REPORT.

Great and manifold are the blessings vouchsafed by Almighty God, through the economy of salvation, to the human family. Very precious promises abound in the word of God with regard to our sin-cursed world; promises rich in the fulness of gospel blessings, light, life and power; gracious deliverance and full emancipation from sin and Satan's thralldom, and yet we see millions of our race held in the chains of hellish bondage; shrouded in thick clouds of spiritual darkness; lying in the region and shadow of death. The question very naturally suggests itself, why is this?

Why, then, Almighty Saviour, why
Do wretched souls in millions die,
While the infernal tyrant reigns
O'er spacious realms, in ponderous chains?"

Hath God forgotten to be gracious? hath he in anger shut up his tender mercies? are his faithful promises and his covenant with his people ineffectual? No emphatically no! The Lord is not slack concerning his promises, neither is his arm at all shortened, but the church has been remiss, she has not fully and faithfully performed her heaven imposed work, she has dallied with the world, she has descended from her high and glorious vantage ground, and listening to the message of the worldly Tobias and Sanballats, has on the plains of spiritual Ono coquetted with the sworn enemies of her glorious sovereign; and thus in a great measure has she been shorn of her strength. O, that she may ere long awake, shake herself from the dust, and gird herself with strength for the conquest of the world and the subjugation of a rebel race to the mild sway of her Emmanuel. That her sons may be as plants grown up in their youth, that her daughters may be as corner stones polished after the similitude of a palace. When the rich shall not be highminded nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God; be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate.— When holiness to the Lord shall be engraven on her banners. Then shall God, even our own God bless us, and all the ends of the earth shall fear him.

In reviewing our own mission work during the past year, we have cause of heartfelt gratitude to God, that considerable good has been accomplished. On several of the mission stations the Holy Spirit has been graciously poured forth, and souls have been added to the Church. Many of the Stations have contributed more liberally to the support of the cause; but in some instances the cause has suffered, because those who should contribute largely in proportion to the ability God hath given them have not done so. One Mission, viz: Mitchell,

has resolved to be henceforth a self-sustaining circuit: we earnestly urge on other Stations the duty and privilege of copying this noble example.

We feel it our incumbent duty to return our sincere thanks to the Home Committee for the hearty manner in which they have responded to our call for Missionaries to fill up our ranks; and the more especially, as those Brethren sent us are indeed workmen that need not to be ashamed. We trust they may long be spared to labor in this increasingly interesting field of the great vineyard of the Lord.

We also feel very thankful to God that during the year the lives of all the Missionaries have been spared; and although affliction and death has entered some of our families, we have been divinely supported, and enabled in deep humility, but implicit confidence and trust in God, to kiss the rod, and bless him that hath appointed it.

The following synopsis of the state of our Missions, as presented by the several quarterly meetings, will be read with interest.

COBOURG DISTRICT wears an improving aspect. There were great searchings of heart a few years ago, on account of the downward tendency of the District, especially manifest in a yearly decrease in the membership; this we are happy to say received a check the year preceding the last. This year we report an increase, after allowing for removals, deaths, unfaithfulness, &c., of 138 members, and 58 on trial.

PETERBORO' Station, though not visited with large revival influence, nevertheless rejoices that God was present among them in the services of the sanctuary, and a few were added to the church. The Pastor and friends are united in their opinion that a change must be made in the working of the mission, and request the Conference to send them two preachers for next year.

DUMMER reports:—We feel grateful to the great master of assemblies, that though we have not experienced any special outpouring of the spirit, we have frequently realized his presence in our midst, both in our public and social meetings. The class and prayer meetings have been seasons rich in grace, and we deeply regret that our friends do not more generally appreciate those means of grace. Our special services, which commenced with cheering prospects, were suddenly closed by violent weather, and bad roads.

SEYMOUR report says:—We have admitted several on trial for membership during the year, and we are expending upwards of \$200 on one of our churches. Nevertheless we must ingenuously say, we cannot report much progress on the whole. In regard to our membership, some are living to God, others are twice dead, plucked up by the roots, and some, though but once dead have never had a resurrection unto life. We scarcely know how to expect much prosperity on this mission until the people shall have been more thoroughly educated in the rudiments of liberality, that they may devise more liberally for the erection of churches, the support of the gospel among them, and the cause of God in general.

In HUNTINGDON the past year has not been marked by any large ingatherings to our societies; nevertheless we have not been without manifestations of divine favor, for truly we may say "God has been with us," and without an exception peace has prevailed in our societies. Our congregations are generally good—some have been greatly enlarged. In some places we suffer for want of suitable buildings in which to worship God. The principal thing that militates

against us in the past year has been the want of care in carefully watching and guarding our form to be worked out in a healthy condition.

against us in the peculiar shape of the station, causing so much travel; but by carefully watching and taking advantage of circumstances we may get it into a form to be worked with advantage and comfort. Financially we are in a more healthy condition than last year.

