A triple murder was committed at the usually quiet city of Guelph some time yesterday afternoon. A man named William H. Harvey murdered his wife and two daughters, and then came on to Toronto with the deliberate intention of adding a fourth victim to his list in the person of his son. Luckily he was intercepted before the fourth crime was committed and the murderer is now a prisoner at Police Headquarters. This tragedy is one of the most revolting in the annals of Canadian crime, and recalls such bloody deeds as the Biddulph butcheries and the Mann murders in Eastern Ontario. It is said that Harvey, the murderer, is insane. There is considerable mystery about the movements of the murderer between the time of the commission of the crimes and his arrest in Toronto. The World reporters have strung together a well-connected and accurate account of the awful crime.

THE SCENE OF THE TRAGEDY.
It is a long narrow cottage-looking building with two stories in front and a one story addition at the rear. On entering the front door the stairway ascends on one side, the narrow hall, and the parlor is on the other side. The hall runs into a bedroom off its balcony in the rear. Behind the sitting-room is a dining-room. Back of that again is the kitchen and a clothes-room in the rear corner. Upstairs there is a front bedroom with closets, and a couple of other bedrooms. The chief door of the house looked at both doors, but by raising the window at the back made his way inside.

A Dreadful Discovery.
All was as silent as the grave. He passed through the kitchen, dining and sitting rooms, looked into the parlor and then went up stairs where the first object on which his eye rested as he turned to the front was Mr. Harvey's fair-haired daughter of twelve or thirteen years lying on the floor of the front bedroom with her head in a pool of blood by the closed door. The bloody hole in her head as once told the means by which she had met her death. The chief raised the little one's head from its cramped position and laid it on a pillow.

Horrible. The chief went downstairs and in the clothes room off the kitchen found Mrs. Harvey stretched at full length with a similar awful bullet wound. A further search through the house revealed nothing more, and no trace was found of the author of the dreadful triple murder. The last seen of him was as he was walking towards the Exhibition Grounds shortly after twelve o'clock. Though many are on his track no trace of him has yet been discovered.

The News spread like wildfire and in a few moments after the house was surrounded by an excited crowd. The doors were locked and no one was admitted.

The Purchase of the Pistol.
About half past nine this morning Harvey went into J. M. Bond & Co.'s store. Being well known the clerk had no hesitation in selling him a pistol. Harvey asked for a

expression which seemed to denote regret that the case did not use on himself. The police are fully alive to the importance of the case, and Inspector Stephen placed on duty before the call to see that he does not do himself justice.
