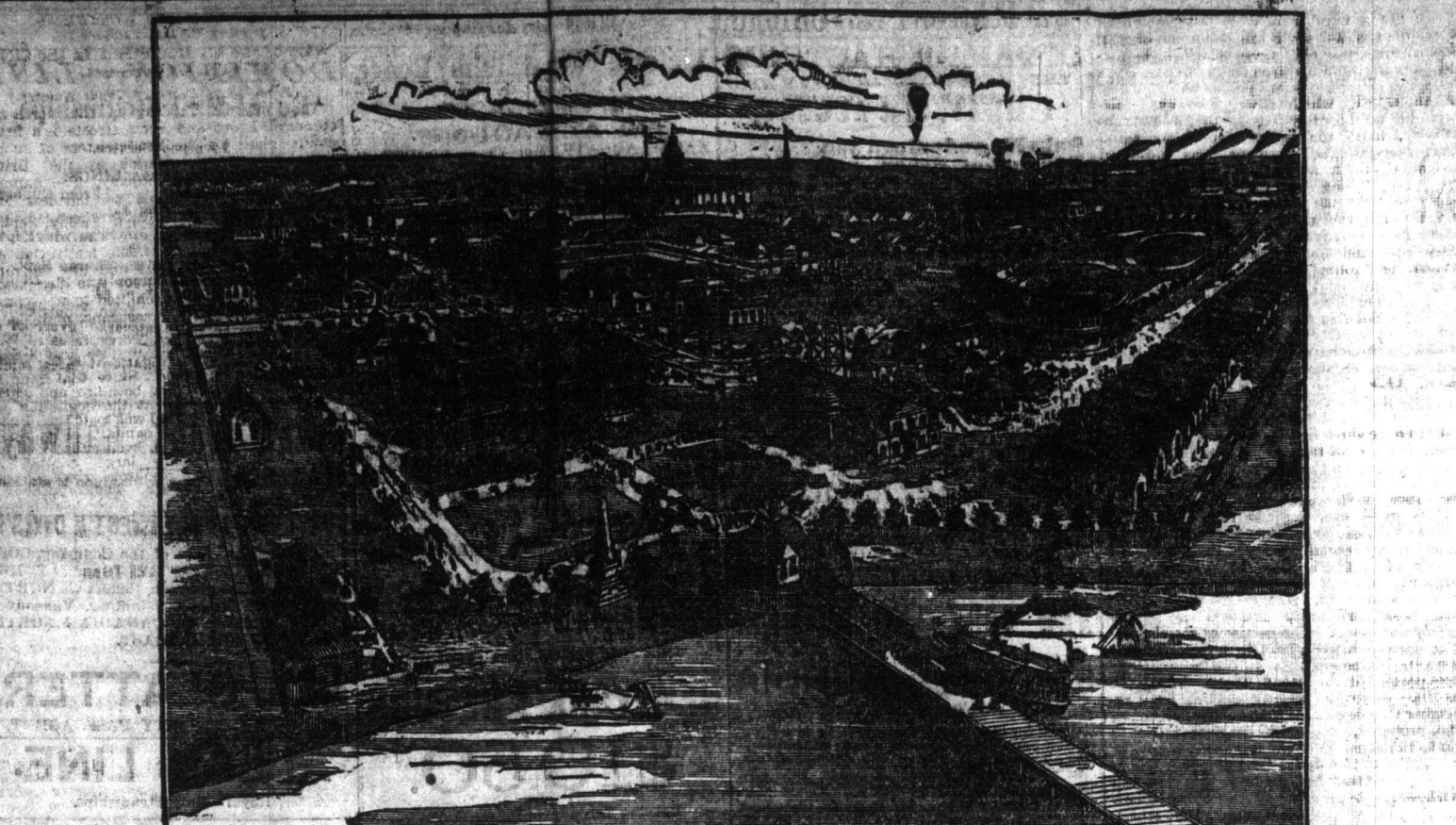