HUNGERFORD report says:—We see much to encourage and incite us to increased faithfulness in the discharge of duty, and some things over which we are led to mourn. God hath graciously visited his people. At Potter's Lodge, Bethesda, Burley's and Ebenezer the cause has improved numerically and spiritually. Congregations have improved throughout the station. Ebenezer Chapel (36x26) has been erected and painted, and placed beyond the reach of pecuniary embarrassment. Bethesda Sabbath School has been organized with a good prospect of success. A livelier interest has been taken in financial affairs, but the large tract over which the station extends, and the large number of preaching places so inconveniently situated, militate against the effectual working of this field of labor. To work the station properly we must have a second preacher.

The PERRYTOWN report expresses gratitude to God for the preservation of the lives of the members with one exception, Sr. Howden, who met death with christian fortitude, and in triumph passed to her rest above. In both the public and social means of grace the gracious presence of God was realized. For about six weeks the Sabbath and week evening appointments could not be attended to owing to the impassable state of the roads. The membership shows a decrease of six; still in many respects the prospects of the station are more hopeful than for some time past. In finance there is considerable deficiency.

BOWMANVILLE DISTRICT is steadily advancing, showing an increase numerically and financially. The reports from every station are encouraging, and we hope the day is not far distant when several of the Mission Stations in this District will be self-supporting.

The OSHAWA report, after grateful acknowledgment of God's mercies, says eleven persons have been hopefully converted and received on trial for membership. After filling up the places of removals and some dropped for unfaithfulness they return the same number of members as last year. The debt on the church has been reduced \$331.80. The Sabbath School is well sustained both in numbers and finances. The weekly Bible class, established during the winter, is well attended, and good results are expected from it. The Missionary and Quarterly receipts far ahead of last year. The prospects of the station are good, and with the Divine blessing we anticipate the day when we shall have one of the largest and most flourishing churches here. We want deeper piety and closer union.

In PICKERING there is a steady increase of membership. Congregations on the whole good: two thriving Sabbath schools started. In some localities the spirit of liberality has improved, and some souls have been converted to God. All their churches are out of debt, and the mission is in a healthy financial condition. Attention is directed to the necessity of paying greater care to the centres of population; and earnest longings expressed for deeper piety among the membership, and more regular attendance to the regular means of grace.

From SCOTT we learn that during the year success has been realized. The Holy Spirit has been graciously poured out, and about twenty have joined the

Church; two new Sabbath Schools organized, and three of the children become members of Society. Bethesda chapel has been painted, and lumber procured for the erection of a shed at Bethel. The Societies are living in peace.

The PRINCE ALBERT report regrets that not many conversions have been realized. The congregations have improved in some places, and the Missionary receipts are about \$70 in excess of last year. The debts on two chapels have been paid off. The burying ground at Bethel has been fenced, and a new shed built. A lot of land has been given for a chapel on Scugog Island, and \$400 promised towards its erection. They think if the Conference would send a second preacher, with a suitable grant for a few years, the mission would soon pay its way.

THE FENELON STATION is gradually progressing and becoming consolidated. The Divine presence has been enjoyed in the assemblies, cheering the faint-hearted and converting the penitent, so that allowing for four places with 14 members given up last Conference, they still report a larger number of members. On account of adverse circumstances neither of the chapels commenced last year are finished.

EXETER DISTRICT presents some very pleasing features. Some of the missions are steadily approaching their proper position--self-sustaining Circuits--while others are still drawing heavily on the mission funds.

The MITCHELL REPORT says some things have transpired causing sorrow of heart to the true lovers of Zion, but others for which grateful thanksgivings are poured forth. At Bethel, Zion and Mitchell the efforts put forth for a revival of God's work have been in some measure successful: about 20 professed faith in Christ, and believers have been stirred up to seek after holiness of heart. The Sabbath Schools are reported in a very prosperous condition; a new school has been organized at Providence, with a good library, a staff of efficient officers and teachers, and 48 scholars. The missionary meetings, with one or two exceptions, quite a success. Mitchell has done nobly in finance. At Zion a large shed has been built, at a cost of \$100, all paid.

At LONDON, while they regret in the early part of the year a lack of anticipated success, which they trace to the want of a second preacher, with gratitude record several conversions to God. At Delaware the Society has had an accession of several members, the congregation is very good, and the contract let for the erection of a brick church at a cost of \$1,200. At Lambeth the special means were blessed; several joined the church, and the permanent improvement of our interest there secured. The place recently opened in Westminster bids fair to become a source of strength, financially and numerically. An elegant parsonage has been built and partly paid for.

The DEREHAM report mourns over a decrease of members, their returns showing 10 less than last year. The attendance at public services is good, and seasons of refreshing realized. Zion chapel has been painted, and the painting of Bethel chapel let. The prospects at Ingersoll seemed somewhat blighted after last conference, but things appear more cheering at the present; a strong desire is expressed to station a Preacher in Ingersoll, who should enter energetically into the general work of the Mission and be prepared to take his stand with other Ministers of the town.

