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## JUDICIAL JOTTINGS.

COURT OF QUEEN'S BENCH (appeal side).

Case inscribed:—

E. Courville, Appelant & H. Leduc, Respondent, issued on the 4th of May 1885. Messrs Lacroix & Papineau, Appelant's Attorneys.

Mr Justice Doherty will render judgments at half past ten (this morning) 5th may instant.

Mr Narcisse G. Bourbonniere, notary, has been appointed curator to the substitution instituted by the last will of late Joseph Durand, notary.

Mr F. L. Beique having been sued for the value of a horse which he accidentally killed while on a ride, last winter, came Saturday last with an action *en garantie* against the City of Montreal, claiming that the accident occurred through an obstruction on the road due to the negligence of the Defendant.

The cause of action *EX RE Corine Dandaram vs J. Die St-Louis & Freres*, mentioned in the list of judgments published this day, is for damages resulting in the death of Honoré Clermont, the Plaintiff's husband, from wounds received by him, while working at the employ of Defendant, as a mason, at the Drill Hall in Montreal. The Plaintiff took an action for \$5000 damages claiming negligence and carelessness on the part of said Defendants and of their employees. Judgment was rendered in favor of said Plaintiff, for \$1000 with costs. Messrs Prefontaine & Lafontaine attorneys for said Plaintiff.