From **USBORNE** we hear the year just closed has been one of more than ordinary conflict and trial; but the evidences given by many of the members of sterling piety, strong attachment to the cause, and liberal support of the funds are thankfully acknowledged. Several causes for the lack of greater success are reviewed. At **Elim** a denominational Sabbath School has been organized, and steps taken for the improvement of connexional property. The new church at **Bethany**, owing to a misunderstanding with the contractors, is not yet completed.

CLINTON report says:—This Mission has unquestionably improved.

COLBORNE.—The year has on the whole been a happy one. Believers have been blessed while toiling with the Ministry to promote God's glory. Our labor in the Lord has not been in vain, inasmuch as souls have been saved and Christ's cause built up. Finances increased, but we want more light, more love, more of God.

GREY.—During the past year we have had some seasons of refreshing coming from the presence of the Lord. The chapel at the Town plot has been plastered. We want an increase of spirituality and holy activity in the cause of God.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND DISTRICT has slightly improved numerically, but in finance there is rather a falling off on some of the Stations. There have not been so many disappointments in the past winter as the former, storms not being so frequent nor violent.

CHARLOTTE TOWN report speaks of considerable success, especially at Winslow road. Congregations are generally good. A visible improvement in Sabbath Schools—one new school has been organized and another resuscitated. The debt on Charlotte Town Chapel has been lessened £100, and £20 paid on Wheatly River Chapel. At Vernon river during some weeks past the ordinary services have been attended with an increased degree of Divine influence, and during the special services now being held believers are becoming quickened, and some manifest a desire to flee from the wrath to come. A Tea Meeting, to raise funds for the Mission House, resulted in realizing £28. With unwavering reliance on the promises of God we renew our vows of entire consecration to his service.

EBENEZER reports a year of toils, cares, struggles, and conflicts. The Sabbath School department is very encouraging; and the finances, despite adverse circumstances, in a healthy state; we remember that it is declared, "at evening time it shall be light," and despite failures in the past we are hopeful for the future.

MURRAY HARBOUR report regrets counteracting influences, which have in a measure rendered the word preached of none effect. They acknowledge gratefully refreshing seasons in the public and private means of grace. The Sabbath Schools and Bible Classes are in a prosperous state, and finances healthy.

THREE RIVERS & GRAND RIVER.—Though not realizing any marked manifestations of Divine power in the breaking down and conversion of sinners, nevertheless in connection with the varied means of grace a Divine influence has been felt. Considering the mixed character of our population our congregations are good. Our finances, owing to commercial depression and other causes, are

far from being satisfactory; and from the present aspect of affairs this Station must for a time at least continue to be largely dependant on the Missionary Society for aid.

NEW BIDEFORD has not realized much success during the year; which they think in some degree owing to the lack of a good staff of Local preachers to supplement the labors of the Itinerant preachers. In the special meetings held at Northern the labor was not spent in vain. The financial state of the mission is far from encouraging.

WISCONSIN DISTRICT.—At Yorkville and Ives' Grove the work of grace deepens. The special meetings held in those places resulted in a general quickening of the members, and bringing into church fellowship seventy-five persons. Most of the converts meet regularly in class, and some of them promise to be useful in the church. The other Societies continue stationary. Burlington Road chapel lot is being enclosed, and money subscribed for building a shed. Beaumonts, Rosehill and Ives' Grove Societies very much need the erection of a chapel in each place. The south-west part of the Circuit is being thickly settled with Roman Catholics. The only hope for the Station is in genuine extensive and lasting revivals of religion.

At LISBON they have obtained the Union Church on the Lisbon plank road, extended their borders by the addition of one society, and a few added to each of the others. Their greatest need is a few local preachers, as the congregations cannot at present be supplied with but one service on the Sabbath.

The CLEVELAND report gratefully records the many blessings received from God during the year, and also the unity and brotherly love which has universally obtained among them. The congregations have slightly increased, and the religious services, more especially the Quarterly love-feasts, have been seasons rich with Divine influence. During the winter extra meetings were held in a few places, resulting in good to the church and the addition of a few to the society. The Sabbath School is in a very prosperous condition; a very lively interest has been manifested in its welfare, and the great end of Sabbath school teaching realized in the happy death of two scholars during the past year. fervent breathings are poured forth, and buoyant hopes expressed for the outpourings of the Divine blessing, that the cause of Christ may prosper and his universal reign be ushered in.

From ROCKLAND we are happy to hear the cheering notes of victory under the banner of King Jesus. About one hundred persons have professed faith in Christ. The Sabbath services are well attended, and the Sabbath School increased in interest. Nearly two thousand dollars have been raised for connexional purposes during the year.

ORANGE & CHAGRIN FALLS speaks of severe struggles and abundant mercies, financial difficulties and cheering liberality. Some have professed faith in Christ, and a few passed home in the triumphs of blissful hope. Complaint is made of lack of interest in, and attendance to, class and prayer meetings.
